FUNERAL SERVICES TAB ON WEBSITE

A funeral service provides family and friends an opportunity to reflect and celebrate the life of a loved one. Participating in the planning of the funeral service will provide an experience that is unique and meaningful to all involved.

Coming together for a funeral service allows all in attendance to support each other while honoring the memory of the person who has died. Peninsula Cremation and Burial will assist in creating a lasting tribute as per the wishes of the family and or those involved in the arrangements.

The Funeral Service

A funeral service is a solemn and traditional occasion. A private or public viewing and a service to follow at the funeral home, church or other venue is the usual order of events. Burial at a cemetery in the ground or above ground of the casketed remains would then follow.

The cost of caskets range between several hundred dollars to several thousand dollars depending upon the construction materials. There are many to choose from which will accommodate any budget.

It is a requirement of many cemeteries that a grave liner or vault, constructed of concrete and designed to support the weight of the earth be used to encase the casket when buried beneath the earth, keeping cemetery property secure and safe.

The Graveside Service

The graveside service can be another option. A graveside service would follow a viewing or chapel service at a funeral home, church or other venue. It can also be the principal and sole gathering for the family and those coming to pay their respects to the deceased. At the conclusion of the ceremony, should there be, burial will follow.

Complete Cremation Service

Complete cremation is another option, though, like a complete funeral service cremation will follow rather than a casketed burial. A rental casket or a cremation casket (casket designed to be cremated) may be used. Following viewing and services, and eventual cremation the cremated remains or (cremains), can be buried, scattered by proper methods, or be returned to the family. There are many selections for cremation urns. Urns are typically constructed out of materials such as woods, ceramics, semi-precious metals, cardboard and plastic.

Immediate Cremation Service

Arrangements for an immediate disposition of the remains by "Immediate Cremation" is also available. In this instance this option will be followed by a memorial service at the funeral

home, church or other venue selected. A service where the body is not present is called a memorial service. Should you select immediate cremation we feel it to be important that you are allowed a time to view the body privately as a family. If a viewing can be done in a matter of a few hours after the death has occurred embalming will not be necessary. We would encourage embalming should there be a delay of eight (8) hours or longer. Embalming requirements vary in accordance to State law. Accepting that the death has occurred is difficult. However, viewing the deceased can be an important step in allowing ourselves to begin the healing process.
