

Cremation Services:

In the past few years cremation has increased significantly. Cremation does not limit one's choices, but in fact, increases the amount of options available. Preplanning your arrangements in advance of need can relieve the burden of these decisions. What is done before or after the cremation is up to the survivors, or up to you.

Cremation and Funerals:

A funeral or memorial service before or after "A Cremation" is your choice. There is no requirement of any kind that one must arrange for any type of public or private service. Though, a funeral service followed by cremation may be the same as a funeral followed by burial within a cemetery. These services can be traditional or non-traditional, very simple, or elaborate. Peninsula Cremation and Burial will assist you in the planning and arranging of a funeral service that is unique and tailored to the memory of the deceased.

Complete Cremation Service

Complete cremation is another option, though, like a complete funeral service cremation will follow rather than a casketed burial. A rental casket or a cremation casket (casket designed to be cremated) may be used. Following viewing and services, and eventual cremation, the cremated remains or (cremains), can be buried, scattered by proper methods, or be returned to the family. There are many selections for cremation urns. Urns are typically constructed out of materials such as woods, ceramics, semi-precious metals, cardboard and plastic.

Immediate Cremation Service

Arrangements for an immediate disposition of the remains by "Immediate Cremation" is also available. In this instance this option will be followed by a memorial service at the funeral home, church or other venue selected. A service where the body is not present is called a memorial service. Should you select immediate cremation we feel it to be important that you are allowed a time to view the body privately as a family. If a viewing can be done in a matter of a few hours after the death has occurred embalming will not be necessary. We would encourage embalming should there be a delay of eight (8) hours or longer. Embalming requirements vary in accordance to State law. Accepting that the death has occurred is difficult. However, viewing the deceased can be an important step in allowing the healing process to begin.

Direct or Simple Cremation

Direct or Simple Cremation is an option that includes removal and transportation of the deceased into our care, securing necessary documents, and the actual cremation of the remains. There is no viewing or funeral service arranged. This option is the least expensive choice; however, it is designed to carry out disposition of the remains without any additional enhancements.

In Our Memories

There are many choices to memorialize a loved one after cremation. A family may wish to keep the cremated remains in their possession at home or have them properly scattered over land or water. Other options may include:

Outdoor Niches – Your loved one's cremated remains may be held in an above ground columbarium niche.

Scattering – There are special services licensed to scatter the cremated remains of your loved one within the natural environment including sea and air.

Burial of a Cremated Remains in an Urn – Urns containing the cremated remains of a loved one may be buried at the head or foot of a gravesite.

Personalized Merchandise for Memorialization - We carry a beautiful selection of urns and keepsakes that are perfect for displaying within your home. In addition, you may choose to inscribe your loved one's name and a special saying on a park bench, tree plaque, or other special memorial.
