
2019 Going, Going almost Gone

Tennessee Rider Education wishes all of our GWRRA family a very Merry and safe Christmas. Many members have winterized their bikes, while some members ride year round selecting the warmer and dry days. Be safe and alert riding in the winter months. Watch for ice and leaves. Be sure and dress for the weather and carry extra clothing.

We are working on TRC and ARC classes for 2020. We should have dates and locations by the Operations meeting. I will send the chapters directors the training needed for their members in the levels program that are coming up for renewal either in Medic First Aid or Rider courses, and of course Co-Rider Seminars. We will work with GW University in putting the Co-Rider Seminars together.

I spoke with Charlie and Pam Huffman our Medic First Aid Coordinators about having a MFA Instructor class for those who would like to become GWRRA MFA Instructors. If you are interested in becoming a MFA Instructor please contact Charlie and Pam Huffman. The class is a two day class usually Saturday and Sunday.

Winter is the time to schedule your Medic First Aid Training Classes. If your chapter needs the training contact Charlie and Pam. GWRRA does accept CPR / First Aid training classes from American Red Cross and American Heart. Classes are often offered by Fire departments and Rescue Squads as community service and some of our members maintain their certification through their employer. To record your CPR / First Aid certification be sure to e-mail or mail a copy to Roger and Marie or myself so we can update the data base for you.






