









District University Coordinators

There are many avenues for motorcycle education: one is, of course, the University Modules. At last count, there were 50 modules available. There are other avenues available too. As you well know, Google knows "everything" well, almost. There are several motorcycle safety websites, but as with any website, one needs to be careful. Some are very good, some are fiction. One of the problems is determining which sites are worth reading. Some that I have found and think to be good ones are:

- 1. **Mcrider.com** (<u>www.mcrider.com</u>). On the home page of this site are two buttons in the middle: 'Road Skills' and 'Road Strategy'. Clicking on the buttons brings up videos pertaining to those subjects. No longer does one have to go to youtube and search for appropriate videos. Kevin (i.e. mcrider) has done this for you. The best part is that this website and videos are free. Of course, you can become a member for a little as \$3.00 a month through Patreon but this is not required.
- 2. **Revzilla.com** (https://www.revzilla.com) publishes articles (Common Tread) about many things, many of which are reviews of different motorcycles models, but they also often include safety articles. To reach Common Tread directly, use the URL https://www.revzilla.com/common-tread.
- 3. **Motorcycle Tips & Techniques** (https://www.msgroup.org) is a site that has been around for a while but it has some pretty good safety tips. Definitely worth perusing.
- 4. While you are at it, check out **RideApart website** (https://www.rideapart.com). I have sometimes found some good safety articles on there

Meanwhile, ride safely and look out for distracted drivers – they seem to be everywhere.


