I have been asked on several occasions about the GWRRA Life Member Program. Former GWRRA President, Anita Alkire, addressed that in her May 2019 Insight article click on link below to see that article (<a href="http://gwrra.org/oconnect/newsletter/2019/InsightNewsletter0519.pdf?v=1">http://gwrra.org/oconnect/newsletter/2019/InsightNewsletter0519.pdf?v=1</a>). In a nutshell, there have been 3 "Life" member programs since GWRRA started. Original "Life Member" program ran until 2001. You became a "Life" member after 20 consecutive years as a GWRRA member. In 2002/2003 the "Gold" member program was introduced. Anyone with 10 years or more of GWRRA membership was permitted to purchase the remaining years to get them to the 20 year mark. These members became "Gold" members. Gold members had privileges similar to "Life" members. However, this program ended in 2007. The "New Life" member program started in 2007. "New Life" members pay reduced dues. The New Life program is in existence today. Everyone in the Life, Gold, or New Life program should receive reduced registration at Wing Ding and several District Rallies.

Let me tell you about a couple who joined as a "Family membership" but decided to save money and dropped the spouse for several years. When it was time to get their "Life member" patches they were told the spouse was not qualified because they had not been a member for several of those 20 years. Lesson here is: "your spouse is worth the \$10 per year. Besides, if you take them to a Rally they have to pay non-member entry.

**Spring is almost here.** So sign up for Spring Fling April 30 - 2 May in Pigeon Forge. But before you do that make sure your bike is ready for all those spring rides.

How many times have we seen someone show up for a chapter ride on an empty tank, or riding on a low tire or the core is showing on the tire. # SPRING FLING HAPPENINGS

Spring Fling (April 30 to May 2) will be here before we know it. Here are some items for those that are interested in the Bike Show, Light Show, Masters Breakfast and Rider Education Seminars.

## **BIKE SHOW**

The bike show will again be under Tennessee Bike Show rules (copies provided when registering), not national rules. There will be nine classes. We are going to have 1800 bike, 1800 trike, 1500 bike and 1500 trike classes. In the 1200, 1100, 1000, Valkyrie and Others class will include both bikes and trikes together in each category. Bikes with add-on kits (Voyager, etc) will be in the Valkyrie or Others class. There will not be any separate classes with trailers and or sidecars. All participants must be **fully registered** for Spring Fling. **No bike show registrations will be accepted after 5:00 PM deadline on Friday May 1, 2020.** Awards will be given out for 1st and 2nd places in each of the nine classes as well as a Best of Show Award.

## LIGHT SHOW

**Class I** All **motorcycles** and **trikes** with non-flashing lights. Exception: 4-way stock flashers, modulating headlight and/or alternating flashing brake lights. Any color is acceptable.

All lights, mountings and wires must be permanently attached to the cycle and accessories and must not interfere with the safe operation of the motorcycle. (No taped on or tied-on temporary lights.)

**Class II** Motorcycles and trikes with a **sidecar and/or trailer** with non-flashing lights. Rules are same as above.

**Class III** All bikes, trikes, trailers and sidecars with computerized lighting and or alternating brake lights, these may be in Classes I or II.

Anything goes with lighting as long as the lights are mounted and wired and do not in any way, jeopardize the safe operation of the motorcycle.

All participants must be fully registered for Spring Fling.

No light show registrations will be accepted after 5:00 PM deadline on Thursday April 30, 2020.

The number of lights on the bike will not determine the winner. Judging will be based upon the continuity, the overall pattern and the general appearance of the display.

The lights, mounting and wiring cannot, in any way, jeopardize the safe operation of the motorcycle.

Plaques will be given out for 1st place only in each of the three classes.

Cost is \$15.00 for each person. You **must be pre-registered** for the Masters Breakfast. **No** tickets will be sold on site.



The Horizons Program would be a good start. There will be a Horizons Program in Murfreesboro on March 28 at the Trinity United Methodist Church which is located at 2303 Jones Blvd. Because there are 4 modules in the program, we will start promptly at 9:00 am and we should be through by 5:00 pm at the latest.

Because of the length of the program, we will not have time to run out to your favorite eating establishment for lunch so we will be making arrangements to have lunch brought in. The cost of the lunch and the snacks which will be available all morning will be \$7.00 per person. Please send checks to David Hill, 2152 Ravenscourt Dr, Thompsons Station, TN 37179 by March 21. These funds will be used to purchase the snacks, coffee, soft drinks, water and lunch. Keep watch on Groupworks. Various classes are posted periodically. Unless otherwise stated in the class notification, anyone is welcome to take any class anywhere. If you're close to any of the surrounding states, you can take classes there too. Just be sure to scan or take a photo of the class roster so we can make sure you are credited for the class.

I don't know about you but we are ready for Spring. Please contact us if you need a class or have a question. We'll do what we can to help.


