



TIPS FOR A STRONG CONSTRUCTION



Tips for a strong construction:

We apply the same techniques with any plaster statuette to fix them on the stands. For some figurines the wooden bars are too short.

Then one can make each figurine longer by a lump of aluminum foil on top of the wooden stand.

- 1. Tear off a piece of aluminum foil and take one half a lump.
- 2. Fold the aluminium around the wooden rod.
- 3. Fix it well by pushing hard and scotshing it well.
- 4. Take a strip of aluminum foil about 25 cm wide. Fold it four double
- **5/6.** Wrap this strip down firmly around the plaster figurine and paste it with painter's tape. Keep it tight so you get a nice sleeve together with the foil around the figurine.
- 7. Slide the sleeve over the wooden rod (or glass bottle) 8. Press the foil securely.
- **9.** Stick stuck with tape and proceed with aluminum foil to give more volume to the body. Tape the whole figurine. The stronger the base, the faster and safer your will be finished. Paint the plaster inyour desired Powertex color.
