Affirming the Faith is an annual seminar and lectureship put on by churches of Christ in the Oklahoma City area. Each year, almost a thousand Christians gather together on Friday and Saturday to fellowship, sing, hear various speakers, and grow stronger in the faith. The elders and deacons of Hillcrest originally started attending this teaching event several years ago when new deacons had just been appointed at Hillcrest, and there was a particular teaching track held at the seminar regarding deacons and leadership. The years following, this annual pilgrimage resembled more of a men's retreat, with elders, deacons, and preachers all enjoying each other's company and fellowship.

It didn't take long for the wives of these men, after hearing from their husbands about how great this spiritual weekend really was, to want in on the action as well. The past two or three years have seen more of the wives of the elders and deacons attend the seminar and come away with a deep appreciation for the great work being done there. This year, the elders have decided to open up the invitation to all members of Hillcrest to attend this spiritual feast. We will leave on Friday afternoon, March 6, have supper in Oklahoma City, and then attend the first Keynote address and singing session of the seminar. We will stay overnight at one of the area hotels, and then get up Saturday morning to attend the rest of the sessions at the event, including breakfast

and lunch, before wrapping up the lectureship early in the afternoon. We will then head towards Neosho, typically stopping for supper in Tulsa, before arriving home late Saturday evening.

To encourage participation, the elders have graciously offered to help cover costs of the hotel rooms. One adult from each family unit can have a room free of charge (meaning individuals willing to share a room with someone else can have a room at no cost). Individuals who desire their own room will only have to pay \$50 for half the room cost. Couples are asked to pay \$50 for a room as well.

This year's Theme is "Reaching Higher: The Sermon on the Mount." It will be packed full of great gospel teachers, including Wes McAdams, Steve Higginbotham, Chris McCurley, Melvin Otey, Neal Pollard, our own Danny Boggs, and many others!
