TO OUR **PROSPECTIVE APPRENTICESHIP APPLICANTS**:

Community is at the heart of everything we do, so as the novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) begins to have a greater impact, we want to share some of the immediate steps we are taking to help you keep you safe and healthy.

Like many others, our company is closely following guidelines from the CDC, the World Health Organization, and our local and national health organizations.

- At present the Anchorage ATESTT/CEE office are closed for public access but will continue to serve you by telephone and email.
- We will continue to process our apprenticeship openings and application/selection processes as scheduled unless we feel strongly that other necessary steps are required. We will only accept apprenticeship applications by postal mail.
- Workkeys certificate/test scores are required as part of the mandatory eligibility for apprenticeship applications. In the event you are unable to schedule testing with any of the local municipal or state entities which provide testing; we will accept your otherwise COMPLETE application by the noted deadlines. However, you will be required to submit test scores once we are able to determine a de-escalation of the COVID-19 threat and those entities resume services.

While we know the COVID 19 threat will disrupt business as usual in the short term, everyone's health and safety are of utmost importance to us and we guarantee that we are closely monitoring updates from the CDC, and are following CDC recommendations. We wish you all the best during this trying time. We want to assure you - *our valued customers*, we will be here ready to serve and assist you as things get back on track in any way we can during this threat and after it has passed.
