Because of the new fee, the city will layout Sara Park in specified camping, vending and/or casual sites. These sites will be available for rent from the city after registering with the AOMCI at 8:00 AM on Wednesday, July 30, 2014, on a first come-first served basis. The city will collect the fees for the sites and a daily launch fee. The Northwoods Chapter will also collect a \$5 fee from all AOMCI members to sustain the meet's expenses. How to register: 1. Select your site. 2. Park, setup, pull colored tag at the site. 3. Go to the arena. 4. Register first with the Northwoods Club by paying the \$5.00 fee. 5.
