How is Your Attendance?

You may be thinking "church attendance." I must admit, it is strange not to have the buzz about the church building this past couple of weeks. All of the church activities have been limited in regard to congregating. However, what if I were to tell you that the word "attendance" means something different in the scriptures than how we normally use it?

For instance, one usage is that of servitude, office, or function.

- When the Queen of Sheba visited Solomon, she was impressed by "the attendance of his ministers" among other things (1 Kings 10:5; 2 Chronicles 9:4).
- There is a reference to Harbona, who served King Ahasuerus as, "one of the eunuchs in attendance".
 The KJV identifies him as a chamberlain (Esther 7:9 ESV).
- Then there is an argument made in Hebrews 7:13 about there being a change in the law which resulted in a change in the priesthood. Jesus Christ (of the tribe of Judah) now is serving as High Priest of the faith (Hebrews 7:26). "For he of whom these things are spoken pertaineth to another tribe, of which no man gave attendance at the altar."

The other usage is that of turning the mind to, being attentive to, or giving heed to something. Paul instructed Timothy, "Till I come, give attendance to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine." (1 Timothy 4:13). While most commentators acknowledge that the act Paul wanted Timothy not to neglect would be taking place in a public setting (perhaps the public reading of scripture), it is just as important to make an application to the private reading of scripture. We must remember that:

- All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: (2 Timothy 3:16).
- David said, "Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee." (Psalm 119:11).
- David also said, "I will delight myself in thy statutes: I will not forget thy word." (Psalm 119:16).
