PREPARING FOR YOUR SOLO

Students should be able to play their solo correctly with the CD from memory at least a month before the recital. Teachers need to hand in their list of solos on Oct. 20th. The first step in preparing is to make sure you can play all of your old pieces correctly with the CD. Review your scales and 4th finger exercises to make sure you can play them with the scale CD. Pick a piece where you feel comfortable and try some practice performances at home. Try recording a video on your phone or tablet and watching the playback to look for areas to improve.

Students who don't feel comfortable playing a solo on the day of the recital do not have to play. There is no pressure. We want everyone to have a good experience.
