Group class for additional children in the same family is \$200.00 per term.

We normally don't send out bills to save on administrative costs so we rely on parents to be proactive in paying their tuition so that we don't have to call you.

You can help by checking your records and paying before we have to contact you.

Students who use a weekly or monthly payment plan must pay for the weeks that they miss. Students who pay monthly should pay at the end of the month for the following month.

The materials fee covers all practice CDs, replacement strings, printed materials. This way you don't have to pay for each item separately.
