## South-West Florida Classic Youth Bowlers Division Rules for JUNIOR GOLD QUALIFIER Event

1. Current Junior Gold and USBC rules will prevail unless specified below.
2. Dress Code for tournaments held in January - November: NO Shorts, Jeans, Denim, Yoga pants or Athletic attire permitted at any time. Pants cannot have any outside pockets, such as cargo pants.
  - a. **Shirts:** A collared/mock collared shirt or USBC Youth shirt. Sleeveless shirts are not permitted.
  - b. **Male participants** are required to wear slacks. Slacks must not contain drawstring waists or elastic bottoms. Slacks must have a zipper and a button to be eligible.
  - c. **Female participants** are required to wear slacks, skirts or capris. All skirts, must be **sufficiently below the competitor's fingertips** when they are standing and their arms are hanging loosely at their side. All capris **must be below the knee** while standing.
  - d. **Headgear** – No covering or sunglasses can be worn while practicing or competing (hats, caps, or bandannas, etc.). Male participants cannot wear any headgear while practicing or competing, unless a request is made in writing and approved prior to the event.
  - e. **Headphones**—not permitted by bowlers at any time they are bowling, whether in the bowlers circle or on the approach
3. Membership Requirements for Junior Gold Qualifier:
  - a. USBC Youth Standard member can apply for Junior Gold membership at any time.
  - b. Athlete must be a USBC Youth Member in good standing.
  - c. Athlete must purchase a USBC Junior Gold membership prior to participating in Junior Gold Championships qualifying tournaments. The USBC Junior Gold membership fee is separate from the regular USBC Youth membership fee. Each membership is valid for the current bowling season only, regardless of date of purchase.
  - d. Once the Junior Gold membership is obtained, it remains valid for the current bowling season, Aug. 1 - July 31.
  - e. USBC Junior Gold Membership cards **MUST** be presented at time of registration or the bowler will be required to purchase another membership card for \$30 for the U15, U17 and U20 divisions and \$10 for the U12 division.
4. Junior Gold Qualifying Divisions:
  - a. This tournament will be conducted using eight (8) divisions, **REGARDLESS OF AVERAGE**. Individual age breakdowns are as follows:  
1: U12 Boys, 2: U12 Girls, 3: U15 Boys, 4: U15 Girls, 5: U17 Boys, 6: U17 Girls, 7: U20 Boys, 8: U20 Girls.
  - b. Any bowler whose birth date is **Birthdate of 8/1/2007 or Later** will participate in the **U12 Division** as long as there are 4 bowlers.
  - c. Any bowler whose birth date is **Birthdate is between 8/1/2004 and 7/31/2007** will participate in the **U15 Division** as long as there are 4 bowlers.
  - d. Any bowler whose birth date is **Birthdate is between 8/1/2002 and 7/31/2004** will participate in the **U17 Division** as long as there are 4 bowlers.
  - e. Any bowler whose **Birthdate is between 8/1/1999 and 7/31/2002** will participate in the **U20 Division** as long as there are 4 bowlers.
  - f. Bowlers in the U12, U15 and U17 division may exercise the option to participate in the U20 division by completing the Junior Gold Championship form. Individuals who qualify in either a U12, U15 or U17 only division must compete in their respective age division at the Junior Gold Championships.
5. Registration/Check-In/Entry Fee:
  - a. Entry fee into the South-West Florida Classic Junior Gold Qualifier will be \$25 for U12 Only, \$37.50 for U15 Only or \$50 for U17 and/or U20 Only per bowler. If we need to combine divisions, the highest entry fee will be charged. Pre-registration can be done via mail, email, phone or on our Facebook page. You are not required to pre-register, however it is recommended.
  - b. In order to bowl in the Junior Gold Qualifier the bowler is required to bowl in the South-West Florida Classic Youth Eliminator Tournament that is running in conjunction.
  - c. The entry fee will be used for 100% towards the Junior Gold Prize Fund.
  - d. We will NOT follow the Major Fraction Thereof for the Junior Gold Qualifier. If the event has extra entrants, the tournament will advance the winner under their 1:4 ratio. The next place finisher would now be given the opportunity to fund any remaining shortfall between the entry monies collected and the appropriate division entry fee and claim a spot in the Junior Gold Championships. This option is available **only** to the next player in line. If that player declines to exercise this option, it ceases at that point and the option is **not available** to other finishers down the line in the standings.
  - e. All payments are due, in full, on the day of the event. Cash or money order will be the only acceptable forms of payment.
6. Standard Junior Gold Tournament Format for all divisions:
  - a. Qualifying Round – Bowl the amount of games used for the SWFC Qualifying round, moving one (1) pair to the right
  - b. Junior Gold advancers will be selected at the end of the qualifying round based upon scratch scores of all qualifying games combined
  - c. 1:4 will determine the number of qualifiers for the Junior Gold Championships in Las Vegas, NV from July 11 - 18, 2020.
  - d. If an athlete already has won an entry to the Junior Gold Championships and then wins another, he/she cannot take the second as a scholarship. The spot must go to the next highest qualified Junior Gold member.
  - e. Alternates: The next player in-line is used to replace any bowler who declines an earned spot.
  - f. Ties: A three (3) frame [frames 8 - 10] roll off will be used in the event there is a tie for the last qualifying spot. In case there is still a tie after the three frame roll-off, another three (3) frame roll-off will occur until a winner is determined.
7. Check-In:
  - a. Check-in begins one (1) hour PRIOR to start time. All entrants should try to arrive at least one (1) hour before squad time.
  - b. All squads will be closed 15 minutes prior to the scheduled start time. If you arrive after that time, without prior notification to the Tournament Director of your lateness, you will not be allowed to bowl. **NO SQUADS WILL BE DELAYED FOR LATE ARRIVALS.**
  - c. You **MUST** be properly dressed in tournament attire before you check-in.
8. Qualifiers must consist of:
  - a. At least four (4) male USBC Junior Gold members OR
  - b. At least four (4) female USBC Junior Gold members OR
  - c. Any combination of four (4) USBC Junior Gold members regardless of gender or age.
9. Bowler Responsibility:
  - a. It is the qualified bowlers responsibility to inform the SWFC Tournament Director if they can't attend the Jr Gold National event. Failure to do so prior to May 31, 2020, and the spot can't be used will result in the bowler reimbursing SWFC for the entire entry cost: U12 = \$100, U15 = \$150, U17 or U20 = \$200. Failure to pay the entry cost will result in the bowler being disqualified from future SWFC events.

## South-West Florida Classic Youth Bowlers Division Rules

1. Current USBC rules will prevail. Entry into the South-West Florida Classic Youth Tournament is open to USBC Youth Division and Adult Division sanctioned members in good standing. Bowlers must be 21 years of age or younger as of January 1st of the current year to be eligible to bowl in our tournaments. No PBA card holders - National or Regional Tours, will be allowed to participate.
2. Dress Code for tournaments held in January - November: NO Shorts, Jeans, Denim, Yoga pants or Athletic attire permitted at any time. Pants cannot have any outside pockets, such as cargo pants.
  - a. **Shirts:** A collared/mock collared shirt or USBC Youth shirt. Sleeveless shirts are not permitted.
  - b. **Male participants** are required to wear slacks. Slacks must not contain drawstring waists or elastic bottoms. Slacks must have a zipper and a button to be eligible.
  - c. **Female participants** are required to wear slacks, skirts or capris. All skirts, must be **sufficiently below the competitor's fingertips** when they are standing and their arms are hanging loosely at their side. All capris **must be below the knee** while standing.
  - d. **Headgear** – No covering or sunglasses can be worn while practicing or competing (hats, caps, or bandannas, etc.). Male participants cannot wear any headgear while practicing or competing, unless a request is made in writing and approved prior to the event.
  - e. **Headphones**—not permitted by bowlers at any time they are bowling, whether in the bowlers circle or on the approach
3. This tournament will be conducted on an average basis of two (2) divisions, **REGARDLESS OF AGE**. Individual average breakdowns are as follows: Division 1 will consist of Sport Averages of 163 and under or Non Sport Averages of 189 and under. All bowlers in Division 1 will receive handicap; Division 2 will consist of Sport Averages of 164 and over or Non Sport Averages of 190 and over. All bowlers in Division 2 will be in the Scratch division. Bowlers may opt to move up in the Scratch division if they request it. This decision needs to be provided to the Tournament director prior to the 1st ball being thrown. Once the 1st ball has been thrown, division declaration is locked and bowlers may not change. If there is an obvious error in declaration, the Tournament Director may/will update the divisions appropriately. Tournament Director reserves the right to modify the Average Divisions based upon number of entries received.
4. The Entering average used for this tournament will be determined as follows: **You must provide a copy of the information found on bowl.com. If you do not provide a printed copy, you will be required to bowl scratch. All averages will be converted to Sport.**
  - a. Averages used for SWFC Tournaments will be in as follows:
    - b. From January 1, 2020 - July 31, 2020
      - c. Bowl.com average for 2019-2020 January average as long as
        - d. 36 games bowled for sport average
        - e. 21 games bowled for non-sport average
      - f. Bowl.com average for 2018-2019 Winter League season as long as
        - g. 36 games bowled for sport average
        - h. 21 games bowled for non-sport average
      - i. Bowl.com average for 2018-2019 Summer League season as long as
        - j. 21 games bowled for sport and/or non-sport average
    - k. As of August 2020
      - l. Bowl.com average for 2019-2020 Winter average as long as
        - m. 36 games bowled for sport average
        - n. 21 games bowled for non-sport average
      - o. Anyone without any of these average or written proof, will be placed in the scratch division
  - p. If a bowler has a Certified Sport average and a regular league average, the Certified Sport average will take precedence to be used in our tournaments. If a bowler is bowling in a Tough shot league, they must inform the tournament staff prior to bowling.
  - q. Falsification of entering averages or any information will result in the disqualification of the bowler, with no refund of entry fees.
  - r. Tournament Director reserves the right to re-rate any bowler at any time.
  - s. Rule 319a will not be in effect for any South-West Florida Classic tournaments.
5. Registration/Check-In/ Entry Fee:
  - a. Standard Tournaments –See schedule for entry Fee. Pre-registration is highly recommended and can be done via email, phone and/or text to 813-486-2641. Each tournament will have a maximum amount of bowlers. Bowlers on the pre-registration list will be guaranteed a spot into the event. Once the limit has been reached we will start a waiting list. Pre-registration can be done for any event and will end at 8pm the Friday before the event.
  - b. Walk-ins will be permitted the day of the tournament, however, they will be accepted on a space-permitting basis. Walk-ins cannot be guaranteed placement in these tournaments. This DOES NOT INCLUDE the Tournament of Champions in December, in which participation is by invitation only. No walks-ins or persons without an invitation from the Tournament Director will be permitted to participate in the Tournament of Champions tournament. Pre-registration is required for the Tournament of Champions tournament.
  - c. All payments are due, in full, on the day of the event. Cash or money order will be acceptable the day of the event. Checks will be acceptable forms of payment for pre-payment only and must be received within 7 days of the event. See rule 6 for full details regarding our check policy.
  - d. The standard entry fee is comprised of:
    - e. Entry Fee ==> \$55 South-West Florida Classic will add \$150 to the prize fund each event
      - 1) Scholarship Fund = \$30.00
      - 2) Lineage, Expenses and Awards = \$23.50
      - 3) Tournament of Champions = \$1.50
  - f. The Mid Year Extravaganza entry fee is comprised of:
    - g. Entry Fee ==> \$70 South-West Florida Classic will add \$1000 to the event
      - 1) Scholarship Fund = \$30.00
      - 2) Lineage, Expenses and Awards = \$38.50
      - 3) Tournament of Champions = \$1.50
  - h. You can also mail your pre-registration request to: **South-West Florida Classic 1302 Primwood Lane, Lutz, FL 33549**
  - i. Check-in begins one (1) hour PRIOR to start time. All entrants should try to arrive at least one (1) hour before squad time.
  - j. All squads will be closed 15 minutes prior to the scheduled start time. If you arrive after that time, without prior notification to the Tournament Director of your lateness, you will not be allowed to bowl. **NO SQUADS WILL BE DELAYED FOR LATE ARRIVALS.**
  - k. You MUST be properly dressed in tournament attire (see Dress Code) before you check-in.
6. Registration/Check-In/ Entry Fee:

All prize money will be returned 100% in the form of scholarships. No cash prizes are awarded. Prize ratio will be at least 1:5

7. **Check Policy:** **Cash or Money Order will be accepted the day of the tournament. Checks will be permitted for pre-payment only and must be received one (1) week prior to the upcoming tournament along with a completed registration form.**
  - a. All checks are to be made payable to SOUTH-WEST FLORIDA CLASSIC or SWFC.
  - b. All checks must include the check writers name, address, phone number and the name of the bowler written on the check.
  - c. Any check returned to us by your bank for any reason will incur a \$35.00 returned check fee in addition to the amount of the check.
  - d. All returned checks must be made good by cash or money order only and must be received by South-West Florida Classic within 7 days of our notification to you. A personal or business check to replace the returned item WILL NOT be accepted.
  - e. If payment is not received within 7 days, the matter will be referred to our attorney for collection.
  - f. A returned check must be made good before the bowler can receive any SMART scholarship awards or participate in any future events. There will NOT BE ANY EXCEPTIONS.
  - g. If we receive one (1) returned check, you will be required to pay for all future events, in the current calendar year, by cash or money order only.
8. **Behavior and Conduct:**
  - a. Members of the USBC who conduct themselves in a manner deemed not within the standards expected of youth and adult bowlers shall be disqualified from further participation in future tournaments and reported to USBC for formal suspension from membership. Bowlers are expected to be professional in demeanor and behavior at all times. Abuse of equipment, foul or disruptive language/gestures, and/or unprofessional behavior by bowlers or spectators will result in disqualification and removal from the building. If a bowler is disqualified, their entry fee will be forfeited. You will also receive a one tournament suspension and will not be allowed to participate in the next tournament.
  - b. Any bowler or spectator suspected of being under the influence of alcohol or drugs of any kind will be required to leave the tournament and be escorted from the venue. Any entry fees paid and scholarship awards earned for the event will be forfeited.
  - c. Only current bowlers and tournament personnel are permitted in the bowling circle during competition. Easy slide is NOT permitted in the circle. No food or beverages will be allowed in the bowling circle.
9. **Standard Tournament Format for all divisions:**
  - a. **Round 1** – Bowl 5 games across 10 lanes. The top 12 bowlers in each division will move to Semi-Final Rd1 – all previous scores will carry over.
  - b. **Semi-Final Rd1** – Bowl 2 games across 4 lanes. Top 5 in each division will move to Semi-Final Rd2 - all previous scores now dropped after this round.
  - c. **Semi-Final Rd2** – Top 5 bowlers in each division after 7 games of qualifying will bowl at the same time on the same pair of lanes where top 2 scores, including handicap, will move on to the Finals. 3rd, 4th and 5th place will be awarded by order of scores.
  - d. **Finals** - Bowl 1 game head to head including handicap to determine 1st and 2nd Place.
10. **Double Elimination Tournament Format for all divisions:**
  - a. **Round 1** – Bowl 4 games across 8 lanes. Top 16 bowlers in each division will move on to the bracket round. Bowlers will be placed in brackets by division and position from qualifying. Pins DO NOT carry over.
  - b. **Bracket Rounds:** Consist of one-game matches - total pins with handicap shall determine the winner.
  - c. **Double-elimination** format will be used. A player is eliminated after two losses.
  - d. All participants start in the Winners' Bracket. After losing one match they enter the Contender's Bracket.
  - e. **Finals** will consist of a one-game match - Total pins with handicap shall determine the champion.
11. **Mid Year Extravaganza Tournament Format for all divisions:**
  - a. **Sat. 9 am Block 1 Qualifying** – Bowl 5 games across 10 lanes on Short Sport Pattern [Moving 2 pairs after each game]
  - b. **Sat. 2 pm Block 2 Qualifying** – Bowl 5 games across 10 lanes on Medium Sport Pattern [Moving 2 pairs after each game]
  - c. **Sun. 9 am Block 3 Qualifying** – Bowl 5 games across 10 lanes on Long Sport Pattern [Moving 2 pairs after each game]
  - d. Top 12 bowlers in each division after 15 games of qualifying move on. The top 2 bowlers in each division get a bye and will move on to Semi-Final Round 2. All Previous Pins are now dropped.
  - e. **Sun. Semi Final Round 1** - Bowl 2 games across 4 lanes - moving 2 pairs. Top 2 bowlers in each division will move on to Semi Final Round 2. All previous pins are dropped again.
  - a. **Sun. Semi Final Round 2** - Top 5 bowlers in each division, 2 from Qualifying and 3 from Semi Final Round 1, will bowl at the same time on the same pair of lanes where top 2 scores, including handicap, will move on to the Finals. 3rd, 4th and 5th place will be awarded by order of scores.
  - d. **Sun. Finals** - Bowl 1 game head to head including handicap to determine 1st and 2nd Place.
12. **Ties:**

A three (3) frame roll-off [frames 8-10] including 1/3 of the handicap dropping any fractions will be used in the event there is a tie for the last qualifying spot going into the finals round or during the Step Ladder Finals. In case there is still a tie after the three (3) frame roll-off, another three (3) frame roll-off will occur until a winner is determined. All bowlers who are tied for the last qualifying spot in a non-final round will all qualify for the next round.
13. **Protests:**

The decision of the Tournament Director is final unless an appeal is made. Any protest or appeal concerning scoring must be made in writing stating briefly the grounds of the protest or appeal and submitted to the tournament office no later than 24 hours after the game has been played. Any other protest must be filed in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
14. **Score Sheets:**

Each bowler is responsible to enter their own scores and initials on the recap sheets each game. The "A" bowlers, and "E" bowlers at the Mid Year Extravaganza, on the pair is responsible to present the recap sheet to the tournament staff after each game. Failure to do so will result in a "0" for each game the score sheet is not provided for the "A" bowler as well as any score that has not been entered or initialed. The "A" bowler and "E" bowler have until all bowlers are finished for the round to turn the sheets in.
15. **Bowling Ball Surface:**

Bowlers may alter the surface of any of their bowling balls during practice sessions. Once practice concludes, bowlers may not alter the surface of any bowling ball for any reason. Any ball found to be altered from competition will be removed and will be returned to the bowler when they depart the event. Refusal to provide the ball to the tournament director will result in immediate disqualification.

Bowlers may not use rosin or powder on their equipment even if they wipe it off. Bowlers who do not abide by this rule will have the ball confiscated and it will be returned once the tournament has completed.
16. **Empowerment:**

The Tournament Director has the right to refuse any entry. The bowler, by voluntary participation in this tournament, acquiesces to the final authority of the Tournament Director to interpret and enforce all tournament rules, regulations and procedures. Any unforeseen or not described situation will be regulated by USBC rules with interpretive judgment guided by the best interests of youth bowling and this event. Any rule not covered by the tournament rules or the USBC rule book will be decided by the Tournament Director and their decision will be final.
