2020 TENNESSEE STATE USBC MIXED TOURNAMENT RULES

1. **RULES AND REGULATIONS:** United States Bowling Congress rules and regulations and those listed herein govern this tournament.
1. **ELIGIBILITY:** This tournament is open to all Tennessee State USBC members. If you are a member of another association outside of Tennessee, you must have at least 21 games in a 2019-20 winter season league in a Tennessee Local Association. Current membership cards must be presented at check-in. Should an entrant be unable to show their USBC Membership Card, fees will be collected from that player for individual membership fees.
2. **TOURNAMENT EVENTS:** The annual tournament shall consist of two as follows: Team – four person mixed (2 Women and 2 Men); and Doubles – two person mixed (1 man and 1 Women).
3. **AVERAGE AND HANDICAP:** A bowler's average shall be based on their highest 2018-19 sanctioned winter league average of 21 or more games in any one league. If no 2018-19 winter season average then entrant will use their highest current 2019-20 winter average of 21 or more games as of March 1, 2020. If no current average, then entrant may use 2019 Summer average of 21 or more games. Bowlers without acceptable averages will be accepted with a scratch average of 220. Handicap will be based on 90% of the difference in a bowler's average and 220. It shall be the bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average (USBC RULE 319a3). Entrants who have qualified for a prize of \$300 or more in any one event in a tournament, \$500 in any one tournament, or \$1000 in all tournament (Certified or not) in the last 12 months prior to bowling in this tournament must report their actual score, position, and the amount won to the Tournament Director prior to bowling for possible rerating (USBC RULE 319d). USBC RULE 319e in its entirety shall apply. USBC RULE 319a-2 (ten pin rule) shall apply. When the previous season's average is used and the entrant's current average as of March 1, 2019 for 21 or more games is 10 pins or higher, the current average must be used.
4. **AVERAGE VERIFICATION:** The average reported on the entry form must be verified by the Team Captain. **The Tournament Director may require all averages of prize winners to be certified by the local association manager within three weeks after the closing of the tournament.** Bowlers who use an incorrect average may be disqualified.
5. **REPLACEMENTS:** No one may bowl in this tournament except those originally entered before entries close or such replacements authorized by the team captain or their appointees. All replacements must qualify with the Tournament Rules and the captain will be responsible for the verification of their tournament average. No changes in the four-person team lineup will be permitted except in the case of replacements. A replacement will bowl in the same position as the bowler replaced.
6. **MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION:** A bowler may be permitted to bowl three (3) times in the team event and three (3) times in Doubles. No more than two players on the same team can place more than once in the prize list for position standings. You may only cash once in doubles with the same partner. (USBC RULE 315).
7. **PRIZE LIST:** Prize fund will be paid 100% in each event. At least one for eight (8) entries in each event.
8. **SCHEDULING:** All scheduling will be done by tournament management. **Please include note if you prefer to bowl on the same lanes with any other team or doubles entries.**
9. **ENTRY FEES AND REFUNDS:** No entry form will be accepted without entry fees. Also, all entry fees must be accompanied with complete entry forms or priority will be forfeited. **REFUNDS:** No team or individual shall be entitled to a refund after the entry fees have been received and definite dates assigned. Returned checks will incur a \$25 service fee.
10. **REBOWLING GAMES OR FRAMES:** If a tournament game or frame(s) within a game are irretrievable lost in the scoring process, the TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR may approve:
 - a. Re-Bowling, starting immediately.
 - b. Re-Scheduling, if possible
 - c. Refunding entry fees for that particular event and all events if bowler is eligible for all events and can't be rescheduled.
11. **PRACTICE BOWLING:** Practice games are not permitted on the lanes on which the entrants are scheduled to bowl within one hour prior to their scheduled times. Each entrant shall obtain clearance from the Tournament Director before practicing.
12. **BOWLERS DRESS CODE:** While competing, proper attire shall include shirts with sleeves, dress slacks or jeans, dress shorts. No tank tops, cutoffs, swimsuits, or spandex. NO OBSCENE ATTIRE. All issues to proper attire will be decided upon by the tournament management.
