Enjoy afternoon tea with the innkeepers of the historic George Starrett House, built in 1889. Known by architectural enthusiasts to be one of the most iconic Victorian homes in America, George Starrett built this mansion as a second anniversary gift for is wife, Ann, at a cost of \$60,000.

The uniqueness of the house lies in the staircase and tower. Called a "two-tiered" free floating staircase, it is one of the last of its kind in the United States. The magnificent "Four Seasons" fresco painted on the tower ceiling serves as a solar calendar when light pours through the gabled windows.

The Starrett House Inn is one of the few remaining Port Townsend bed & breakfast inns and is managed by Bayside Housing & Services.
