- The historic clock has a rich history, including its maintenance and repair. The clock mechanism was originally installed in 1891 by the E. Howard Watch & Clock Company of Boston.
- Over the years, the clock has undergone various repairs and refurbishments, most recently in 1975. It is currently under repair after sticking at 9:56 for months.
- The clock has served as the town's unofficial timekeeper since it began tolling – and has been a long-standing feature of our community.
