FREE & Family Friendly Fort Worden State Park, Port Townsend

Join us for a delightful stroll in the park along the parade grounds of Fort Worden. Dress in your afternoon best to celebrate the turn of the 20th century. Explore the Commanding Officer's Quarters (COQ) and learn about the innovations and cultural changes that marked the transition from the Victorian era to the Edwardian age. Enjoy a picnic on the porch of the COQ museum, play a game of chess or checkers, and try your hand at croquet on the lawn. There will be scavenger hunts for all ages and coloring pages for children.

The COQ Museum will be open from 11 AM to 4 PM, and snacks will be served until they run out. Entry to the museum is free, though donations are greatly appreciated.
