

Church=Hypocrites

- Church is full of sinners
- Church is full of fighting/disagreements/denominations
- Church is full of fakeness
- Church is full of "holier than thou"
- Church is full of Pharisees
- Church is full of falsehood
- Church is full of half-heartedness
- Church is full of pseudo-faith believers
- Church is full of hypocrites

A Room of Hypocrites

Church=Redeemed

- "Such were some of you" (1 Cor 6.11)
- "Sorrow led to repentance" (2 Cor 7.9-11)
- "Made us alive" (Eph 2.3-5)
- "There has already been enough time" (1 Pet 4.3-4)



A ROOM OF HYPOCRITES

Church=Proof

- Our change from sinner to saved should convince (1 Pet 2.11-12)
- Our change should be thorough (2 Cor 7.11)
- Our change should display God's goodness (Mat 5.16)
- Our change should display God's forgiveness (1 Jon 1.9; 2.1-2)
- Our way of living should please men (Rom 14.18; 2 Cor 8.21)
- The answer is not in pretending to be better than we are it is in BEING better than we currently are.
 - Involves sincere righteousness
 - Involves transparency about our effort
 - Involves focusing on God instead of self (or condemning others)

A Room of Hypocrites

Church=Spiritual

- When we are called hypocrites:
 - If we deserve it, we must change
 - If we are misunderstood, we should explain
 - If we are unfairly accused, we should live more righteously
 - In all cases, we should be turning the attention to the God who doesn't fail and is exactly who He claims to be
- We are the physical world's connection to a spiritual God

A Room of Hypocrites

Church=Display

- Without God, there is no reason for:
 - Forgiveness, peace, love, kindness. selflessness
- We are God's display of all that comes from a relationship with Him and with one another
