“Father, forgive them...”

- What did Jesus mean? Why pray for this?
- We must also live a life of forgiveness
- God does grant Jesus' request



PRAYERS FROM
THE CROSS

“My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?”

- This statement might not be a prayer
 - Doesn't begin the same way as every other prayer of Jesus
 - This statement assumes God's abandonment
 - It is a direct quote from Psalm 22
- Not being a prayer, this is not truly a request

“Father, into Your hands I commit My spirit.”

- Jesus declares His work complete
 - Quotes Ps 31.5
 - This psalm again declares Jesus as innocent, righteous, and pleasing to God
- We need to commit our souls to God!
