We do not supply life jackets or paddles for private vessels.

Prices include transportation (put in and take out), paddles, adult life jackets, 2 nights primitive camping. Additional night camping is \$10 per person, per night. Children age 7 and under get free camping. Life jackets have to be accessible in the boat. Children age 7 and under must wear a life jacket at all times. **Children's life jackets are not provided.**

Reservation Procedures

We recommend 2 people per canoe plus their gear except for special cases where there is an uneven number in a group or small children are joining the excitement.

Reservation Procedure: Weekend reservations need to be made by phone at least 3 weeks in advance. Please keep in mind that June, July and August are our busiest months. Payment in full as deposit is required 14 days prior to the float date. Payment can me made by credit card or money order by mail. When sending money order please include:
1. The name of the person who made the reservation.
2. The date of the float.
3. Reference number.
Weekday floating available without a reservation.

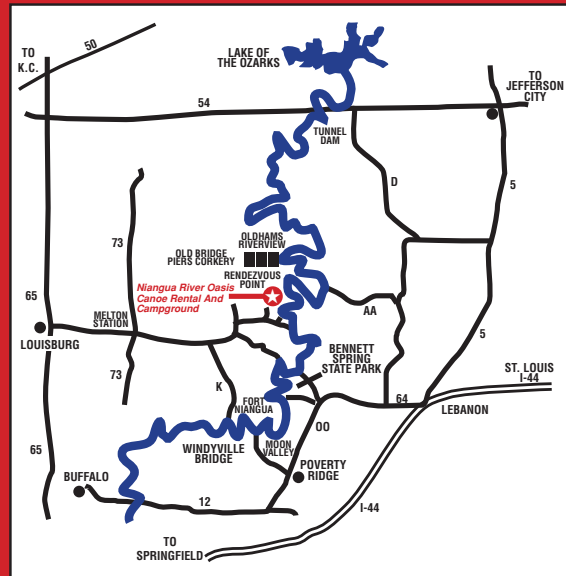
Directions

From Kansas City: 50 East to Sedalia, 65 South to Louisburg, left on 64 East, 14 miles to Corkery Rd. Follow NRO Signs 2 1/2 miles

From St. Louis: 1-44 West to 2nd Lebanon Exit, turn right off ramp, to 64 West, Approx. 18 miles to Corkery Rd. Follow NRO Signs 2 1/2 miles

From Springfield: 65 North to Louisburg, turn right on 64 East, 14 miles to Corkery Rd. Follow NRO Signs 2 1/2 miles

From Wichita, KS: 54 East to 65 South at Preston, MO to Louisburg, MO, then left to 64 East, 14 miles to Corkery Rd. Follow NRO Signs 2 1/2 miles

Campground Rules and Regulations

Campers are responsible for knowing and complying with the rules and regulations:

NOTICE!

Non-compliance of campground rules could result in eviction of campground. No money will be refunded!

1. All **radios** must be kept at a moderate volume level and must be turned **off 12 midnight to 6 a.m.**
2. Quiet time is from 12 midnight through 6 a.m. All vehicles must be parked and remained parked after 10 p.m. **NON-COMPLIANCE CAN RESULT IN EVICTION** from campground.
3. Speed limit is **5 mph** in campground.
4. No **ATVs** or **dirt bikes**. **No firearms!! No fireworks!!**
5. No glass bottles, no beer bong, no kegs or containers containing more than 4 gallon of alcohol.
6. No **littering- dumpster and trash bags are available**. Please, **no cans or bottles** in fire rings.
7. Do not **cut, mar or damage** trees.
8. Pets must be kept on a leash at all times while in the campground and are the responsibility of the owner. **No aggressive dogs.**
9. **We do not allow firewood to be brought in to our campground. We sell firewood at both NRO stores, due to the Ash Borer Beetle invasion.**

We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone. The Missouri State Water Patrol and the Dallas County Sheriff's Department make periodic, unscheduled patrols in the campground.

NRO Security and Dallas County Deputies patrol the campground on Friday and Saturday. If you have any problems the NRO office is open 24 hours on Friday and Saturday until 2 a.m.

Quiet Hours Policy Please be respectful of neighboring campers. Our quiet hours are from 12 midnight to 6 a.m. All radios are to be turned off at 12 midnight. Normal noise level is to be maintained all hours. Security will enforce quiet hours when necessary. Guests that are repeatedly asked to adhere to quiet hours policy will be escorted off NRO property. If a camper next to you is being disruptive or inappropriate at anytime, please mention this to security or the store staff. If you are removed off the property for noise infraction or inappropriate behavior there is no refund or rain check.

Vehicle Policy All vehicles must be registered at the store. Any vehicles on premise without a car tag will be sent back to check in for proper registration.

FLOATING POLICY Absolutely no glass in canoes, rafts or kayaks. It's the law!

Floating is both good exercise and great fun experienced in the outdoors. It is an enjoyable way to spend a day with friends and family. As a participant you have responsibilities, one should always show courtesy to your fellow floaters, which also includes the Niangua River Oasis Staff. Be aware as with any sport there is some inherent risk that personal awareness and common sense can reduce. Never float under the influence of drugs or alcohol. We provide a litter bag with each floating vessel, keep it until the end of the trip. Observe all posted signs and warnings.

* The Missouri State Water Patrol patrols these waters. Most property along the river's edge is privately owned and is often marked with purple paint meaning NO TRESPASSING! Please do NOT stop or camp on those bluffs or riverbanks.

Rain Check/Weather Policy Inclement weather for activities is up to the discretion of NRO management. If it is raining on the day of your float we will issue a rain check. Rain check is good for one year from the date issued.

Cancellation Policy is 14 days in advance after 14 days there is **no refund** it goes on a rain check/credit policy that's good for 1 year. If flooding is an issue and the river is not floatable, there is **no refund** and your reservation would go on a rain check/credit policy good for 1 year.

Floating Liability Waiver/Vehicle Check-In Forms: All vehicles must stop and register before entering campground. Floating Liability Waiver/Vehicle Check-In forms are available on-line at nrocanoe.com. Have form completed before arrival and hand in at time of check in. Each adult must sign for themselves.

We cannot assume responsibility for personal injury, medical payments or property loss or damage. You will be asked to acknowledge this by signing a liability waiver before the outing begins. The cost of your float does include: transportation, the normal use of the vessel, paddles, trash bag and life jackets. Please treat our canoes, rafts, kayaks and equipment with the same respect as if they were your own. We expect normal wear and tear on our canoes and for that we do not charge. In the event a canoe or raft is damaged beyond normal wear and tear, then we expect to be reimbursed appropriately in relation to the damage. If you abandon your canoe or raft or it is lost or stolen, you will be asked to pay for it. If everyone follows the rules of common courtesy, every floater will have a safe and rewarding adventure.
