NOTE: In order to comply with the provisions of Wisconsin Statutes [s. 95.21 (2)] and Administrative Codes [s. ATCP 11.52], relating to the Statewide Rabies Control Program, the owner of any dog kept or exhibited in Wisconsin (other than a dog kept for educational or scientific purposes) shall have the dog vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian at no later than 5 months of age and revaccinated within one year after the initial vaccination. Any person (including out-of-state exhibitors) who imports a dog into Wisconsin (for exhibition or any other purpose) must have a valid interstate health certificate or certificate of veterinary inspection for that dog, regardless of the age of the dog. The certificate must be completed by a veterinarian; accompany the dog when it enters this state; and indicate the current vaccination status of the dog. Vaccinations shall be administered by a veterinarian and comply with age and time standards and label instructions approved by the federal bureau for the type of vaccine used. Additional information regarding these regulations may be obtained from the Wisconsin State Veterinarian at (608) 224-4888.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

- **BUILDINGS WILL BE OPEN AT NOON ON THURSDAY, JULY 25, 2024.**
- **\$7.00 PER CARLOAD PER DAY OR \$20.00 FOR THREE DAYS FOR ALL VEHICLES. ALL CARS MUST ENTER GATE 1 & MUST STOP. NOTE: We will NOT accept \$100.00 bills! Credit cards will be accepted.**
- **CATALOGS WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE GATE & INFORMATION TABLE UNTIL SOLD OUT.**
- Summer attire is encouraged for our three days of Summer Splash events. Stay cool, but no shorts or swimsuits please.
- No unentered Dogs allowed.
- Indoor Restrooms. NO DOGS PERMITTED IN THE SHOWERS OR LAVATORIES.
- Restrooms & Show Location are handicapped accessible.
- NO GROOMING will be allowed in the Arena Building.
- Dogs may be crated in Arena Mezzanine.
- NO PRIVATE EXERCISE PENS ALLOWED IN ANY BUILDING.
- NO PRIVATE TENTS OR POP-UPS WILL BE ALLOWED WITHIN 20 FT OF ANY RING (except Dane & Malamute ring). All tents must be set so poles are **at least 10 feet from ring stanchions.**
- No Pop-Ups may be set up until ALL RINGS are set by the Superintendent.
- ALL EZ UP TENTS MUST BE STAKED DOWN.
- EXCELLENT FOOD WILL BE SERVED IN THE CAFETERIA FRIDAY, SATURDAY & SUNDAY AT 7:00 A.M., ADDITIONAL FOOD CHOICES WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE FOOD STAND.
- NO picnics allowed on the show grounds. Expo will charge a \$50.00 fee or ask the food to be immediately removed. Picnics at RV sites only. Picnics allowed on Friday if an approved Combined Specialty Club.
- Armbands available at ringside. Know your number before requesting an armband.
- Please keep aisles as clear as possible at ring areas.
- CRATES WILL BE ALLOWED UNDER THE TENT AREA WHEN YOUR BREED IS BEING JUDGED. ALL CRATES MUST BE REMOVED AFTER THE COMPLETION OF THE JUDGING OF YOUR BREED.
- DOG CRATES IN GROOMING BUILDING MUST HAVE A CONTACT NUMBER ON THEM IN CASE OF EMERGENCY.
- No dogs that are disqualified for aggression will be allowed to enter these Shows, nor be allowed to be on the grounds. In addition, no aggression reinstatement procedures will be performed at these Shows.
- Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs with their own equipment in the entire facility, including Ex-pens. There will be public scoop stations on the show grounds.
- When a club member/volunteer asks you to do something, please realize that they are doing this to follow regulations and do NOT take any irritations out on them. We will not hesitate to ask you to leave if we feel you are being abusive.
- Club tables allowed only adjacent to the ring under the tent. No tables may be set in aisles, or adjacent to the ring which affects any passageway between rings or set of rings.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:

It is understood that each club associated with the Waukesha Summer Splash Shows reserve the right to substitute any unavailable prize(s) with one(s) of equal or greater value. Prizes must be claimed the day of the show(s). None will be mailed. Unclaimed prizes will become property of the club which offered said prize.

EXPO RULES AND RV GUIDELINES

THESE RULES WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. Anyone who either ignores the directions of the Parks staff at the gate or bypasses them in some manner will be subject to an Event Committee Hearing, per the Waukesha Kennel Club, Inc.

- The only vehicles allowed within the show area (within 50' of all rings), are First Aid, Security, Expo Staff, and Waukesha Kennel Club, Inc. dog show staff. All private golf carts, utility vehicles, and ATVs must be used around the outer perimeter of the event.
- Day RV Parking ONLY in Gate #1. No overnight parking will be allowed. Anyone who chooses not to abide by this rule will be asked to move their RV to the overnight RV parking area through Gate #3 and will be required to pay the appropriate overnight fees. Noncompliance will result in your RV being towed at your expense.
- Entrance to RV Camping is Gate #3. Upon arrival to Gate #3, participants will need to provide a copy of their registration confirmation. Once registration has been verified, a parking pass will be provided to be displayed in the window of the RV. Access to Gate #3 is limited to:
 - o Recreational vehicles with proper parking pass displayed in the window.
 - o Handler/Exhibitor vehicles with proper parking forms displayed in window. One vehicle per site. Any handler/exhibitors without proper parking confirmations must enter through Gate #1 and use the designated "Handler Drop Off area."
 - o Club members and workers with appropriate pass (Friday – Sunday).
- After 10:00 P.M., RVs are welcome to enter Gate #3 to be staged in Arena West Parking Lot until the next morning. No electrical hookups available. Wednesday arrivals are welcome from 3:00 P.M. until 10:00 P.M. and Thursday - Saturday 6:00 A.M. until 10:00 P.M.
- A noise curfew is in effect from 10:00 P.M. until sunrise. This applies to all types of loud noises, including, but not limited to, music and stereos. Please be considerate of your neighbors so everyone can have a pleasant time.
- Grills are allowed by individual RV sites only, not on the show grounds. Hot coals should not be dumped into Expo trash containers or dumpsters. Absolutely NO campfires of any kind are allowed.
- No tent camping will be allowed.
- All dogs must be kept on a 6 feet or less leash, unless in designated dog show rings.
- All campers are responsible for cleaning up and properly disposing of all trash, recyclable items and dog droppings. Place items in proper receptacles found throughout the Expo Grounds. Failure to follow this rule may result in additional charges or not being allowed to camp on-site for future shows.
- Cancellations of RV Camping and Handler Parking: A full refund will be given if canceled on or before July 17, 2024. If canceled July 17, 2024 or later, the reservation fee will be forfeited.

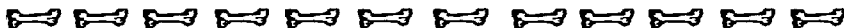

To continue to compete in AKC events beyond the initial 30-day period the dog must be either individually AKC registered or by the date of the event have been granted an extension to exhibit using the foreign registration. THE CLUB AND ITS SUPERINTENDENT caution all persons entering the show site and show grounds against all hazards which may exist, including, but not limited to: Condition of the site/grounds, parking/loading/unloading areas, entrances, floors and stairways, elevators and escalators, floor coverings, walkways, tenting/canopies, electrical appliances, cords and fittings, exercise pens, and the presence of animals. All persons should take into consideration this is a sporting event and dress, act and exercise caution appropriate for the activity involved. All persons entering the show, the grounds, site and show areas for whatever purpose do so entirely at their own risk. By virtue of entering the show, the entrant has indicated their acceptance of the terms listed in this premium list and assumes all risks involved.

The following breeds must be judged on a Ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Lagotti Romagnoli, Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Cirnechi dell'Etna, Kerry Blue Terriers, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows, Keeshonden. Breeds designated as ramp optional may, at the discretion of the judge, be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition. Judges may request the ramp to judge any breed in emergency situations; if granted, unless the use of a ramp has been indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.

Junior Showmanship judges should follow the above.

Entries must be accompanied by a cover sheet stating the number of pages, what shows and how many dogs per show. Visa/Mastercard/Discover/American Express number and expiration date, as well as the printed cardholder's name and address must be included on cover sheet. Visa/Mastercard/Discover/American Express number, expiration date and cardholder's name must appear on each entry. Fax entries must be received by the closing hour/date. Fax fee: \$4.95 per entry in addition to entry fee. All credit card entries, regardless of method submitted, are processed through the Fax program and are charged the \$4.95 administrative fee. This Fax Fee is subject to change without notice.

Post Dated Checks, Returned Checks and Declined Credit Cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check or declined card. Subsequent returned checks or declined cards from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY** basis.

CHARGEBACKS on Credit Cards are considered a violation of your agreement to pay the required entry fee for entry into a show and the AKC Compliance Dept. will be notified for their disciplinary action. Also, if this remains a bad debt, the club may decline future entries for their shows and the superintendent will decline future entries for ANY show submitted via any method of payment until the debt is paid (Chap 11, Sec 15, AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows). Thereafter, the superintendent will refuse all future credit card entries from the exhibitor. All future entries must be paid for in cash or by money order or check.

An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 first entry only and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 for first entry and \$3.50 for each additional entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 will be required for each first entry and \$3.50 each additional entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. An AKC Event Service Fee of \$2.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Open Show. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions.)

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the event, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made. No Refund for Duplicate Entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. **An Administrative Fee of \$5.00 will be charged or withheld from refunds for duplicate entries.**

An Administrative Fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.

Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Each Owner and Agent listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog at a show is bound by the Certification and Agreement on the front and back of the entry form regardless of who may have completed & submitted the entry form.

As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.**

Judges Will Not Wait for Any Dog Holding Up a Class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

Class Cash Prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Superintendent's Office advised at once. The Superintendent and Show-Giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.

HOW TO USE THE ENTRY BLANK

Use one entry blank per dog only if information is exactly the SAME for each event. Carefully check the block (blocks) for each event in which you wish to enter your dog. You MUST use a SEPARATE entry blank if you are entering your dog in a different class on different events.

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
