

#### Responsive Reading Mark 12:28-33, Romans 13:8-10 (KJV)

Minister: And one of the scribes came, and having heard them reasoning together, and perceiving that he had answered them well, asked him, Which is the first commandment of all?

Congregation: And Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord: And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment.

Minister: And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these.

Congregation: And the scribe said unto him, Well, Master, thou hast said the truth: for there is one God; and there is none other but he: And to love him with all the heart, and with all the understanding, and with all the soul, and with all the strength, and to love his neighbor as himself, is more than all whole burnt offerings and sacrifices.

Minister: Owe no man anything, but to love one another: for he that loveth another hath fulfilled the law.

All: For this, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not kill, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Thou shalt not covet; and if there be any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself.

Minister: Love worketh no ill to his neighbor: therefore love is the fulfilling of the law.

All: Be still, and know that I am God: I will be exalted among the

heathen, I will be exalted in the earth.

Minister: The LORD of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our refuge.
