



POSITIONING

There are many *positions* you can use to make shots when in the field. The use of shooting sticks is a great way to steady your shot. In addition, using things such as backpacks, trees, bipods, your hunting partner, rocks, hay bales, or fences are also useful tools.

A prone position is the most steady and accurate way to shoot. Lying flat on the ground with your rifle directly in front of you makes for a very rock-solid form. Prone also allows you to use your full body to absorb recoil and acquire the target much faster.
