

Proper trigger squeeze makes for good shots. Proper trigger squeeze is almost an art. This is when the trigger breaks (sets the firing pin) and it's almost a surprised. I say almost. After some practice, you should know fairly close at what point in the process the trigger should break. Jerking the trigger to make the gun fire will surely result in a poor shot. Proper trigger squeeze is achieved by applying stead pressure with you finger. Use only the pad at the end of your finger and first knuckle contacting the trigger.
