GOP Women Sign Letter Promoting Election Integrity to Alexandria’s General Assembly Legislators

ALEXANDRIA, VA –

The Commonwealth Republican Women’s Club (CRWC) of Alexandria focused its January meeting on legislation being proposed in Virginia’s General Assembly with a special focus on election integrity.

A panel of CRWC members including Susie Miller, Eileen Brackens, Linda Greenberg, and Susan Yonts-Shepard provided an overview of legislation being proposed by the Democrat majority. The legislation covered issues related to: changing Electoral College rules; eliminating single family zones throughout the Commonwealth; eliminating parental consent for certain healthcare for minors; abolishing the death penalty; limiting self-defense options and Second Amendment rights; legalizing casinos; allowing mandated union membership; and changing rules for voter registration and voter ID requirements.

CRWC President Linda App said that “Preventing voter fraud is of keen interest to our club, and should be for all Americans regardless of political persuasion. We want the General Assembly to hear our voice and know that we oppose any legislation that would threaten election integrity.”

Club members signed a letter that will be sent to each of the five General Assembly members representing various Senate and House of Delegates districts in Alexandria. The letter expressed the club members’ sincere concern for election integrity and concern that some proposed legislation would facilitate voter fraud. It referenced a recent *Judicial Watch* report from its Election Integrity Project asserting that the

number of registered voters in Virginia exceeds the number of citizens of voting age by 90,000 (and in our own city of Alexandria by 6,000), a clear indication of potential voter fraud.

CRWC is the Alexandria chapter of both the Virginia and the National Federation of Republican Women (VFRW and NFRW). CRWC encourages local Republican women of all ages to become more politically involved by helping support and elect GOP candidates to public office at the local, state, and national levels.
