8th Congressional District: Clarification on Candidates

Please be aware that there are only two GOP candidates who met the qualifying requirements and who are still in the running as Republicans for the 8th Congressional District race: Mark Ellmore and Jeff Jordan. Either Ellmore or Jordan will be the Republican nominee determined May 30 in a party process based on the votes of registered delegates. The deadline to register as a delegate for this event has passed. The 8th Congressional District encompasses all of Alexandria, and portions of other nearby areas.

Two other Republican candidates for Congress in the 8th District did not meet certain qualifying requirements established by the GOP, but have decided to continue to run as Independent candidates: Heerak Christian Kim and Mike Webb. There may be some confusion on this point since they started their campaigns as Republicans, but switched parties in order to appear on the ballot.

To summarize, the Republican nominee for the 8th District Congressional seat will be either Mark Ellmore or Jeff Jordan, and CRWC will support the party nominee and the rest of the GOP slate in the November elections.

Republican Election Officers Needed to Ensure Voting Integrity

Judicial Watch has identified Virginia as one of 38 states with more registered voter than citizens of voting age (CVAs) in its 2019 Election Integrity Project. Almost 90,000 registrations fit that category Virginia-wide. In Alexandria, over 6,000 registrations fit that description. Scary, right? So we must all work to ensure election integrity. Being an Election Officer is one of eight key steps to stop voter fraud, according to Judicial Watch. Our local Republican party is trying to recruit more poll workers for Election Day because most of the poll workers in Alexandria are Democrats. We need to be represented to ensure fairness. Please consider being one of those patriots willing to work up an entire day (about 5 am to 9 pm) to prevent voter fraud and ensure fair elections. Some CRWC members are Election Officers (Kimberly Pinter for one), and can let you know what it's like. Contact CRWC Leadership or ARCC Chairman Sean Lenehan so we can keep track of how many Republicans are signing up.



That said there are probably Republican equivalents.

GOP Women Discuss Outreach to Minority Communities with Shared Values

ALEXANDRIA, VA –

The Commonwealth Republican Women's Club (CRWC) of Alexandria focused its February meeting on enhancing communications with minority groups.

Former Alexandria Vice Mayor Bill Cleveland and former city council candidate Fernando Torrez, both Republicans, shared their thoughts on ways to connect with minority communities. Cleveland emphasized the need for voting on values and principles, rather than feelings and emotions, and how that change in perspective will help bring more conservative minorities into the Republican party. He praised the work of the Douglas Leadership Institute (DLI) (<https://www.dlinstitute.org/>), named for Frederick Douglas, which focuses on the concepts of righteousness, justice, liberty, and virtue. DLI is not a political organization, but is engaged in many issues from with a conservative viewpoint.

Torrez, President of NanoTech and a former candidate for city council, provided insights into the concerns and experiences of the local Latino community. He said they share conservative values and are deeply concerned about finding work. Torrez spoke of a program he initiated to teach technical skills to inmates and Latino immigrants to prepare them for joining the local workforce.
