Some people are confused about Fountain of Life in Belle Center; they chose to create a business selling only our products. They chose in 2011 to concentrate on weight reducing "commercial" made products and continue to sell our Herbal Sprays. They chose their own names for the products, same as any store can do. Some rumors had floated around that Fountain of Life had been inspected, shut down, etc. and these are just rumor, they have never been inspected or told they could not sell any herbal products, they chose to change brands on their own. We personally gave Fountain of Life our Amish customer's names over the years and allowed them to have all our Amish business while we concentrated on an internet business that has reached individual people world wide. Fountain of Life is local to us, so they purchased all products in 5 gallon buckets and bottled themselves, anyone can do this! We provide 5 gallon bucket or 55 gallon drums for pick up orders only.

We desire our products to only be sold in Amish stores or privately; we do not seek commercial sales in common "public" stores. Homemade products of all kinds are not suitable for commercial stores such as Wal-Mart and corporation type stores. The herbs sold in these types of commercial stores have been radiated and made so weak, no one is expected to have increased health results that could result in a healing crisis or any symptoms of a body increasing in health and being able to expel waste/disease. Such products are mass produced in China by slave labor.

Our products are made by one person, ME! I have been doing so for over 15 years for my family's health and all those that want to try what we have tried. My passion has been herbal formula making for close to 20 years and I am certainly the largest private manufacture of old fashioned herbs in North America. I know it takes years to make the best herbal products, while commercial companies use machines that produce a finished product from the cheapest raw sources they could purchase from in the same day.
