## PRIMARY DENTITION

Central incisor	8-12 months	6-7 years
Lateral incisor	9-13 months	7-8 years
Canine (cuspid)	16-22 months	10-12 years
First molar	13-19 months	9-11 years
Second molar	25-33 months	10-12 years

Lower Teeth	Erupt	Exfoliate
Second molar	23-31 months	10-12 years
First molar	14-18 months	9-11 years
Canine (cuspid)	17-23 months	9-12 years
Lateral incisor	10-16 months	7-8 years
Central incisor	6-10 months	6-7 years

## PERMANENT DENTITION

Poor health in the womb does not provide the building blocks for good, strong bones and the health of the teeth is an example of the total bone health in my opinion. The undernourished baby will develop teeth too quickly and most likely have more dental disease. Many toddlers today have rotten teeth before age 5 and most baby teeth have serious cavities by the time they fall out that harms the health of the adult tooth coming in.
