Simple Summer Salmon Contributed by Jake Kelly, CCSWCD

Ingredients

1 large salmon filet, salt and pepper, 1 lemon sliced thinly, 1 clove of garlic minced, 1 tbs butter thinly sliced, thyme & oregano to taste

Directions

- 1. preheat grill to 400 degrees F
- 2. prepare 2 sheets of aluminum foil 6" longer than filet & grease one side that salmon will be placed on
- 3. center filet on greased foil, skin side down
- 4. evenly season with salt, pepper, minced garlic, thyme, & oregano
- 5. place lemon slices & butter on top of filet, squeeze remaining lemons over
- 6. wrap top with second piece of foil and crimp, cook on medium for 18-20 min or until 145 degrees internally
- 7. remove and let rest 5 minutes, serve with steamed vegetables/rice
