Habitat: Little brown bat inhabits trees, bat houses, and buildings, usually choosing a hot attic, where

nursery colonies of hundreds and even thousands form. In the west colonies have been found beneath bridges and in caves. Groups of males occasionally occur in caves.

Diet: Omnivore

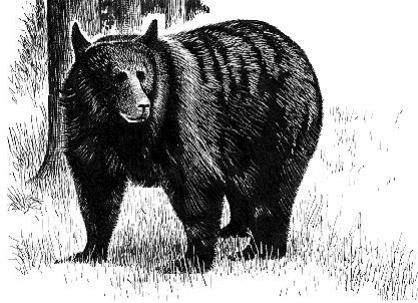
Range: Widely distributed throughout North America. Presently found in northern Mexico, 32 states of the United States, and all the provinces and territories of Canada except Prince Edward Island.

Habitat: Normally found only in forested areas, but within such habitat they are highly adaptable. They live in both arid and moist forests, from sea level to over 2,000 meters (6,560 feet).

northern most parts of Canada, Florida the desert Southwest and Mexico.

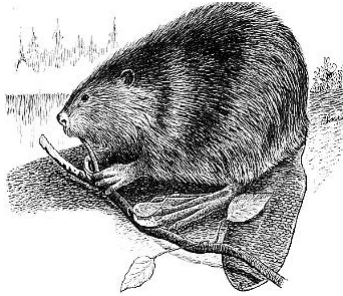
Habitat: Beavers live near rivers, streams, ponds, small lakes and marshes. They build lodges of sticks and mud on islands, on pond banks or on lake shores

Range: The white-tailed deer can be found in southern Canada and most of the

United States, except for the Southwest, Alaska and Hawaii.

Habitat: The white-tailed deer lives in wooded areas. In some areas, deer overpopulation is a problem. Gray wolves and mountain lions used to be predators of the white-tailed deer and helped keep their population under control. But because of hunting and human development, there are not very many wolves and mountain lions left in some parts of North America.

all of Europe and Britain, and almost all of Asia, including Japan. There are also several populations in North Africa.

Habitat: The red fox prefers the edges of forests, tilled fields and near marshes but they can be found on farmland, beaches, prairies, woodlands and both alpine and arctic tundra.

Range: Raccoons range from Canada and throughout the United States (excluding the

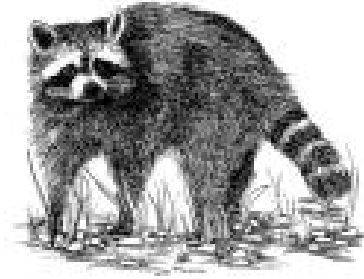
high elevations of the Rocky Mountains and much of the Southwest) into Mexico and Central America.
