National High School Finals

- As outlined and required by the NHSRA By-Laws and Rulebook.

Mid-Winter Meeting/Prom

- Update the general membership on all activities at the National level that would be of interest or impact the State Association.

State Finals

- Update the general membership on all activities at the National level that would be of interest or impact the State Association.

General Duties and Responsibilities

- Monitor the State Association to insure all governing rules of the NHSRA are followed and proper business and finance procedures are conducted.
- Act as a coordinator in all State sanctioned rodeos. Any flagrant abuse will be brought to the attention of the National Director.
- Use best efforts to resolve at the State level all disputes and issues arising from Rodeo events and/or operations of the State Association.
- Oversee and coordinate the duties of the junior high division. The National Director may appoint or select a Junior High Director for his State. The National Director has the same authority and responsibilities within the Junior High Division as outlined in the NHSRA By-laws and Rulebook for the High School Division.

- Serve as a member of the State Association Board of Directors.
- Apprise and communicate to the Board and General membership regarding activities of other State Associations that may be of benefit or interest to the Indiana High School Rodeo Association.
- Facilitate and insure the State Association is optimizing from all the benefits of being an NHSRA Member Association including benefits from National Sponsors.
