The Bo-Boen Snowmobile Club is super excited to be a recipient of a 2024 Tourism Development Grant from the **St. Germain Chamber of Commerce**. The Grant was used to purchase a u-blade plow for one of the Tucker Sno-cat groomers. The plow will be instrumental in breaking down high banks along with improving trail safety by widening trails where possible.

The Club currently deploys a New Holland tractor, two Tucker Sno-cats, and associated drags. This addition to our grooming equipment is part of a nearly \$900,000 investment to make St. Germain's snowmobile trails the best in the area.

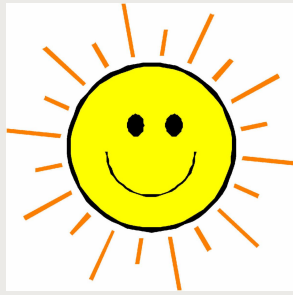
