Once your membership is verified, a ballot will be mailed to you with a return envelope. After you have completed the ballot, it will need to be sent back by U.S. mail to P.O. Box 192, Saint Germain WI 54558. Ballots must be received by March 14 to be counted. Absentee ballots must be returned in the envelope provided, sealed, and mailed. Providing and returning ballots via email is not permitted so please allow sufficient time for U.S. Mail if voting by absentee ballot. Voting by proxy is not permitted.

Family memberships, map advertisers, and landowners get two votes; Single memberships get one vote.
