ESIDENT'S MESSAGE



It is mid-May and many of us have summer-ized the sleds and are planning our snowmobile trips for next season. But there are Bo-Boen fund raising events before the next season begins that need your support. Our first event is the Snowmobile Hall of Fame Classic

Sled Round Up happening on Sunday, May 28th at the St. Germain Community Park, where we will be selling food and beverages along with our Bo-Boen banners. Our next fundraising event, the Bo-Boen Golf Tournament, is on August 27th at the St. Germain Golf Course. The Chamber of Commerce's Bingo has been canceled this summer because enough volunteers could not be found to set-up and take down the tables and chairs (to keep the Community Center gymnasium open requires putting up and taking down 72 tables and 432 chairs every Monday). Another opportunity to participate in a Bo-Boen activity is St. Germain's Independence Day Celebration on July 2nd, where we will be in the parade and have a display. We look forward to seeing you at these events.

The Town of St. Germain Board of Supervisors has approved a draft revision to its Code of Ordinances to allow ATVs and UTVs to use Town roads yearround. This includes road routes used by snowmobiles. The ATV Club has committed to adding or removing the necessary signage to keep ATVs and UTVs off of the snowmobile trails. The Board of Supervisors will take public comments pertaining to this draft revision at 6:30 pm on May 25th at the Community Center. As an option to attending the meeting, written comments may be submitted to the Town Clerk, P.O. Box 7, St. Germain, WI 54558. Click here to review the draft ordinance. Written comments must be received by the Clerk no later than May 24, 2023, to be considered.

In addition, due to the unexpected passing of our long-time Secretary, Kay Schultz, the Board also unanimously approved a motion to appoint Roxanne Platz to fill the remainder of Kay's term. BECOME A SNOWMOBILE SAFETY INSTRUCTOR!

I have contacted the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources regarding providing in-person training for new instructors, and as a result, we will be hosting a one-day class with Kate Juza from the DNR in the near future. If you have an interest in attending, please contact me.

We typically hold one Safety Class per year, on the second weekend of December, for our very eager students. The class is from 8:30 - 3:00 on Saturday, and 9:00 - noon on Sunday. It is an extremely rewarding day and a half working with these students who really want to be safe, respectful snowmobilers. The DNR has stated to us, "you will help save lives" by teaching this class. Considering our past season, many of you are wondering what you can do to promote safety: this is one meaningful way! Not all students are children; we also usually have several adult students attend.

If we have enough instructors, we could hold more than one Safety Class per year, opening the opportunity up to more students. Please give this some careful thought and consider becoming a Safety Instructor.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Town of St. Germain Board of Supervisors will take public comments pertaining to a draft revision to its Code of Ordinances at 6:30PM, May 25, 2023, at the St. Germain Community Center.

Proposed revisions:

<u>Chapter 30 – ATV / UTV Routes</u>, §30.05(C) OP-ERATION OF ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES AND UTILITY TERRIAN VEHICLES. It is proposed this section be revised to open Town roads to yearround ATV /UTV use.

Be further advised that said draft Code of Ordinance revision is on file for public inspection in the office of the Town Clerk and on the homepage of the St. Germain town website at <u>townofstgermain.org</u>.

As an option to attending the meeting, written comments may be submitted to the Town Clerk, P.O. Box 7, St. Germain WI 54558. Written comments must be received by the Clerk no later than May 24, 2020, to be considered.
