Chief argues against speed limit reduction

COEYMANS — Police Chief Douglas Keyer argued against lowering speed limits on town-owned road at the Aug. 26 meeting of the Coeymans Town Council.

The town in July initiated the process of requesting lower speed limits from the state, seeking a reduction to 30 mph on all roads owned by the town.

The request came on the heels of numerous complaints from local

residents on several town thoroughfares, claiming the current 40 mph speed limit is too high and that drivers exceed the limit, posing a danger.

The town does not have jurisdiction to change the speed limit unilaterally and must request the change through the state.

Town roads that have seen complaints from residents about speeding include Bushendorf, Biechman and Blossom Hill roads, where the speed limit is 40 mph.

Keyer said Aug. 26 that he had received a complaint about speeding on Bushendorf Road and stationed a police officer between Starr and Bushendorf roads for about 40 minutes to assess the situation.

"In those 40 minutes, [the officer] observed 47 vehicles," Keyer told the board. "The speed limit there is 40 [mph]. The top speed was 48 and only seven of the 47 cars she observed were driving 45 mph or more. I think

if people are observing speeding vehicles, I do believe it is an anomaly. I believe for the most part, the residents here in the town of Coeymans are abiding by the speed limits."

If the town were to be successful in reducing the speed limit on all town roads to 30 mph, it could pose more problems than it solves, Keyer said.

"I don't know that that's a great idea, in my person-

2nd annual River Fest to commemorate 9/11

COEYMANS — The second annual River Fest this weekend will commemorate the anniversary of the 9/11 terrorist attacks that killed 2,996 Americans on Sept. 11, 2001.

"This marks the 20th year after 9/11," River Fest organizer Rosemary McHugh said at the Aug. 26 meeting of the Coeymans Town Council.

On Sept. 11, 2001 — 20 years ago this Saturday — there were three attacks on the United States in New York, Washington and Pennsylvania.

Two decades later, River Fest will commemorate the event with a ceremony in Coeymans Landing, a parade and festival.

"This is our second year of having the River Fest," Town Supervisor George McHugh said. "It was a great success last year and it will be even better this year."

The inaugural festival took place in 2020 and memorialized the terrorist attacks, including the ringing of a replica of the Liberty Bell.

This year's two-day event will begin Friday and conclude Saturday.

"The second annual River Fest will be Sept. 10 and 11 at Coeymans Landing," George McHugh said. "Our patriotic event takes place on the weekend

The event will continue Saturday

with a parade and a classic and antique car show, with live music provided by In The Dust. There will also be hot-air balloon rides, a rock-climbing wall, and a dunk tank sponsored by the RCS Community Business Association, George McHugh said. There will also be an exotic bird display.

"We will finish out the evening with a fireworks show over the Hudson River," he added.

Festivalgoers should park in the parking lot of Pieter B. Coeymans Elementary School, 66 Church St., Coeymans, and the town will provide a shuttle service to the riverfront.

At the Aug. 26 town board meeting, elected officials thanked Rosemary McHugh and the festival's four major donors for their contributions to the festival and other local events — LafargeHolcim, Carver Companies, Callanan Industries and Wm. Biers, Inc.

"Not only are they major employers in our town, but they are also major taxpayers in this town and they are still contributing to a festival or to the Evenings on the Green or to the farmers market," the town supervisor said. "They are very generous donors [sic] and they should be recognized."

Admission to River Fest is free of charge.

Masking up for a new school year

RAVENA-COEYMANS-SELKIRK — Students and staff will be masking up as the 2021-22 school year kicks off this week and the COVID-19 pandemic continues.

"We are eager to welcome back our students," District Superintendent Brian Bailey said in a letter to families Sept. 3.

The district released the RCS Tiered Mitigation Reopening Plan last week detailing health and safety protocols that will be in place for the new academic year. The plan is fluid and could change as needed, Bailey said.

"This plan will continue to evolve as our reopening committees and all staff plan for all logistics needed for the smooth operation of our schools," Bailey said.

Under the plan, all students will return to in-person instruction. Last year, most schools switched to a hybrid form of instruction with both in-person and remote learning and students switching off from day to day.

This year, students and teachers will

return to the classroom, and other activities that may have been impacted by the virus outbreak will make a return.

"The district will employ a tiered mitigation approach, including components

including face masks, facilities cleaning, hand hygiene, contact tracing, quarantining, HVAC (ventilation) and surveillance testing," according to the plan.

Face masks — a controversial topic

among some families — were mandated for all schools in New York state by Gov. Kathy Hochul on Aug. 24 in an effort to prevent the spread of the COVID-19 virus.

"There is a clear recognition of the polarized views on masking and vaccination," according to the plan. "Our priority has been and will continue to be the safety of our staff and students... We will continue to employ the strategies that work best. The district will continue to endeavor to be responsible in terms of mitigating the spread of COVID, while balancing the provision of educational and extracurricular activities with the preservation of health and safety."

"These are challenging times and we are all similarly focused on the best interest of our students, our children."

Under the reopening plan, mitigation efforts will be based on levels of community transmission of the virus, from low to high. The goal is to keep kids in the classroom while at the same



cifically, but we just don't have the people." Town Supervisor George McHugh pointed out that Starr Road, where the officer was stationed to conduct a traffic analysis, is not a town-owned road and would not be affected by the speed limit reduction, but Bushendorf would. Route 143, a state road, would also not be impacted, he added. No county or state roads would be included in the speed limit reduction if the town were successful in its request to the state. "I can't think of any town road that shouldn't be 30 [mph]. Town," McHugh stressed. "I can think of lots of roads in the town that should be 30... I've had a lot of complaints about Bushendorf [Road], that's it's too

fast at 40." Town Councilman Daniel Baker told the police chief he still believes a reduced speed limit would be good for the community. "I respect your opinion, but I think it is the right thing to do," Baker said. "On Biechman [Road], they are flying." Town Councilman Brandon LeFevre noted on some roads the infrastructure may increase the perception of high speeds. "I think some of the problem lies in the width of the road, with Bushendorf and Jarvis, so it makes the speed feel a lot faster because you are that much closer to the oncoming vehicles," LeFevre said. The area has also become much more residential, McHugh added. "Thirty or 40 years

ago, there weren't a lot of homes on Bushendorf, and now it is loaded with homes," the town supervisor said. The police department will continue to assess the situation, Keyer said. "I can dedicate an officer to a specific town road for an hour or two to observe the traffic and come up with the speeds. I think that would be a prudent step," he said. But reducing the speed limit could complicate matters, Keyer said. "I just wanted to bring this up because if the complaints start flying in — if people are going like they normally would do, 35, 36 [mph] — now it's going to seem fast to the residents out there because the speed limit is 30," Keyer said. "I'm just not set up to handle that volume of complaints."

time ensuring health and safety. "The intent of the tiered approach is to find and maintain a balance between prioritizing health and safety of students and staff, and supporting the social, emotional, mental health of students and staff," according to the plan. "This tiered mitigation strategy is fluid and will be reviewed intermittently in order to ensure

the stated objections are being met." Mitigation efforts are based on guidance from the New York State Department of Health, the New York State Education Department and the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. They will be reviewed on a monthly basis, according to the school district. COVID-19 vaccinations are encouraged, but at this time not required, under the plan. Masks

are required indoors at all times, with exceptions for meals and during music classes. Social distancing at 3 feet will be practiced indoors in most situations, and 6 feet during meal times. Students and staff are to stay home when they are ill. Sports and performing arts will resume, with masking and other protocols varying depending on community transmission of the virus. The first day of school was Wednesday, Sept. 8.

Town government we can trust

Coeymans, now more than ever, we deserve a town government we can trust.

Our town is full of energetic and forward-looking residents who want to rethink and rebuild our hometown and restore some of the pride of the past. We have budding entrepreneurs seeking to make a go of things in our town, investing their energy and resources into bakeries, breweries, and bagel shops, and others restoring our storefronts, giving our storied golf course a second wind, and even celebrating our town through some spectacular murals. We have welcomed new families who are looking to put down roots here, and we are home to households that have been giving back to our town for generations. These people all deserve a trustworthy town government that is a wind at their backs. Unfortunately, we don't have that with the current administration.

I believe that I, along with my fellow A Team candidates Sara Pruikisma, Yvonne Shackelton, Sherle Slingerland, Tom Frese, and County Legislator candidate Kristen Geoghegan, have the will, the experience, and the commitment to deliver on this vision. I am running for town supervisor to bring TRUST back to our town government. I not only have a breadth of experience and the skill set required to competently and effectively manage our town affairs, but I have the integrity and backbone to do so with transparency, fidelity to the spirit of good governance, and a greater commitment to inviting and respecting the concerns and views of all community members.

As supervisor I am committed to the following priorities:

- Restoring ethics and accountability to elected and appointed town officials.
- Initiating a true open government, where as much information as possible is shared clearly with the public.
- Rebuilding cooperation with the village office and RCS Community Business Association on projects necessary to improving the town.
- Improving Town parks and buildings in a fiscally responsible and open way, through grants and practices proscribed by the Office of the State Comptroller.
- Executing efficiencies in government processes to cut costs and save money.
- Creating a five-year plan to responsibly budget for items and expenditures, stabilizing town finances.
- Investing town funds responsibly in savings and reserve accounts in order to earn more interest for the town.
- Updating out of date local laws in the town code.
- Working to make all members of the community feel heard

So, why should you expect me to be able to execute this plan and lead our town government forward? I believe that my hard work and dedication to our community these last few years answers that.

Since moving to Ravena, I worked at the Village of Ravena Building Department where I forged an understanding of village concerns and established strong working relationships with village officials. I helped update pro-

cedures and increased efficiency, secured a grant for the Village Records Management program, and began my study of municipal finances.

From this position, I was recommended to the town as a part-time bookkeeper, where I was quickly offered a full-time job as confidential secretary to the supervisor. As secretary, I worked closely with the supervisor and gained a fuller understanding of municipal finances through the bookkeeping duties that I still maintained. Through this experience I was inspired to supplement my bachelor's degree by pursuing an associates degree in accounting, which I was awarded, with honors, in 2019.

Upon hearing that Diane Millious was retiring as town clerk, I decided to run for that position and was elected in 2017. I have spent the past three-and-a-half years organizing and updating the town clerk's office to run as efficiently and smoothly as possible. Together with my deputy, I have worked to organize and categorize the Records Storage Room and have increased the rate of digitizing records. The office can now be run with less staff and in less space, and therefore at less cost to the taxpayers.

More valuable, perhaps, than the improvements I brought to Town Hall or the management skills I honed, was the enormous, sometimes disturbing, education I received from observing the current supervisor and council as they went about conducting town business. It became clear to me that any truly successful Coeymans government will require some significant changes to our policies and practices, and a recommitment to the basic principles of good government.

One of the first things I will do as supervisor is work with the town board to create a new Ethics Law. The current local law was written in 1970, and its vague language not only causes confusion, but provides room for abuse by town officials. I will work to mandate financial disclosure statements, helping to lay bare any latent conflicts of interest that may be lurking below the surface. Along with this, I will make clear the path for residents to make use of the Ethics Board, so all residents can work to ensure that our town government is one of honesty and integrity.

I will also immediately increase transparency by improving access to the meeting agendas for both the town board and the planning board/zoning board of appeals. The town board meeting agendas will include the meeting packets handed out to the town board members to allow the public access to all of the information and reports being discussed. Agendas will also be available several days ahead of time, allowing ample time for residents to look into and become acquainted with the different topics. In this effort to achieve greater transparency I will also improve access to records in the supervisor's office so that the town clerk can respond to FOIL requests in a timely manner.

I will work with every town department to create a multi-year budget plan for all equipment, small and large, from printers to dump trucks. Doing so will allow us to utilize reserve accounts to save for larger expenses, and reduce the town's debt. Each time the town borrows money there are thousands of dollars in attorney fees and lost interest that could be eliminated through careful budgeting. This multi-year plan will help keep taxes stable from year to year.

I will work to restore shifts to the Coeymans Police Department to make the department sustainable. There is no way to build a responsive police force for tomorrow in the wake of the deep cuts the current administration made to our town police. Currently there is no method in place to train new officers, which is of great concern to the resiliency of our force. Our chief of police and our officers are underpaid when compared to other local departments, which makes it difficult to keep them here. In the past two years we have lost an acting chief of police, several part-time and one full-time officer. We need our local police, they know our town residents and have a commitment to bettering our community. The Albany County Sheriff's deputies also serve a role here and are the needed backup to our local police. Having both forces is a boon for our community, but under the current setup the Coeymans Police Department will not last.

It has been great to see the work being done in our town parks this past year. I will continue this work, but will do so with a renewed commitment to responsible fiscal management, openness, and creativity. The town grant writer has done yeoman's work exploring various funding opportunities for local projects, and I will work closely with her to accelerate and intensify those efforts. Unlike recent practices of avoiding putting work out to bid and artificially splitting up invoices to avoid that process, I will not skirt the rules put in place by the Office of the State Comptroller that help the town achieve competitive pricing, but will adhere to them, therefore saving the taxpayers money.

When I ran for town clerk, I was ready and willing to work with any elected officials, regardless of party, as long as I had confidence in their integrity and commitment to our town. Unfortunately, the past two years has seen a deterioration in respectful cooperation within Town Hall and in its dealings with other agencies, municipalities, residents and neighbors who brought forth real concerns and ideas. We are a community of many perspectives, and we need leaders who regard that as the strength it surely is, not as an impediment or irritation. We are a community of both real challenge and great opportunity, and we need a town board that will commit to pushing solutions into the light of day. It is time for a change here at Town Hall, it is time to have an administrator that we can trust to do what is right for the residents of Coeymans.

Rain and gardens

Tropical Storm Henri and Hurricane Ida came and went in a pretty mysterious fashion as parts of our region got drenched with 6 or more inches of rain, i.e Tannersville and elsewhere in Greene County, while just a few miles away, like my house, the rainfall total was less than 2 inches.

The rainy summer has been good, in general, for our forested land and especially good for those of us who won't use our precious well water for the garden.

One downside is that the local mosquito populations have been able to breed often. Mosquitos only need a fraction of an inch of stagnant water to lay their eggs in and even persistent puddles, lasting only a few days to a week, will suffice as breeding grounds. This is a good time to inspect your property for such places and get rid of any standing water you see. Bird baths, flower pot saucers, old tires, clogged gutters and even rain gauges should be emptied every time it rains.

If you seem to be inundated with mosquitos it is very likely they are coming from within a hundred yards of your house and not from a pond, stream or any other body of water than holds fish. Remember that ticks are not the only blood-sucking pests capable of transmitting diseases.

The rogue yellow jackets, hornets and wasps, now unencumbered from the work of raising their brood, with their queen dead, are feasting on my hummingbird sugar water and any tasty snacks I leave unattended outside.

I guess I cannot blame them, but I wish they would stay away from my open can of beer! I once got stung on my lip from an intoxicated yellow jacket in the can and it almost cost me my life.

GARDENING TIPS

Last week I mentioned that I harvested my first ripe tomatoes and now I am picking a half dozen or more a day. I have eaten BLTs almost every single day.

Now my latest, favorite treat is sliced tomatoes on crusty bread with a slice of mozzarella cheese and a fresh basil leaf, topped with a splash of olive oil. I also eat sweet corn at least five times a week. My zucchini plants are still producing, I am overrun with green and wax beans to such an extent that I am now pulling the whole plants out of the ground to make it easier to harvest.

All these crops reward harvest by producing even more, which reminds me of an old cartoon strip called Lil' Abner, created by Al Capp. There was a creature called a "Shmoo," featured back in the early 1950s. According to Shmoo legend, the lovable creature died of sheer ecstasy when looked at with hunger. The Shmoo loved to be eaten and tasted like any food desired. Anything that delighted people delighted a Shmoo and they reproduced so quickly that it was impossible to run out of them.

Far from being the salvation of mankind, the Shmoo led to complete abandonment of any

desire to work or carry out any labor at all. They had to be exterminated to save the world from too much of a good thing!

Sadly, our gardens may appear shmoo-like right now, but soon, too soon, they will expire on their own. In the meantime, we get to enjoy the healthiest diet available at any time of year. No one loves meat more than I do, but I can be a happy vegetarian in August and September.

Fortunately, we can also can, freeze, dry, process and preserve the good stuff we have now for winter treats. Home canning is not likely to save you any money on your food bills this winter, with price of a new canning jar, more than \$1 each, but the taste of home-processed food and the memory it may evoke makes it all worthwhile.

I quit weeding my vegetable garden about two weeks ago, which all garden experts agree is a bad idea, since now is when the weeds are all going to seed and this will insure a fresh crop for next year. I don't care and the fact is that my garden soil already has enough of a weed seed bank to last a century, even if I pulled every single weed I see. Now it's the harvest season and there is plenty of work to accomplish putting the food away, if you so desire. Enjoy the fruits and vegetables of your labor as the days grow shorter.

Our gardens are a lot like our lives. They speed up as the days grow shorter, rewarding hard work with the satisfaction of accomplishments and the successes, or sometimes failures that must inevitably occur. Each year is a learning experience with so much potential for the future, until frost finally puts an end to the effort.



Dave MacLauchlin

One year ago this month, **Dave MacLauchlin**, started as manager of the **Lafarge** cement plant in Ravena – an opportunity that enabled him both to utilize his two decades of industry expertise and realize a dream of returning to his home state of New York.

But the job also presented significant challenges to MacLauchlin, 45, a Western Mohawk Valley native and Clarkson University graduate. He arrived five months after the coronavirus pandemic forced the closure of everything but essential businesses across the state.

The Lafarge Ravena plant, MacLauchlin said, shuttered briefly in April, but otherwise “operated successfully” throughout the Covid-19 crisis and never experienced an outbreak.

“That’s a testament to the workforce,” he said.

Now that the Covid restrictions have eased, MacLauchlin is focused on getting into the community and forging relationships. He is working to highlight how the local team has “evolved as an organization” and the plant has “evolved as a site.”

“Our goal is to be a good member of the community, to be a respected member of the community,” he explained. The plant is the largest employer in Southern Albany County, with 150 workers, and the largest contributor of local property taxes.

MacLauchlin often points to Ravena plant’s multimillion-dollar modernization project completed in 2017. He notes it has produced cement for many projects, including the GlobalFoundries site in Malta, which announced a significant expansion; and looks forward to playing a key role in helping New York reach its ambitious renewable energy goals.

Perrego has first win of the season

In 2020 at the “Great Race Place,” Albany Saratoga Speedway, it was Mike Mahaney calling the always tough 4/10th mile Malta facility home and at the end of the year was crowned as the point champion.

Turn the calendar ahead to 2021, and this time it is Anthony Perrego who makes the tow from Montgomery, NY, every Friday night as he has since the 2020 season who sits as the point leader going into the final night of points.

ALBANY SARATOGA SPEEDWAY

Perrego suffered his worst finish of the year the week before with a 17th place finish after getting a flat. With just a few laps left in the feature and the points getting closer, Perrego had a 19-point lead over Mahaney.

Winning at Albany Saratoga is a tough thing to do and with 14 different winners in 17 events, it only proves the point and Perrego, well he had YET to win a feature.

Well, that all changed after picking up his first win of the year and more importantly going into the final night with a 35-point lead on Mahaney and 37 points on two-time former champion Marc Johnson. Like I have said, it is tough competition on Friday nights and to lead in points without a win shows the consistency and reliable hot rod this team has built and maintains.

The busy Superior Remodeling Bicknell, Billy the Kid powered #44, are not only running Albany Saratoga but Orange County Fair Speedway on Saturdays, where the former three-time Small Block champion sits fourth in Big Block Points. He leads in the Small Blocks as well as runs the STSS, where he has two wins and 14 top 10s in 15 events. He sits tied with Mike Mahaney for the South point lead and 43 points behind Matt Sheppard in North points.

The win for Perrego sets him up going into the final night of points and the season-ending races across the Northeast, including the Malta Massive Weekend, Sept. 24 and 25. It was Perrego who scored the season-ending event last year as part of DIRTcar OctoberFAST.

MODIFIED FEATURE

The Modified feature was another of those “Great Race Place” races that lived up to its name that has become the norm on Friday nights due to the talent that assembles in the pits.

It was Neil Stratton with the early lead with a freight train of Modifieds on his rear deck. The battle up front was heating up with Jack Speshock and Jessey Mueller racing hard and not allowing Stratton to pull away as a great battle developed. Using the high side, Speshock grabbed the lead on lap 4.

Tight racing action behind the leaders found Perrego and Matt DeLorenzo working their way to the lead pack as Marc Johnson, Peter Britten and Mike Mahaney were in a battle working their way forward. After the caution flew on lap 8, the ensuing restart found Speshock over the bank in turn 2, handing the lead to Neil Stratton.

Staying green, the racing upfront continued to be hard and clean. The yellow was out for Kenny Tremont Jr. who was having a tough night aboard his 115. Once back to green it was Perrego and DeLorenzo showing their speed, putting on a show for the fans with Stratton out front. The caution was again out this time for Keith Flach.

Once back to green it was DeLorenzo working his way to second as the caution was quickly back out. Again back to green and this time it was Perrego back to second.

No matter where you looked, there was great side-by-side racing going on for position and don't look now, but here comes the 3J of Marc Johnson, who started on the ninth row and was

coming to the front as former champion Peter Britten and Adam Pierson were also having good runs.

As the laps clicked away, Stratton, who was looking for his first win, was spot on hitting his marks lap after lap. He was having a great drive on the front, holding off Perrego and DeLorenzo, who were giving Stratton all the pressure he could want going 3 wide in turn 4 with DeLorenzo on the bottom, Perrego in the middle and Stratton using the high side and holding the lead.

Coming out of turn four the white flag was out for Stratton, who only had

four more turns to that first win. After passing the starters' stand and moving into turn one, it all went bad as Stratton slid off the top of turn two, handing the lead over to Perrego.

The race remained green as Perrego went on to his first win of the year and took another step towards his first Albany Saratoga championship.

Following Perrego to the line were DeLorenzo, Stratton held on for third, with Marc Johnson fourth and Peter Britten rounding out the top 5 in a great race from green to checker.

MORE RACING

In other action, Jason Meltz waited for the right night to pick up his first Pro Stock win of the year, picking up the \$1,000 paycheck after holding off Chad Jeseo. With his second-place finish, the Albany Saratoga Pro Stock champion is Chad Jeseo who had an outstanding season with 7 wins to his credit. Following Meltz and Jeseo to the line was Jay Casey, Kim Duell and Luke Horning rounding out the top 5.

The Sportsman came into the night in the same situation as Tim Hartman Jr., with four wins on the season, had already clinched the 2021 championship, but you would never know it with the drive from his 15th starting spot to finish second behind seventh-place starter Scott Duell, who made it three wins on the year. Following Duell and Hartman to the line were Jeff Washburn, Robert Bublak, with Andrew Buff rounding out the top 5.

In the Limited Sportsman, it was current high-point driver Dylan Madsen picking up the win over Chris Jakubiak, Chris Crane Jr., Zach Buff and Bryce Breault rounding out the top 5.

In the full-fender Street Stocks, it was Adam Tranka with Jon Sheppard and Jaxson Ryan winning the 4-Cylinder race.

FALL RACING

Here we are and it is already September. Well, I guess there is one good thing about it — fall brings great racing and plenty of it.

The Albany Saratoga Speedway after Championship night will be back in action Sept. 10 with the DIRTcar Eastern Region Sportsman Series 76 lap event to head line the night. They have now added Modifieds to the show, along with Pro Stocks, Limited Sportsman and Street Stocks.

This night of racing should put plenty of cars in the pits and plenty of action on the track as the DIRTcar Sportsman Series comes to town and puts on a great show. The Albany Saratoga regulars will be tough to beat defending their home turf.

The season-ending show will be the Malta Massive Weekend on Friday, Sept. 24 and 25. The weekend kicks off with a 50-lap Fall Foliage 358 Spectacular along with Sportsman, Street Stocks and 4-Cyl.

On Saturday it will be the Super DIRTcar \$10,000 to win Modified Series, and DIRTcar Pro Stock Series along with Limited Sportsman that will bring the best in the Northeast to the Malta facility.

The Fonda 200 Weekend will be back for 2021 kicking off on Thursday, Sept. 16-18. During the weekend Modifieds, Pro Stocks, 602 Sportsman, Street Stocks, 4 Cyl, and the Winged CRSA Sprints will all be in competition during the weekend.

On Thursday will be practice for all divisions participating during the weekend, along with heats and consolation events for the “Ultimate Underdog 33.” This 33-lap race is for modified drivers who have gone without a win during the 2021 season at any track.

On Friday the Pro Stocks, CRSA Sprints and Street Stocks will be in action with heats, consolations and features. The 4-Cylinders will run feature-only format. The Short Track Super Series (STSS) Modifieds will run four 15-lap qualifying heats for the chance to take the \$53,000 to win Fonda 200 on Saturday. Then for the drivers who did not qualify, there will be STSS B Mains for the 200. The STSS 602 Sportsman will take to the track for their portion of the weekend with heats, B-Main and a 25-lap feature.

The last in our series about canine drives is a discussion on defense — very important for all owners to understand.

Defense drive in all dogs is pure survival mode, moment to moment, overriding everything.

Their fight-or-flee mechanism mirrors ours. Defense drive is exactly what the word means to us. Webster’s Dictionary defines it as an act or state of protection, defending or being

defended, and self-preservation. The dog’s mind computes, “I’m trapped, I have no back-up, I need to survive, I need to live.”

Defined another way, it can be an “I’ll get you before you get me” or an “I need to run and hide to save myself” type of response.

Passive defense drive means flight if at all possible. Dogs that choose to flee when pushed beyond their stress threshold, dogs that hide, dogs that cower, dogs that roll over, dogs that freeze and do not move, dogs that urinate submissively, and dogs that do not eat (even if they’re starving), all exhibit passive defense drive. Their MO is avoidance... avoid the threat and the experience.

Conversely, our fight-to-the-finish Mike Tysons of the canine

world will make choices in active defense drive that can easily become problematic, and often-times dangerous. A dog in active defense drive will growl at a spatial threat from people or other dogs, and can and will exhibit guarding behavior of resources, including food, toys, rooms, beds, cars, houses, yards, their owners and more.

Dogs in active defense are bold and hard, standing their ground, staring you down, and ready to take on all adversaries. It is imperative that dog owners understand and anticipate potential trigger situations and have the correct tools and methodology to put a defensive dog back into pack drive.

We do not want our dogs feeling defensive. Although dog bites are realized in active defense, a fearful animal that is “cornered” can psychologically switch from passive to active defense in an instant.

My favorite scenario to explain this in layman’s terms, is sweet little Honey, who lives alone with Grandmama, entertaining the family with grandchildren at Thanksgiving. Honey is giving every indication that she is stressed and in passive defense, wide-eyed, panting, scooting away from the playful and unsuspecting children, trying to hide, hackles up the full length of the body, not taking treats — you get the picture.

Not long into the holiday visit, we have a youngster screaming that Honey has bitten her. Backed into a corner of the den, Honey has decided that she must “get them before they get her” so she can survive, so she can live to see another day.

Now we have Honey being surrendered to a shelter, with a child bite to her name.

So much of what we do naturally as humans can put a vulnerable dog into defense drive. Education is absolutely necessary to help us understand and properly handle our loving, devoted, and predatory companions. We must avoid situations that elicit a defensive response. Your dogs are not children. They are dogs!

Understand your dog’s instinctive behaviors. Learn how to establish your multi-person home hierarchy, teaching him or her the rules in a dog-easy-to-understand and be successful mode. Do something, dog trainer!

State asks for help in combatting spotted lanternfly

ALBANY — The New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets (AGM) is asking for the public’s help in combatting the Spotted Lanternfly (SLF), an invasive pest from Asia.

First found in New York state on Staten Island in August 2020, the population has now been observed in all New York City boroughs.

SLF is a destructive pest that feeds on more than 70 plant species, including tree-of-heaven, and plants and crops that are critical to New York’s agricultural economy, such as grapevine, apple trees and hops.

“The department has been working diligently to mitigate the impacts of this destructive pest, which can weaken plants and have a devastating impact on agriculture,” state Agriculture Commissioner Richard A. Ball said. “Despite intensive survey and the implementation of targeted management plans, AGM has continued to find spotted lanternfly around the New York City area. We are once again asking for residents’ help, this time with spotted lanternfly treatment options, particularly in this area. Outside of New York City, we’re asking for the public to continue to be vigilant and report any sightings to help slow the spread of this invasive.”

The department has been receiving increased reports of the insect in the five boroughs of New York City. While inspectors continue to survey and respond to these reports, AGM is asking residents to destroy spotted lanternfly adults.

Later in the fall the public can help further by scraping off and destroying SLF egg masses.

The public can also reach out Cornell University’s Integrated Pest Management Program (IPM) or a certified pesticide applicator for treatment options to help combat SLF.

While these insects can jump and fly short distances, they spread primarily through human activity. SLF can lay their eggs on any number of surfaces, such as vehicles, stone, rusty metal, outdoor furniture and firewood. Adult SLF can hitch rides in vehicles, on any outdoor item, or cling to clothing or hats, and be easily transported into and throughout New York.

SLF has also been detected in several isolated areas upstate, including Ithaca; however, that population is relatively small and scheduled for treatment.

For residents living outside of New York City, AGM urges New Yorkers to report sightings of the SLF, using the web reporting tool found here: <https://survey123.arcgis.com/share/a08d60f6522043f5bd04229e00acd63>

Reporting in Upstate New York is critical, helping inspectors identify any newly impacted areas.

“In New York, we’re particularly concerned about the impact spotted lanternfly could have on our grape and wine industries,” said Brian Eshenaur, Sr., extension associate at Cornell University’s Integrated Pest Management Program. “Our NYS Integrated Pest Management Program has been working with our colleagues in Pennsylvania over the past few years to learn from their experience and prepare our growers for this insect advance. We are currently scouting vineyards and have NYS appropriate management options available for producers and tips for residents as well.”

In February of this year, the state also launched an innovative effort to combat the spread of SLF in New York state.

A new online interface allows volunteer members of the public to assist in surveying for SLF in a specific area, or grid of land, and tracking associated data.

The program encourages broader surveying for SLF and increased public awareness of this invasive pest.

The state is holding a series of training webinars to educate volunteers on how to identify SLF and tree-of-heaven, a plant that SLF commonly feeds on.

Each training webinar will focus on a different life stage of SLF based on the time of year that stage would be most likely found during survey.

Currently, the training focuses on identifying

adult SLF. The training will also cover how to use iMapInvasives, how to sign up for a grid and track data, and details about land access.

The next webinar will be held Oct. 27, from 1-3:30 p.m. More information about the program, including upcoming webinars, can be found at <https://www.nyimainvasives.org/slf>.

SLF feeding can stress plants, making them vulnerable to disease and attacks from other insects. SLF also excretes large amounts of sticky “honeydew,” which attracts sooty molds that interfere with plant photosynthesis, negatively affecting the growth and fruit yield of plants, devastating agriculture and impacting forest health.

The estimated total economic impact of invasive insects in the U.S. exceeds \$70 billion per year, and if not contained, the SLF could have an impact to New York state of at least \$300 million annually, mainly to the grape and wine industry.

SLF also has the potential to significantly hinder quality of life and recreational activities due to the honeydew and the swarms of insects it attracts.

First discovered in Pennsylvania in 2014, SLF has since been found in New Jersey, Maryland, Delaware, West Virginia and Virginia. Given the proximity to the Pennsylvania and New Jersey infestations, New York state is at high risk for infestation.

Adult SLF are active from July to December.

They are approximately 1 inch long and half an inch wide at rest, with eye-catching wings. Adults begin laying eggs in September. Signs of an SLF infestation may include:

- Sap oozing or weeping from open wounds on tree trunks, which appear wet and give off fermented odors.
- One-inch-long egg masses that are brownish-gray, waxy and mud-like when new. Old egg masses are brown and scaly.
- Massive honeydew build-up under plants, sometimes with black sooty mold developing.

Is it best to wait until 70 to claim Social Security?

Dear Rusty:
I'm 66 years old and still (self) employed as a home builder. I have not taken Social Security benefits yet, and don't need to at this time. If relevant, my business struggled when I first started it five years ago, but did well last year, and I'll have my highest earning year in my life this year and possibly next year as well. My question is, and it may be dumb, is it always best to delay Social Security until age 70 if there is no current financial need for it? Also, are benefits calculated by total dollars earned over a lifetime, or is some kind of average or mean computation used? I've enjoyed excellent health throughout my life, and I have longevity in my family. I'm single if

that's relevant.

Dear Planning Ahead:
There is never a dumb question about Social Security because it's a highly complex program. No, it isn't always best to delay claiming SS until age 70, but yours might be a typical example of why waiting until age 70 to claim is a very smart move. Here's why:
Your benefit at age 70 will be about 31% more than it would be at your full retirement age (FRA), which is 66 years and two months if you were born in 1955.
If you are still working and don't urgently need the money, your SS benefit will grow by 8% for each full year you delay claiming (but

you can still claim at any time if necessary and get all Delayed Retirement Credits (DRCs) earned to the point you claim).
Your benefit amount will be computed using the monthly average of your lifetime 35 highest

earning years, so if your current and more recent earnings are among your highest, they will be included in your benefit computation when you claim. Your earnings in the early years will be adjusted for inflation, and if you don't have a full 35 years of earnings, they will still use 35 (putting zeros in to make 35).
So, if you don't have a full 35 years of lifetime earnings, your current earnings now will eliminate some of those "zero earnings" years, resulting in a higher benefit.
If you're in good health now and you enjoy at least an "average" longevity (about 84 for a man your age), you'll get more in cumulative lifetime benefits by waiting until age 70 to claim and enjoy that

higher monthly benefit for the rest of your life. If you wish to estimate your life expectancy, you can use this tool we use here at The AMAC Foundation: <https://socialsecurityreport.org/tools/life-expectancy-calculator/>.
Since you're single, you don't need to worry about maximizing a survivor benefit for your spouse, but if you marry or have an ex-spouse who outlives you, then waiting until age 70 to claim would give them the maximum survivor benefit they are entitled to.
So, in your specific circumstance, waiting until you are 70 to claim appears to be a wise choice. For others who don't enjoy good health and don't expect to make average longevity, or for

those who urgently need the money earlier, claiming before age 70 is often a better choice.

Breakfast mistakes you didn't know you were making

Gardener never met a plant she didn't like

WESTERLO — You get the impression from talking to Roberta Nunn that she never met a plant she didn't like. The enthusiasm she expresses for all things gardening is palpable.

Nunn grew up in an Italian family in Hudson where her parents and grandmother always has a backyard garden. When she moved to Albany for college, she dug up part of her back yard there and created a garden.

"Ever since then, I had a vegetable garden wherever I was," Nunn said.

That said, she was still rather a novice gardener when she bought an old farmhouse on nine acres in Westerlo in 1980.

"I looked forward to having a vegetable garden and maybe a few flowers," she said.

Today, over four decades later, there are more than a few flowers. There are hundreds of species of plants on her property, and bed after bed of flowers, shrubs, trees and vegetables.

When she first moved into the home, there was a 20x20 flower bed with some day lilies and roses. Roses remain one of her favorite flowers.

"There was a big square in front of the front deck that was calling me to do something with it," she said.

At the time, she was enamored with English cottage gardens.

"They didn't seem like they would be that much work," she said.

So she planted a bunch of seeds and plants.

"The lesson I learned too late is that you should start small, and as you have additional plants, you should expand," she said.

Preferring plants to grass, Nunn started digging up areas around her property to plant gardens. Her next-door neighbors, Charlie and Irene Karle, gardened, and he taught her how to use a scythe to cut down the tall grass so she could plant. Her neighbors became "almost like a second set of parents," looking after her, and even feeding the wood stove in her kitchen while she was working. Karle, who was from Germany, also taught her about growing currants.

Other neighbors, Fred and Dora Clikeman, taught her about growing elderberries.

"I was lucky to have all these wonderful neighbors," she said.

She also planted a vegetable garden. However, as unfamiliar as she was about living in the country, she failed to fence it and provided the woodchucks with a bounty of vegetables to eat.

"I didn't know what to do," she said. "I was really naïve. I built a scarecrow."

The scarecrow didn't deter the hungry woodchucks, but it did give the Clikemans, a chuckle.

"They said, 'That was the funniest thing we've ever seen,'" she recalled, laughing at the memory.

She enlisted the aid of her father, who helped her put a fence in. Now she grows all kinds of vegetables—zucchini, corn, tomatoes, eggplant, peppers, and potatoes, to name just a few.

"Growing corn is wonderful," Nunn said. "To be able to pick your corn and eat it immediately is just the best thing." At the end of the season each year, her freezer is stocked with

her garden's bounty.

She even grows artichokes, which she started from seed, illustrating her passion for trying the unusual and challenging. Another example of this is blueberries. The soil on her property is too alkaline for blueberries, but that did not deter her. She read that adding sulfur to the soil to make it more acidic would help them grow. Determined, Nunn kept putting pine needles, coffee grounds and tea bags, all acidic items, around her blueberries to get them to grow. To protect them from birds, she has them fenced in all the way around.

There are other fruits, too, including raspberries, blackberries and an orchard with peach, plum, apricot, pear, apple and hazelnut trees.

In addition to learning from her neighbors, Nunn has educated herself through reading.

"I learned mostly from reading gardening books, which I devour," she said.

She also reads Kerry Ann Mendez's "Perennially Yours" gardening newsletter and attended one of her presentations. Mendez's ideas inspired one of Nunn's latest efforts — to simplify some of her gardens.

"She was fascinating," Nunn said. "One of her ideas that really struck me is how to make your garden simpler by putting in shrubs."

Nunn planted a shrub garden on the side of her home where there was a slope of grass that made it difficult to mow. Now that the ground is covered with a variety of shrubs, it does not require mowing.

"It's the easiest thing I have done," Nunn said.

Travel has also sparked the design for some of her gardens. On a trip to England, she toured Vita Sackville-West's famous white garden and tried it on her own property, planting white narcissus, campanula — a favorite — and hydrangeas, among other white flowers.

"Growing just white flowers is really hard to do," Nunn said.

In contrast to white, Nunn discovered her fondness for various shades of green.

"I'm learning that I like a variety of leaves," she said, pointing out plants with chartreuse leaves, deep green with red, and dahlias with dark green leaves that she started from seed in her sunroom.

Another travel-inspired garden is along the side of the greenhouse building that houses a solar heating system. She took a trip to the New York Botanical Garden where there was a Frida Kahlo exhibit, with pink, yellow and orange flowers from Mexico that had been grown in the greenhouses there. Instead of plants like lantana, which does not grow in upstate New York, Nunn substituted in other plants with pink, yellow and orange blossoms, such as four o'clocks and gloriosa daisies she started from seed. The color combination is one she said she fell in love with but had not considered before she saw the exhibition.

The centerpiece of the backyard is a three-quarter round deck with a fountain below and a stunning view of the Catskill Mountains in the distance. The fountain is surrounded by hollyhocks in pink and red, Karl Foerster grass, polyanthus, daylilies and alsacia.

Adjacent to the deck, Nunn put in three linear beds, each with its own color scheme, to break up the area. Digging up the overgrown land was an interesting process, as the property had been a nursing home at one time. As she dug, she found medicine bottles, false teeth and pieces of walkers.

On the other side of

those beds, she grows both white and purple grapes. She made her first wine this year, and she makes jelly with the Concord grapes.

"It's hard to get grapes to grow," she said, noting that she has tried nine different varieties. This demonstrates her constant experimentation, trying various plants to see what

grows well, in addition to moving plants to different locations to see if she can get them to flourish.

Despite the hundreds of plants she has in her voluminous gardens, Nunn, a frequent shopper at Greene Bee Greenhouse in Cornnwallville, is always looking for more.

"They catch your eye, and you just have to have

it," she said.

The Clematis Garden Club chose Nunn's garden as the Garden of the Month for August. The club meets in Greenville and consists of around 40 members from Greene, Albany and Schoharie counties. New members always welcome. For information, call Jean Horn at 518-966-4260.


