## Police: Stabbing leads to manhunt

NEW BALTIMORE — A manhunt was underway at press time Tuesday night for a Columbia County man accused of stabbing another man in Greene County on Saturday.

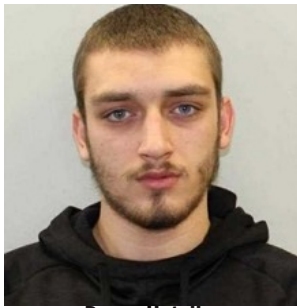
An arrest warrant was issued for Deven Hotaling, 22, of Philmont, Steven Nevel, public information officer for state police Troop F, said Monday.

The victim, a 30-year-old man whose name has

not been released, was stabbed multiple times in the side and back and is undergoing treatment at Albany Medical Center, Nevel said.

At about 12:10 p.m., Greene County 911 sent New Baltimore Rescue Squad, Greene County Paramedics and Cox-sackie Ambulance to the parking lot of C.A. Albright & Sons, 13640 Route 9W, after receiving reports that a man had been stabbed several times.

Paramedics treated the man and requested

that a LifeNet helicopter be sent to their location. New Baltimore Fire Department set up a landing zone at the scene.

Officials later canceled the helicopter and decid-

ed to transport the victim by ambulance.

Hotaling and the victim were involved in a physical altercation Saturday that ended in a stabbing, Nevel said.

Police tape surrounded the crime scene throughout the afternoon while state police conducted their investigation.

An arrest warrant has been issued for Hotaling, Nevel said Monday. He is charged with first-degree assault, a class B felony.

As of Tuesday night, police had not been able to locate Hotaling and

asked for the public's assistance. Anyone with information as to Hotaling's whereabouts is asked to call state police in Catskill at 518-622-8600.

Hotaling is awaiting trial in Columbia County Court on felony charges following two arrests that occurred in the village of Philmont in 2020.

On May 21, Hotaling was charged by state police with fourth-degree grand larceny and third-degree robbery, both felonies. Hotaling was arrested for allegedly

forcibly robbing a Lyft driver of \$1,700 in cash. The incident was reported Feb. 27.

On Aug. 18, Hotaling was charged by state police with second-degree arson. Hotaling is accused of setting a mattress on fire at a residence on Church Street. The fire was put out quickly by firefighters and there were no injuries.

Both cases are pending in Columbia County Court, according to the Columbia County District Attorney's Office.

## New law bans feeding of wildlife

RAVENA — The village board voted unanimously last week in favor of a new law that prohibits the feeding of wildlife, including waterfowl.

The issue arose over the summer when numerous property owners complained that some residents were feeding waterfowl and drawing large numbers of the animals — particularly ducks — to the area.

The ducks were causing property damage and creating a public health concern, village officials said.

"Certain people, maybe a group of people, think they are cute. I think little fuzzy ducks are cute, too, but they are not cute when they are defecating in your swimming pool and on your patio and creating a health hazard," Misuraca said at the board's July 20 meeting. "Also, there is a noise factor,

too."

In August, the village board held a public hearing to gauge the community's reaction to Local Law 2-2021, "Wildlife Feeding Law for the Village of Ravena."

The law, adopted by the board unanimously at the Sept. 21 meeting, outlawed the feeding of wildlife within the village and applies to all wildlife, including waterfowl, with the exception of songbirds, according to the new law.

Residents who want to continue feeding songbirds must use bird feeders that adhere to certain requirements to ensure the food does not attract ducks or other waterfowl instead.

"No person shall feed or provide

## New school year beset by challenges

RAVENA-COEY-MANS-SELKIRK — Another school year has brought a slew of new challenges for local schools.

District Superintendent Brian Bailey told the Ravena-Coeymans-Selkirk Board of Education at the Sept. 15 meeting that the district has faced a unique set of challenges this year, from vague COVID-19 mandates to staffing shortages.

"Last year and this year, back to school was like no other year," Bailey said. "And this year it was even harder in a lot of ways. Last year there were a lot of clear directives around the pandemic even though they came a week or two before school started. This year there were some directives, but they are much less con-

strictive."

Opening the doors to in-person instruction in this, the third academic year impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic, has been "10 times harder," according to Bailey.

Just maintaining the required three feet of social distance between individuals and children wearing face masks that cover their facial expressions has proven to be a great challenge, but students are happy to be back in school, Bailey said.

"They are happy to see each other and I commend all of the people that helped to plan to get us to the opening of the doors and our staff coming back and continuing to do this work that is so important," the superintendent said. "Schools are the glue that hold our culture and our civilization together."

The vast majority of the roughly 1,800 students in the RCS district have returned to full-time in-person instruction this academic year, with fewer than 20 students attending remotely due to medical fragility, Bailey said.

"That is a miracle

compared to last year," he said.

In addition to the pandemic challenges of maintaining social distance and wearing face masks, the district is also facing a staffing shortage, as are many school districts and businesses. Just two weeks into

the new school year, the shortfall in the necessary number of bus drivers could be felt.

"Today we had three drivers who were unable to drive for various reasons and that required our mechanic and our transportation director and our head bus driver to all get on buses and drive," Bailey said. "Today we made a hard choice between athletics and 10th period and we believe those decisions are going to have to continue to be made."

The district is advertising to hire additional bus drivers using yard signs, billboards and newspaper advertisements, but not enough applicants have come forward. There is also a shortage of teachers, with several teachers retiring at the end of last semester or prior to the start of the fall semester.

"People don't seem to want to come to work

and that is true in a lot of industries right now," Bailey said. "We continue to explore how to draw people to do that important work here, both instructionally and in support staff."

Deliveries of expected school supplies have also fallen short, leaving students and teachers lacking some important supplies, including headphones for Chromebooks and basic supplies like pens and paper, Bailey said.

"It's not cool that we have been waiting to come back to normal for a year and a half, then to come back and not have a three-ring binder ready to go," Bailey said. "Not that we can't do good instruction regardless, but it isn't exactly as planned and this is hard enough — just opening is hard enough. Ideally

for any wildlife within the village limits at any time of the year, except for songbirds, which may be provided with food in a regular feeder no less than 4 feet elevated from ground level and adequately secured," according to the law.

Individuals found feeding wildlife must first be given a warning and if they continue to feed the animals, they will be issued an appearance ticket. Any law enforcement agency can issue an appearance ticket for violation of the law, including local police officers, sheriff's deputies, or law enforcement officials from the Department of Environmental Conservation or the Department of Parks and Recreation.

After receiving a warning, a violator will be issued a fine of not less than \$100 and not more than \$500 for a first offense.

"Any subsequent violations occurring within five years of the date of the initial violation shall be punishable by a fine of no less than \$500 and no more than \$1,000," according to the new law.

The law takes effect immediately after it is

filed with the New York Department of State.

"Don't be the person that has to go to court for this," Misuraca said at last week's meeting. "It's doing everybody a favor in the interest of public health and the comfort of your neighbors."

Village Trustee Nancy Warner said she has spoken with Chief Douglas Keyer and he is on board.

"The chief is quite willing to work with the town attorney for when and if anyone gets an appearance ticket," Warner said.

Warner penned a brief letter that will be sent to residents in neighborhoods where complaints about the feeding of waterfowl have come in to make sure they are aware of the new law's passage.

Several complaints have been filed by property owners on Woodlawn Drive, Wendell Street and Orchard Avenue in particular, Warner said.

"I am sure there are a lot of people who are going to say they didn't know, but we will blanket the area, especially in places where complaints have come in," she said.

Village officials have

said that some area residents may think they are being kind by providing food for the ducks and other animals, but in reality that is not the case. The Department of Environmental Conservation website affirms that feeding wildlife does them no favors.

Feeding waterfowl causes problems including poor nutrition for the animals, water pollution, delayed migration, overcrowding, spread of disease with birds in close proximity, unnatural behavior and other problems, according to the DEC.

"It would seem that providing food for ducks and geese would make them healthier. However, this is not the case," according to the DEC. "Waterfowl at artificial feeding sites are often found to suffer from poor nutrition. In natural settings, waterfowl seek and feed on a variety of nutritious foods such as aquatic plants, natural grains and invertebrates. Many of the items commonly used to feed waterfowl (bread, corn, popcorn, etc.) are low in protein and are very poor substitutes for natural foods."

The new local law takes effect immediately.

we will get this squared away sooner rather than later."

There is also the question of COVID-19 test-

ing in schools, which has been mandated by the state with little information about how to implement a testing protocol.

"We are talking about hundreds of thousands

of tests this year," the superintendent said, adding that he hopes to have additional information for the board by the next board meeting in October.

# Calling police costly for motorist

**COXSACKIE** — A Greene County man who asked for assistance from police because he was having car trouble ended up being arrested on multiple counts of drug and weapons possession. Beau Duffy, director of information for state police, said Friday.

At about 9:01 a.m. last Wednesday, Valek Segura, 20, of Athens, flagged down a trooper who was on patrol on Plank Road in the town of Coxsackie to request assistance because he was having car trouble, Duffy said.

While speaking to Segura, the trooper noticed a set of illegal brass knuckles in his vehicle, Duffy said. As the trooper tried to take Segura into custody, Segura attempted to flee the scene.

Segura was taken into custody a short time later, Duffy said.

Police then began searching Segura's vehicle. They uncovered a quantity of psychedelic mushrooms, a digital scale, empty clear plastic bags and a 12-gauge shotgun, Duffy said.

Segura was arrested and charged with third-degree criminal possession of a con-

trolled substance with intent to sell, a class B felony, seventh-degree criminal possession of a controlled substance, a class A misdemeanor, two counts of second-degree criminal use of drug paraphernalia, a class A misdemeanor, fourth-degree criminal possession of a weapon, a class A misdemeanor, second-degree obstructing governmental administration, a class A misdemeanor and resisting arrest, a class A misdemeanor, Duffy said.

Segura was arraigned in Coxsackie Town Court and released. He is scheduled to reappear in court Oct. 18.

Under state Penal Law, third-degree criminal possession of a controlled substance in the third degree means knowingly and unlawfully possessing drugs,

narcotics or specified amounts of other specific types of controlled substances with the intent to sell.

Criminal possession of a controlled substance in the third degree is classified as a class B felony.

If convicted, sentences range from a minimum of five years to a maximum of 25 years in prison, depending on whether the suspect has prior convictions.

The judge may also impose a fine of up to \$30,000, according to state Penal Law.

In New York, metal knuckles are illegal, and those who possess them can be charged with fourth-degree criminal possession of a weapon.

If convicted, the suspect may be sentenced to up to a year in jail, according to state Penal Law.

# Coeymans, New Baltimore candidates pledge to work together

On Monday Sept. 20, Democratic Town Board and Albany County candidates from Coeymans joined with a New Baltimore Democrat running for town office to share concerns and discuss mutual issues affecting both towns, according to a statement.

The event featured a temporary "Gallery of the Hamlets" showing paintings, drawings and other mixed media pieces from Coeymans and New Baltimore artists who believe attention to the arts can be a great economic tool for both areas. This event was a landmark gathering of candidates from both towns, where all expressed their commitment to working together to protect and cherish their shared communities.

Coeymans and New Baltimore are neighboring communities, with one in Albany County and the other in Greene County. Both are historic Hudson River towns with great concerns about the protection of the majestic Hudson and air quality, along with industrial and local solid waste management

issues and proposals.

Much of the discussion among candidates centered around the landmark Coeymans Clean Air Act, which was greatly weakened by the current town administration, along with a huge solid waste management proposal in the town, which could affect air quality, bring in even more truck traffic, and make Coeymans an upstate destination for garbage disposal from other areas.

The event brought advocates from Riverkeeper and other concerned environmental advocates who want to limit the damage from further industrialization and environmental degradation in Coeymans and neighboring New Baltimore.

The Coeymans candidates spoke about bringing the people of the town together by representing all the interests of the town and encouraging open discussions about the Town's choices.

Cindy Rowzee, running for Coeymans Supervisor said, "Through hard work and creativity, we can build a

stronger, caring community where we watch out for each other."

Yvonne Shackleton, running for Town Board, wants to bring her core values to the Town Board: "Cooperation, honesty and transparency", while Sara Pruiksmas, running for Town Board, spoke as an artist and new mother: "We are at a tipping point in Coeymans and if we don't advocate for our Town and its residents now, there won't be a Hometown in the future." Kristen Geoghegan offers a clear committed voice to the Albany County Legislature, on behalf of Coeymans and other rural towns.

New Baltimore Town Council candidate Thomasina Winslow, a board member of the Hudson Valley Sloop Clearwater, spoke for everyone there, noting that: "We all breathe the same air in Coeymans and New Baltimore. We need to work together to encourage economic development that protects our air quality and our river, creating new jobs for all in a new green economy."

But it's so much more than just the fitness. The magic created in every class draws each student into their own trip down memory lane.

Music is one of the only activities that uses and stimulates the entire brain all at the same time.

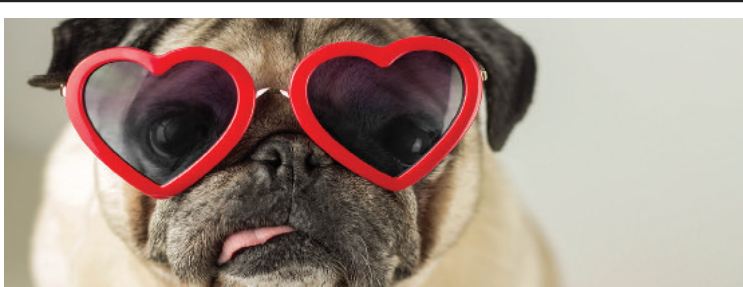

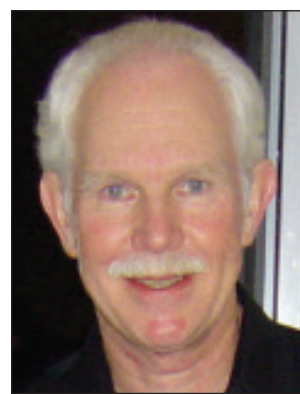

# (Not fried) Green tomatoes

GARDENING TIPS

By mid- to late-September, everyone in our region should be enjoying the wonderful flavor of fresh, ripe tomatoes.

Some of us wait 10 or even 11 months for this annual treat and it always ends much too soon, usually with the first frost.

Unfortunately, some local gardeners are still waiting for their tomatoes to ripen as the days get shorter and cool nights slow the ripening process. As I have previously written, tomatoes ripen fastest at temperatures between 70 and 80 degrees. They will still ripen at 60 degrees and even a bit lower, but much more slowly.

To make matters worse, many tomato plants have already been pretty much defoliated by diseases such as early blight. The flavor of these fruits is dependent upon compounds, mostly sugars, which are manufactured in the leaves. Many supermarket tomatoes are harvested in the green stage and then sprayed with ethylene gas, which causes them to turn red. These fruits have very little flavor and so will the ones on your naked plants.

Prevent premature disease defoliation by spraying the plants weekly, early in the season, with either an organic or conventional fungicide. You can quit spraying by the end of July and still have protected the plants well into the harvest season. If the plants lose their leaves to disease weeks after the fruit are being harvested, who cares?

So, what is the cause and solution to the green tomato conundrum? Well, it all begins with proper variety selection.

All varieties of tomatoes and most other vegetables have an "average" days-to-harvest on the package. That date is based on from when the plants are set out in the garden from cell packs

live at higher elevations.

Most of you live in a warmer climate than I do, but some of you are also not picking ripe fruit yet. There are a couple of other factors that contribute to late ripening. Perhaps the most common reason is overfertilization of nitrogen. Tomato plants that get too much nitrogen will often grow really fast and really large, but plants that are growing very happily vegetatively do not seem to need to finish the reproductive process.

Many gardeners are guilty of overfertilization thinking that if a little is good, then a lot is better. This is true for both conventional, as well as organic gardeners.

Four pounds of a 5-10-5 fertilizer is more than adequate for about four to six tomato plants, growing in about a 10-foot square area (100 square feet). Both compost and manure have a fertilizer ratio of 1-1-1, so five times as much is needed to deliver the same dose of nitrogen. Twenty pounds of compost is plenty for those plants.

If you use a concentrated organic fertilizer, such as dried blood, which has 12% to 15% nitrogen (12-1-0), you only need two pounds or less to feed them. Organic mulches, such as straw as well as organic matter that is tilled into the soil, such as cover crops, also add nitrogen as they decompose.

An acre of a legume, such as alfalfa, when tilled under in the spring, provides about 265 pounds of nitrogen the following season, which is almost three times as much nitrogen as a corn crop needs! And corn needs a lot more nitrogen than tomatoes.

So next year, back off on the fertilizer if you want ripe tomatoes in August!

One year ago this month, Dave MacLauchlin, started as manager of the Lafarge cement plant in Ravenna - an opportunity that enabled him both to utilize his two decades of industry expertise and realize a dream of returning to his home state of New York.

But the job also presented significant challenges to MacLauchlin, 45, a Western Mohawk Valley native and Clarkson University graduate. He arrived five months after the coronavirus pandemic forced the closure of everything but essential businesses across the state.

The Lafarge Ravenna plant, MacLauchlin said, shuttered briefly in April, but otherwise "operated successfully" throughout the Covid-19 crisis and never experienced an outbreak.

"That's a testament to the workforce," he said.

Now that the Covid restrictions have eased, MacLauchlin is focused on getting into the community and forging relationships. He is working to highlight how the local team has "evolved as an organization" and the plant has "evolved as a site."

"Our goal is to be a good member of the community, to be a respected member of the community," he explained. The plant is the largest employer in Southern Albany County, with 150 workers, and the largest contributor of local property taxes.

MacLauchlin often points to Ravenna plant's multimillion-dollar modernization project completed in 2017. He notes it has produced cement for many projects, including the GlobalFoundries site in Malta, which announced a significant expansion; and looks forward to playing a key role in helping New York reach its ambitious renewable energy goals.

## Voters to give thumb's up or down to \$40.7M capital project

BETHLEHEM — On Tuesday, Oct. 19, residents of the Bethlehem Central School District will vote on a 2021 facilities improvement capital project to upgrade facilities across the district.

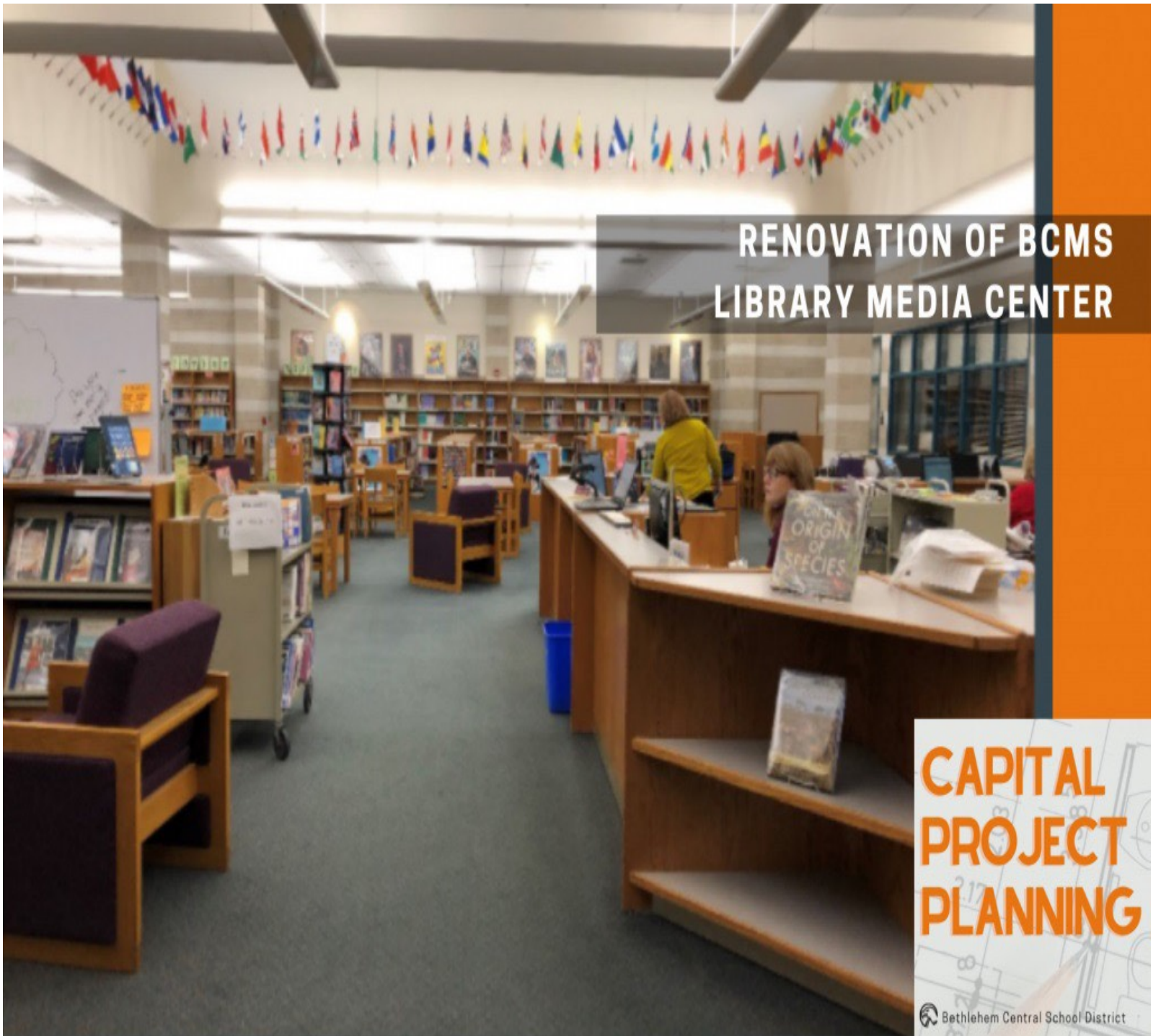
The board of education approved \$40.7 million in infrastructure projects that if approved by voters, would provide improvements at every school building in the district.

The project was developed during eight meetings beginning in March 2021.

Taxes will not increase in the district due to the project, according to a district statement. The project is expected to be budget neutral, with debt service costs fully offset by New York state building aid and significant use of the district's capital reserve fund, according to the district.

Priority projects included in the proposed project are:

- BCMS auditorium renovations
- BCMS Library Media Center renovations
- BCMS Family & Consumer Science classroom renovations
- BCMS Digital Tech classroom renovations
- BCMS synthetic turf multi-use athletic field (outside E wing, not the stadium field)
- BCMS tennis court renovations
- Transportation infrastructure to support 25 electric buses
- BCHS Gym A renovations
- BCHS Stadium pavilion
- BCHS cafeteria outdoor canopy
- Playground improvements at all elementary schools
- Playground shade canopies
- Slingerlands kitchen renovation
- Hamagrael kitchen renovation



Voters will determine the fate of a proposed \$40.7M capital project in the Bethlehem school district.

- Transportation office renovation
- Roofing replacements at BCHS, BCMS, Elsmere and Hamagrael
- Boiler replacements at BCHS, Elsmere and Hamagrael
- Security upgrades at entrances at Glenmont, Hamagrael
- Additional security cameras districtwide
- Technology infrastructure upgrades

The majority of the projects were part of the five-year capital facilities plan, according to the district. The plan prioritizes infrastructure needs by building and provides a blueprint for the district to develop moderate-sized capital projects approximately every three to five years, according to the district.

The most recent capital project was approved by voters in November 2016 and was completed in the 2019-20 school year. The total estimated

cost of the project is \$40,693,000. Funding sources will cover 100% of the cost of the project, with no property tax impact for homeowners. Funding sources are as follows:

- A R P / E S S E R Funds: \$2,397,000
- Federal E-Rate Funds: \$543,000
- Capital Reserve Funds – 2015: \$5,100,000
- Capital Reserve Funds – 2019: \$8,300,000
- E s t i m a t e d

NYS Building Aid: \$24,353,106

Voters will vote on the proposed project in a bond referendum vote Oct. 19 and if approved, the project design is estimated to be completed in May 2022. The State Education Department would review and approve the project between June 2022 and February 2023, after which bids will go out and contracts awarded.

Construction is expected to begin in April 2023

and be completed by December 2024, according to the district.

Voting on the project will take place Tuesday, Oct. 19, from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. at Bethlehem Central High School, 700 Delaware Ave., Delmar, in Gym A. To vote, you must be at least 18 years old, a U.S. citizen and a resident of the Bethlehem Central School District for at least 30 days prior to the vote. You do not need to be registered to vote.

# The environmental cost of plastic nursery pots

Trade associations within the nursery and landscape businesses like to promote themselves as “the green industry,” but sometimes what we do as gardeners is not so green.

For example, in 2009, the last year for which Marie Chieppo has figures, growers in the United States used 1.66 billion pounds of plastic in the form, mostly of plastic pots.

You might think that, given the green-ness of our industry, the majority of these pots might be recycled, but again according to Chieppo and the report on plastic nursery containers that she wrote for the Association of Professional Landscape Designers, that is not the case. Some 95% of the plastic containers used by the horticultural industry are disposed of in the landfill, which is why 90% of the containers in any given year are produced from “virgin” feedstock, new petroleum pumped fresh from the ground.

## BE-A-BETTER-GARDENER

When I spoke to Chieppo about this topic recently, she told me about some of the obstacles to the recycling of plastic nursery pots. This is a subject close to her heart, as after starting her career as a researcher for The New England Journal of Medicine, Marie turned her passion into her profession 23 years ago and trained as a designer of ecologically based landscapes and gardens (she is the principal at Eco-PlantPlans LLC). She’s a Certified Massachusetts Master Gardener, a Certified Garden Designer, and a Certified Native Plant Designer.

The obstacles to recycling of plastic nursery containers are many. When emptied of their plants by the gardener or landscaper, the pots are almost certainly dirty and have to be scrubbed out before they are candidates for recycling. A limited number of nurseries will

take their containers back and try to reuse them for next year’s crops. Most growers, however, want fresh-from-the-factory pots, and for this the used pots must be reprocessed.

Many of the containers are made of lower-grade resins, which cannot be reprocessed successfully, and even those that are made of high-density polyethylene (HDPE #2) can only be reprocessed once or twice.

Further complicating this process is the fact that most of the plastic plant containers are black, and the optical scanners standard at recycling centers cannot read the recycling codes stamped into black plastic and so those pots are automatically discarded.

There are better alternatives, Chieppo stresses. There are, for example, bioplastic plant containers, and although they contain some petroleum

products, much of their plastic is derived from biomass sources. When ready to be discarded, bioplastic pots can be biodegraded successfully by industrial composting systems. Even more eco-friendly are so-called compostable pots, which are made entirely from biodegradable materials such as wood fiber. Compostable pots can be biodegraded in virtually any composting set-up, including home heaps.

Finally, there are also plantable pots, such as those made of compressed peat or “Cow Pots,” which are made of processed cow manure. These last allow planting without the removal of the pot, as they will decompose in place and actually add a modest amount of desirable organic material to the garden soil.

There are a number of factors that discourage growers from switching to these environmentally more desirable containers. One is familiarity: the growers are used to the disposable plastic containers they presently use

and know how to make them work. Likewise, the durability of these containers, a problem when it comes to their disposal, makes them appealing to growers who may be shipping their plants long distances. As Chieppo suggests, the industry will need encouragement to make this change.

For landscape professionals, one way to apply pressure is to go to the APLD’s web page, “Healthy Pots, Healthy Planet” (<https://www.apld.org/healthy-pots-healthy-planet/>) and register to join its growing list of designers and design firms demanding change. Chieppo also suggests that designers specify the use of recyclable or compostable pots in their designs. This, of course, is something that gardeners can also do. We, too, can request at our local garden centers or big box stores that they switch to greener plant containers, and make a point of patronizing businesses that have done so.

As in so many other aspects of the current

environmental crisis, collaborative action is essential, but responsibility ultimately is personal: you and I must make our choices and take action accordingly.

# Increasing blood availability for patients with sickle cell disease

ALBANY — When patients living with sickle cell disease face a sickle cell crisis, blood transfusions can make a lifesaving difference. That's why the American Red Cross has launched an initiative to grow the number of blood donors who are Black to help patients with sickle cell disease, an enduring and often invisible health disparity in the U.S.

Over 100,000 people in the U.S. have sickle cell disease, the most common inherited blood disorder, and the majority of patients are of African descent.

Despite the discovery of the disease more than a century ago, there have been fewer health resources available to help those currently suffering from sickle cell crisis in comparison to similar diseases. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, people with sickle cell disease experience worse health outcomes than comparable diseases.

A closer blood match leads to better outcomes. Many patients with sickle cell disease will require regular blood transfusions to help manage their disease. Unfortunately, these patients may develop an immune response against blood from donors that is not closely matched to their own.

Many individuals who are Black have distinct markers on their red blood cells that make their donations ideal for helping patients with sickle cell disease. More than half of blood donors who are Black have blood that is free of C, E and K antigens — making them the best match for those with sickle cell disease.

The Red Cross asks members of the Black community to join in helping to address this health disparity and meet the needs of patients with sickle cell disease. Donors can take action by scheduling a blood donation appointment at RedCrossBlood.org, by downloading the Blood Donor App

or by calling 1-800-RED CROSS.

## LIFE-THREATENING COMPLICATIONS

Sickle cell disease distorts soft, round blood cells and turns them hard and crescent-shaped, which can cause extreme pain. When hardened, the cells can get caught in blood vessels, potentially leading to stroke and organ failure.

"Transfusions provide healthy blood cells, unblocking blood vessels and delivering oxygen," said Dr. Lawrence Fialkow, medical director for the American Red Cross Northeast Division.

## EVERY TRANSFUSION COUNTS

Seventeen-year-old Demarus Torrence loves comics and sci-fi movies, and he balances his work in high school while living with sickle cell disease. He endures monthly blood transfusions, and, at times, regular hospital stays to help with extreme pain and other complications.

"Just imagine someone

hitting your back with a hammer, constantly, and it just won't stop," said Demarus' mother, Passion Terrell. "[Demarkus] describes it, and you can picture it, but you really can't."

Demarkus is the only person in his immediate family with the disease, though testing has revealed other family members carry the sickle cell trait. As a mother, Passion has made it her mission to care for her beloved son and to inspire others to give blood — especially individuals who are Black and people who have never donated. The family hosted a

Red Cross blood drive at Demarus' school this month to highlight that generous donations can mean a world of difference to people like him.

"It's amazing — once he gets that blood in him, it's like a different person," Passion said. "His breathing improves; his blood levels improve. It's like his body wakes up."

## COMMUNITY PARTNERS LEADING SUPPORT

Partnerships with national and local organizations within the Black community are critical to building trust, sharing information and working together to engage new donors to help save lives.

Nationally, the Red Cross is thrilled to announce new partnerships with preeminent organizations like the NAACP and 100 Black Men of America, Inc. to raise awareness about sickle cell disease as a persisting and heartbreaking health disparity, and to help patients with sickle cell disease by encouraging blood donations from individuals who are Black.

In Albany, individuals make a blood donation Sept. 30 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. at the American Red Cross of Eastern New York, 33 Everett Road.

# Is COLA increase based on current SS benefit?

**Dear Rusty:**  
I started collecting SS when I turned 70 to maximize my income. One factor that is never mentioned is that the annual cost of living increase appears to be based on the previous year's payment.

I've talked to others who are about my age (77) and we talked about how much of an adder we will receive. Those who collected earlier always get much less than I do. So, it appears that the annual increase is based on previous year's payment and not on the original payment from when I started collecting, so it has a compounding impact.

Frequently the increase received by those who collected early covers the

Medicare increase plus a small adder, whereas I have been getting a much larger increase. Can you comment?

*Signed: Wondering*

**Dear Wondering:**  
I'll be happy to clarify this for you.

The annual Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) for next year is determined by comparing this year's Consumer Price Index for the 3rd quarter (July-September) to the same period last year. If there is a difference (which there usually is), the percentage of difference becomes the COLA increase percentage for next year. The COLA is applied annually starting with everyone's December benefit (paid in January).

Everyone gets a different amount of COLA money because everyone's Social Security benefit payment is different. Your COLA dollar increase is more than most of your friends because you waited until you were 70 to claim

and, thus, have a higher benefit. Your friends who claimed earlier will have a smaller benefit and therefore get a smaller dollar amount as a cost-of-living increase.

COLA is a percentage increase and, since the 2021 COLA increase was 1.3%, applying that percentage to each person's SS benefit amount results in a different dollar increase for each.

And you're correct; since the percentage of increase is applied to your current benefit amount and not your original benefit amount, COLA increases are, indeed, compounded.

To further complicate matters, Social Security's "hold harmless" provision sometimes results in beneficiaries paying less

than the standard Medicare premium amount. If someone is now paying less than the monthly Medicare premium (\$148.50 for Part B (out-patient services)), any COLA increase awarded is used to bring their Medicare Part B premium up to (or closer to) the standard premium for that year. That means that sometimes the full amount of COLA dollars are not reflected in each person's net Social Security payment, further confusing people when they see that their total SS payment didn't increase by the announced COLA percentage.

So, as you can see there are reasons why everyone's COLA looks different, but your basic point is correct — COLA is

applied to your current SS benefit amount, not the SS benefit you were awarded when you claimed.

# Moving things along

Constipation is a subject many people do not like to talk about. But if you are one of the 63 million people (mostly women and the elderly) suffering in silence from slow bowels, then today's post may help you get things moving along.

Most people think of constipation as a symptom rather than the cause of their health problems. Chronic constipation has been linked to several serious health conditions including diverticulitis, kidney disease, certain cancers, hyperthyroidism, Parkinson's disease and weight gain.

And how often you empty your bowels is a good indication of how healthy you are. While many people may have a bowel movement once a day, the normal amount ranges between four times each week to several times a day. Having fewer than three bowel movements a week is technically the definition of constipation.

According to an article in Perfect Origins, "Depending on your height, age and diet, you could have anywhere from five to 20 pounds of fecal matter in your intestines at any given time!"

Some symptoms of constipation include hard, dry stools that are difficult to pass and the feeling that you have not fully emptied your bowels.

So what's the solution? Many people resort to taking over-the-counter or prescription laxatives in order to relieve constipation. These products cause a laxative effect by stimulating the lining of the intestines and making the muscles of the digestive system contract while also increasing stool's hydration.

While OTC or prescription laxatives might solve a case of short-term constipation, they ultimately don't fix the underlying digestive issues and if used often enough your body can develop a dependence on them.

However, the exception is bulk-forming natural remedies that are non-habit-forming and safe to use every day, according to the Food and Drug Administration.

Cascara sagrada is used by those who prefer a natural, safe alternative to harsh laxatives. First used by Native Americans, cascara sagrada bark contains anthraquinones that produce wavelike

people with inflammatory bowel diseases had lower inflammation levels when taking wormwood. It also stimulates the production and release of bile, which helps you detox and absorb your food more efficiently.

Psyllium husk is a bulk-forming laxative that works by binding to partially digested food passing from the stomach to the small intestine. It helps with the absorption of water, which increases the size and moisture of stools, making stools easier to pass. Additionally, it may also aid in appetite control by slowing down stomach emptying and reducing appetite, according to a 2011 study published in Pub Med.

One final note: Please consult your medical professional before making any dietary changes.

contractions in the large intestine. Known as peristalsis, it gently stimulates the removal of waste from your body. Cascara sagrada will induce a bowel movement within eight to 12 hours of taking it.

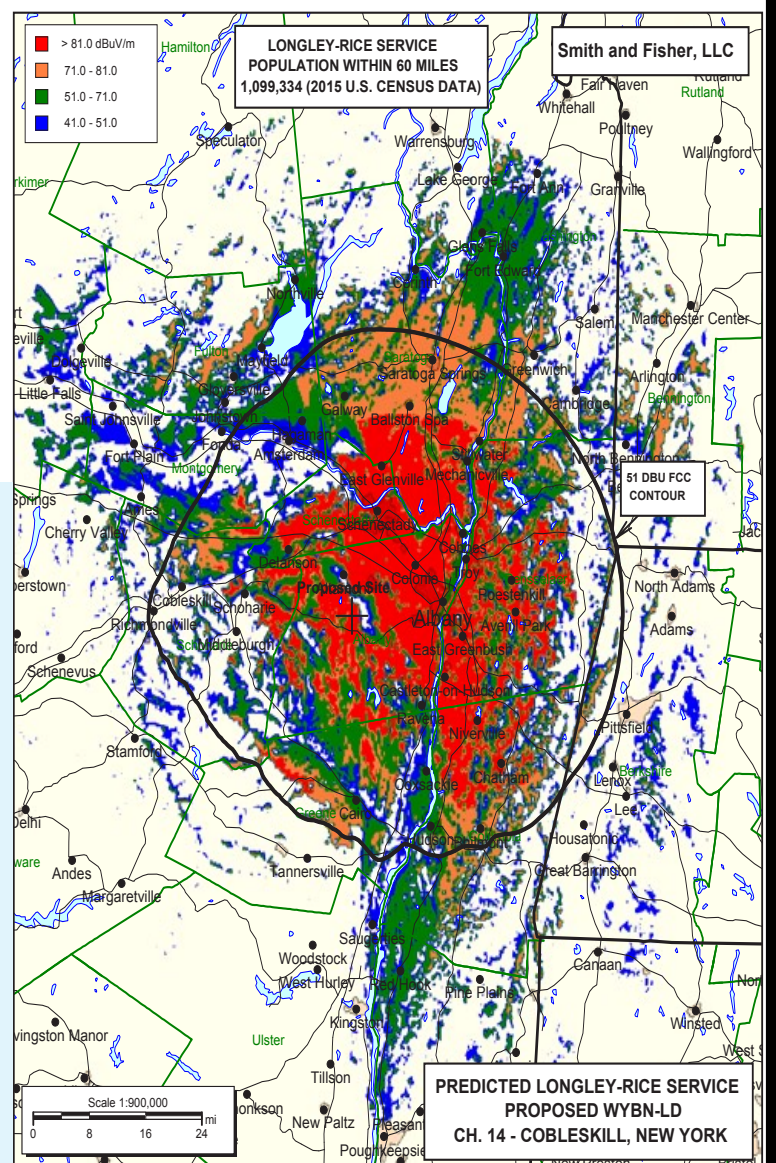
