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## RCS investigating 'hate speech' against LGBTQ community

**RAVENA-COEYMANS-SELKIRK** — The Ravena-Coeymans-Selkirk school district is investigating an online post with homophobic comments directed against the LGBTQ community.

The district termed the social media post “hate speech” in a statement released June 2 and is investigating the incident.

“School officials have been made aware of the incident and are working with RCS High School faculty and law enforcement to identify and address the suspect(s),”

according to the statement. “The offending post featured a hate-filled address to those who potentially identify with the LGBTQ community.”

No specific reference was made in the post to the school district or to specific individuals or locations.

The district did not reveal the statements or what social media platforms they appeared on.

Parents were urged to speak with their students about refraining from hate speech and remaining civil on social media platforms.

“Hate speech has no place at RCS,” according to the statement. “It is a

violation of the student code of conduct, board of education policy, and may violate the law.

Please take a moment to speak to your child about the importance of civility, both digitally and in

person.”

The impacts of hateful speech, both to the writer and individuals targeted by the post, can be long lasting, according to the district.

The posts were brought to the attention of district officials by several students.

“We are grateful that this event was brought forward by a number of RCS students who saw it and reported it to building staff and leaders,” according to the district.

The social media post comes at the start of Pride Month, which is celebrated each June.

Pride Month honors the 1969 Stonewall Uprising in New York City,

which was the catalyst for the Gay Liberation Movement in the U.S., according to the Library of Congress website. The commemoration began as a celebration the last Sunday in June, which was initially known as Gay Pride Day, but the actual day was flexible.

The “day” eventually came to encompass a month-long series of events.

“The purpose of the commemorative month is to recognize the impact that lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender individuals have had on history locally, nationally and internationally,” according to the Library of Congress website.

## Murals breathe new life into Main Street

**RAVENA** — A pair of murals are brightening up Main Street.

A colorful mural with bright red poppies and the word “Ravena” now adorns the side of a vacant building at 126 Main Street, Ravena.

Joy Iafallo, a real estate agent who owns the building and is chairwoman of the RCS Community Business Association, commissioned the artwork with Niskayuna-based mural artist Kendra Farstad, who recently completed a mural at the Troy Waterfront Farmers Market and creates both commercial and residential murals.

“It’s super bright and colorful and that’s what I wanted,” Iafallo said. “And I did poppies because it is right across the street from the war memorial.”

The building is opposite the village’s veterans’ memorial park. Red poppies are a symbol of the sacrifice of ser-

vicemen and women who died in war, according to the national American Legion website.

Iafallo wants to breathe new life into the village’s main thoroughfare, and more murals are in the works.

“The goal is to bring back Main Street,” Iafallo said. “I was already talking about doing another mural before this one was done, so I am going to keep going.”

She already has her eye on another building on Main Street where she would like to see a mural go up. Revitalizing the village and getting new businesses to move into the area is the spark behind the initiative, she said.

“I have been selling real estate in this area for almost 20 years and I am sick of seeing Main Street the way it is, so I wanted to do something about it,” Iafallo said.

A second mural has also gone up on the exterior of Trakside Pizza, 1 Railroad Ave., off Main Street. The two projects were unrelated, Iafallo said.

The Trakside Pizza mural was coordinated by...

## Hannacroix man dies in Glenmont crash

**GLENMONT** — A crash resulted in one fatality and sent another man to the hospital after two cars collided head-on on River Road in Glenmont last Wednesday afternoon.

Gerald W. Carter, 60, of Hannacroix, died in the crash.

First responders were dispatched to 822 River Road in front of the Glenmont Job Corps at 4:33 p.m. on Wednesday, June 2, for a report of a head-on collision with people trapped and one unconscious individual.

Arriving officers from Bethlehem Police reported there was confirmed entrapment of two drivers with one under the dashboard and the unconscious individual was not breathing, advising EMS to step up their response.

Initial dispatch stated one of the vehicles was also reported to be on fire. Arriving crews found no fire but there was some steam coming from the vehicle.

The Selkirk Fire Department was dispatched to the call and requested Slingerlands Fire for an additional heavy rescue truck due to entrapment in both vehicles.

Firefighters cut the driver’s side door to extricate the driver of a white 2020

Chevrolet pickup operated by Brandon C. Littlejohn, 26, of Troy, who was traveling northbound on River Road, according to a statement from Bethlehem Police.

Chief Joe Michaniw of Selkirk Fire said the driver of the pickup said he lost consciousness and didn’t know how he got where he was.

The driver was transported to Albany Medical Center by Delmar-Bethlehem EMS with leg injuries and other injuries

that do not appear to be life-threatening.

Carter was driving a white 2013 Kia, traveling southbound on River Road, according to police.

Police say Carter was pronounced dead at the scene.

Crews had to wait for the Albany County coroner and a District Attorney’s Office official to arrive at the scene for the investigation before Carter could be extricated from the vehicle.

“The second extrication was a

deceased male victim and that was a slow process trying to get him out,” Michaniw said. “The car was pretty crushed and he was tight in there.”

Firefighters started with cutting the doors and the B pillar of the car.

They then rolled the dashboard back far enough until the coroner was comfortable to remove the victim from the car safely.

The investigation took several hours and was prolonged due to heavy downpours in the area.

Crews were on the scene for almost four hours.

“It’s going to be long when we have a fatality for the investigation with the police,” Michaniw said.

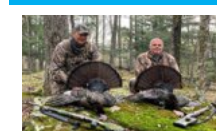
Debris was scattered across the roadway and was cleaned off by firefighters.

Fire police from Selkirk and Elsmere fire departments shut down River Road at Wemple Road and River Road at Clapper Road throughout the investigation.

Agencies on the scene included Bethlehem Police, New York State Police, Delmar-Bethlehem EMS, Albany County Paramedics, as well as the Selkirk, Slingerlands and Elsmere fire departments.

The cause of the crash is still under investigation.

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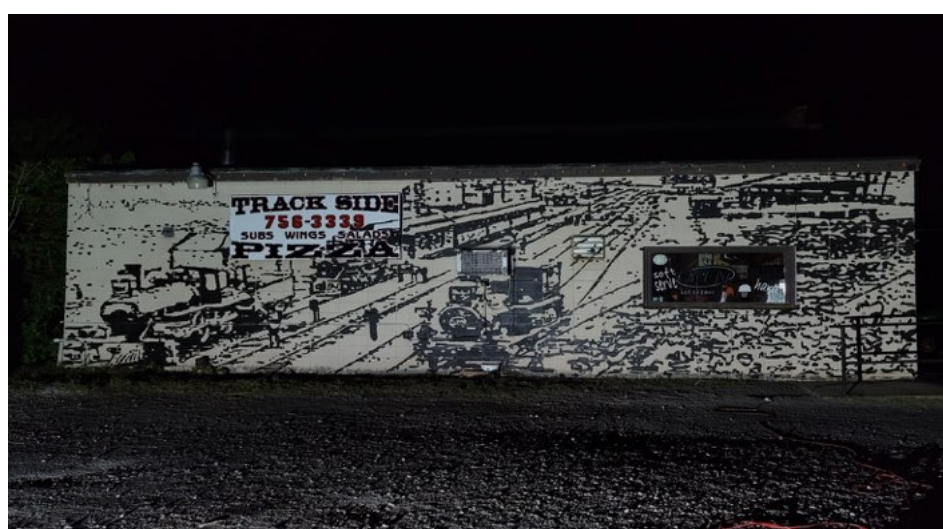

inated by Sara Pruiksmas, who is running for town council. Pruiksmas said she worked with Trackside owner Bernice Hopkins to come up with the idea for a historical theme for the mural.

"Originally, I was supposed to do the mural myself, but when Bernice [Hopkins] started telling me what she wanted, I realized I wasn't the artist for the job," Pruiksmas said. "Every artist has their own wheelhouse of skills that they do naturally. Then we got to talking about doing a historical reference to it and that's how I got the photo of the Ravenna rail yard from 1883."

Discussions on creating a mural began several years ago.

"A few years ago I spoke to Sara Pruiksmas about painting a mural on the side of the building, something with a train was what I wanted, and Sara took it one step further," Trackside Pizza owner Bernice Hopkins said. "Sara located a very special artist to complete the work. I left the creativity up to Sara and

Samson Contompasis." Hopkins said she couldn't be more pleased with the results.

"As I stood there watching this piece come to life, I was truly honored to have had such a wonderful artist create this piece of art on our building," Hopkins said. "A piece of art to hopefully be enjoyed by many as they drive along Main Street."

Joseph Boehlke from the Ravenna Coeymans Historical Society provided the historical picture that was the inspiration for the mural. Albany-based artist Samson Contompasis created the mural during an artist's event May 23, including a question-and-answer session with members of the community.

Contompasis' other area murals include "Ghost City Project" at the Empire State Plaza food court.

"The project was so up his alley — it's just what he does naturally," Pruiksmas said. "I asked him if he was interested in getting involved and he was totally on board."

Contompasis completed the mural in three hours with a 3-inch roller, she said. Viewed up close,

the elements of the mural "dissolve," Pruiksmas said, but when seen from a distance, the scene of a rail yard comes together.

"I am really excited to have it done and have this wonderful piece of history reimaged and I hope it helps to bring some business to Trackside," she added. "It's a fun project."

Pruiksmas is one of four candidates seeking election to the two open seats on the Coeymans Town Council in November.

"This project came to be completely unrelated to politics," Pruiksmas said. "How it's related to me now running for town council is this is part of what I want to see happen in the town. It's not necessarily murals everywhere — although that would be great and Joy and I have talked about partnering on that — but it's more about recognizing the beauty that is here and helping to make culture more visible in the area and pay tribute to the history and the culture that already exists here."

The mural is 12-feet high and 38-feet long. Hopkins funded the project and paint was donated by Persico True Value and Pruiksmas.

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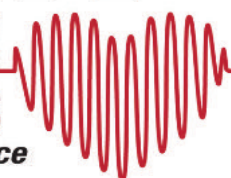

# Lawmakers push bill to help rural broadband

ALBANY — Lawmakers representing areas lacking access to high-speed internet are pushing for changes to state law that would clarify who is responsible for paying for portions of broadband expansion projects to help bridge the digital divide plaguing rural communities.

State Sen. Michelle Hinchey, D-46, who represents Coeymans and Ravena, and Assemblywoman Carrie Woerner, D-113, last Tuesday spoke about the need to pass their bill before the end of legislative session June 10. At press time the fate of the bill was unclear.

The proposed law would streamline the contract process for broadband expansion projects and more fairly distribute installation costs between broadband service providers and companies that own utility poles that hold new internet service lines.

“Without a 21st century infrastructure, we cannot have a 21st century economy, we cannot have 21st century lifestyles,” Woerner said in West Capitol Park. “The bill will start to address the drivers of cost making it harder for people in rural communities to get access to broadband. That we’re not putting all of those costs on the backs of broadband providers, but that we are sharing it between the pole owners and broadband providers.”

New high-speed fiber-optic cables are often installed on telephone poles that bring electricity and telephone landline access to every New York home. When new internet service lines are placed on utility poles, broadband providers are often hit with exorbitant unforeseen fees and costs, including to replace the entire pole, which frequently increases total project costs to several times higher than a company budgeted.

The additional costs disincentivize small broadband providers from expanding coverage in rural communities, Hinchey said. “They’re forced to scale back their build-out or move to easier-to-service communities because they’re facing exorbitant costs at the hands of big utilities,” she said. “Our bill states that we can no longer make our small broadband providers foot the bill for an entirely new pole when all they

need is a small segment of that pole to attach their infrastructure so families down the road can get online.”

The current regulations have driven up the cost of broadband expansion projects, or building out lines to serve every home, regardless of the number of homes per mile.

Rules have increased costs to deliver broadband to an unaffordable rate, Woerner said, from a break-even rate of four houses per mile to almost 12 houses per mile.

“So clearly, any community that has a low density is going to have a much higher cost to get broadband,” she said.

Utility poles are largely owned by companies, not local governments.

The proposed law would require broadband companies pay for the portion of utility pole costs needed because of broadband improvements — not to allow utility companies to charge broadband providers to replace the entire pole, especially if it was already slated for capital improvements or maintenance.

New York is not regulated by the Federal Communications Commission, which has similar regulations already in place. If passed, the bill would codify rules similar to the FCC’s in state law.

Upstate and northern New York communities, especially in rural or poor areas, have lacked access to high-speed broadband or internet services for decades. The issue predates the COVID-19 pandemic, which highlighted the need for adequate internet statewide as students shifted to all-online school and university classes, people relied on working remotely and patients accessed virtual health visits with telemedicine.

Hinchey and Woerner both said broadband access continues to be one of the leading issues among constituents.

“I have constituents who take every Zoom meeting from their car from a library over 20 minutes away, and I have families who have to choose between driving to the library parking lot to do their schoolwork or to go to work themselves,” said Hinchey. “These are impossible choices we have forced people to make. Internet is no longer a luxury, it is a lifeline.”

In many rural communities that lack a hospital, such as Greene County,

internet access is critical so residents can optimize telehealth medicine, the senator said.

Hinchey and Woerner are working to push the Legislature to pass the bill before the session ends this month, and for Gov. Andrew Cuomo to sign it into law.

“We as a state have a responsibility to ensure that every household across New York is connected to the internet, and this bill is one step we can take right now to break down the unnecessary barriers and expand access is communities that need it the most,” Hinchey said. “Every day these households go without reliable, high-speed internet is a day we are leaving them behind.”

Glen Faulkner, president and CEO of Margartville Telephone Company, which serves rural communities in parts of Delaware, Greene, Schoharie and Ulster counties, said the company supports the measure and its clarification of the financial obligations for utility pole owners and broadband service providers when installing new internet lines.

“Margartville Telephone Company is very familiar with the financial, administrative and logistical challenges faced when extending broadband infrastructure into the unserved areas,” Faulkner said in a statement Tuesday. “This legislation provides clear expectations on how pole replacement and other pole make-ready costs will be fairly allocated between the broadband service provider and utility pole owners. We thank Sen. Hinchey and Assemblymember Woerner for their efforts to streamline the pole attachment process guaranteeing that critical broadband services can be delivered expeditiously and cost-effectively to all New Yorkers.”

A detailed survey of the state’s broadband connectivity was legislated in the state’s 2021-22 budget mandating a study to examine the access and reliability of high-speed internet service statewide, identifying boundaries of underserved communities that continue to lack connection. An undetermined number of residences and communities continue to lack access to adequate internet connection after Gov. Andrew Cuomo’s \$500 million Broadband For All initiative announced in 2016.

# Town Supervisor's Message: Getting things done

Coeymans is on the right track and things are getting done!

As we head towards the summer months, it is a good time to reflect on what we as a town have been able to accomplish over the past year, and maybe even more importantly, look at what the Town Board is focused on moving forward in 2021 and beyond.

In 2020 and the first few months of 2021, the Town Board was focused on the following projects:

- Cleaned up the RK Property and restored it to the tax rolls;
- Rerouted most of the heavy truck traffic off Main Street and Church Street;
- Combined the Planning Board and Zoning Board of Appeals;
- Lowered the tax rate from \$2.91 to \$2.65 per thousand;
- Secured a grant of \$1,000,000 for Coeymans Landing Park improvements;
- Secured \$212,000 from New York for Coeymans Landing Park Stormwater Mitigation;
- Contracted for new tennis courts and a basketball court in Joralemon Park;
- Offered free Recycle Days to town residents in 2020 and 2021;
- Adopted the Updated Town Comprehensive Master Plan;
- Replaced all town streetlamps with LED lamps, as part of a cost-cutting green ini-

tiative;

- Hired a dedicated town grant writer in 2020;
  - Improved communications with the residents by instituting a town newsletter;
  - Reorganized the Coeymans Police Department under the new leadership of Chief Keyer;
  - Secured a sheriff's substation in the hamlet, doubling public safety in Coeymans; and,
  - Brought COVID-19 Testing and Vaccines to Coeymans.
- Now, as we look towards the second half of 2021 and beyond, the Town Board is focusing its efforts on the following tasks at hand:
- Designing and constructing restrooms in Coeymans Landing Park and Joralemon Park;
  - Applying for grants to improve our town parks, trail system and sewer infrastructure;
  - Working together with industry and New York to provide a dedicated truck route;
  - Overseeing the construction of a 426-acre solar farm and

finalizing the \$705,000 host community payment to Coeymans;

- Staffing and resourcing our town Food for Thought and summer recreation programs;
- Designing \$1.2 million in improvements to the Coeymans Landing Park for bid in early 2022;
- Contracting for new playground equipment in Joralemon Park; and,
- Holding the line on the budget, spending and the tax rate.

Transparency and a well-informed community is a stronger community, and the Town Board will continue its efforts to provide transparency within our local government through newsletters, town supervisor messages, and live telecasts of our town board meetings and planning/zoning board of appeals meetings.

As we continue down the path of 2021, I want to thank all of our employees, staff and board members who have given so much of themselves this past year during the height of the COVID-19 outbreak and continue to do so today.

I also would like to thank the residents and business owners of Coeymans for persevering through this global pandemic and rising to the occasion in spite of the many challenges we faced and continue to face.

# Fruit tree diseases

Instead of ushering in the summer season, as is usually the case, this past Memorial Day weekend featured a return to winter-like weather.

I don't ever recall such nasty weather this late in the season. Some people lost some tender vegetable garden plants from the cold. As my friend Ken, from Story's nursery says, "Plant early and be prepared to plant often."

I lost one of my "Big Beef" tomato plants and I am glad I did not set them all out yet! The rain was more than welcome though, as I recorded almost 2.5 inches at my house. My rain barrels runneth over!

It looks like many of us will spend some time this week mowing our lawns as our cool season grasses grow fastest under precisely these cool, wet conditions. Normally, I would be reminding you that this is a good time to fertilize your lawn as well as applying herbicides to kill dandelions and other broad-leaved lawn weeds, but with 90-degree temperatures predicted for the weekend and into next week, there is a danger of chemical "drift" that can harm your garden plants.

Certain lawn weed killers, which contain the herbicide 2-4 D, may volatilize when the temperature exceeds 85 degrees. That means they produce an invisible "gas" that can "drift" and damage plants 50 feet or more from where they are applied. Best to wait on the weed killers and even the fertilizer until it cools down once more. Grass plants shut down photosynthesis when it gets too hot, so fertilizer may be wasted if applied in really hot weather.

Several of you have inquired about a problem with your peach tree leaves. The newly expanded leaves are curled, deformed and distorted with odd, pink colors and swellings evident. This is called

"peach leaf curl" and it is caused by a fungus that overwinters on the branches and twigs of your peach tree. It looks terrible, but fortunately it does not generally affect the fruit at all and the damage is mostly cosmetic.

It cannot be treated now and like all fungal diseases, it cannot be cured once infection occurs. It must be prevented and the time to apply a preventive fungicide is late fall, after the leaves drop or early in the spring before they appear. It also helps to rake up fallen leaves in the fall and dispose of them.

My peach trees have set a huge crop once more, thanks to my hummingbird friends who arrived just in time to pollinate them! I have not seen a single honeybee this spring, but I don't recall ever seeing as many bumblebees as I have seen! Most of the bumblebees I am seeing are carpenter bees and they are drilling numerous holes in my soffits around my sheds. At times it appears to be raining sawdust beneath the sheds. I have had to resort to applying an insecticide to the exposed wood surfaces to deter them and I will be filling in the holes with wood putty for the rest of the season.

Those of you trying to

grow backyard tree fruit need to be diligent with a spray routine until at least mid-July. Apples are most susceptible to insect and disease pests followed by pears, then cherries, peaches and plums. It is sometimes possible to get a good crop of peaches or plums without spraying at all.

The most common and serious problem with plums and cherries is a disease called black knot. This is also caused by a fungus that gets inside the branches and causes them to grow a black, swollen area. The leaves and twigs beyond the swelling die and no fruit will ripen on them. You should prune off these infected twigs at least 6 inches below the swollen area. Sometimes these black growths, called "galls," will form on a main trunk and that often signals the end of the tree, but I have seen many severely infected plum trees still produce a decent crop of fruit with dozens of galls on it. Once more the fruit is unaffected.

The biggest problem with pears is a bacterial disease called "fire-blight." It causes the ends of twigs to wither, turn black and die. It appears as though the infected twigs were burned with a blowtorch!

Infection only occurs during rainy weather when the tree is in bloom. Bacteria enter the twigs through the flower blossoms and if it is hails during the bloom period, the infections are generally much worse. It does not happen every year, except to the most susceptible varieties, and sometimes this disease affects apples as well. Pruning off the blackened tissue is your only recourse. Commercial pear growers will usually apply an antibiotic spray of Streptomycin as a preventive when conditions warrant it.

Going into my fourth decade as a hearing instrument specialist, I've become very aware of the importance of auditory learning.

For example, children can't speak well if they don't hear well. It's not a stretch to say that hearing impairment affects most of our life. It's unusually hard to participate in many of the aspects of a prosperous lifestyle without first taking in stimuli through the auditory senses.

And so it is with the spirit. Jesus modeled this in the most profound way when he said, "I speak exactly what the Father has told Me to say." (John 12:50 BSB)

It would not be an exaggeration to say that the entire Gospel is summed up in that one statement. Could you imagine what it would be like if each of us

acted in such a way that reflected what God is saying to us an individual basis...in-the-now?

Getting back to my involvement with hearing-impaired people, it's almost comical to witness what happens when I take the hearing aids off a patient's ears. They impulsively say, "Wow, your voice just dropped way down — I had no idea how much I was missing."

When we don't hear

God, we can neither obey him nor properly express his love to others. Jesus would often go off by himself to pray and listen. If our prayers are just talking to God instead of hearing him, we have just made God into our own image rather than vice versa. Of course, our Heavenly Father wants us to pour out our heart to Him. But prayer is like conversation; it must be a two-way street. The old saying applies here: "God gave us two ears and only one mouth."

So how do we hear from God?

Any pastor or theologian will tell you to start with the scriptures. Many religious leaders lightly refer to the Bible as the instruction booklet or "owner's manual." Now many people don't like to read any owner's manual because

they want to figure things out on their own. How is that working out for them? It's the same thing in the spirit.

No one needs a Bible degree. But a working knowledge of scripture is essential to hearing God. This is now easier than ever as there are many Read-Through-The-Bible phone apps. You just hit a button and listen for 15 or 20 minutes each day while you're doing chores, exercising, driving or cozing up to your fireplace with your cat on your lap. There's also the old-fashioned paper version of the Bible that most people have on a bookshelf. Don't sneeze when you dust it off.

God has been speaking to me about something that I call, "Portals To Heaven." These are very simple ways of hearing God without

growing a long beard and donning a prophet's robe.

Portals To Heaven are those moment-by-moment, daily, monthly and even annual metaphors that are right in front of our faces. I refer to these experiences as the "metaphor-du-jour."

Many believers throughout history have learned to train their ears and their other senses to hear, see, taste, touch and smell the evidence of a loving God in their daily lives.

In these uncertain, volatile and even frightening times, wouldn't it be nice to know that God is as close as the experiences, situations, people and the natural world in your life today? Could it be possible He's actually speaking through your pain?

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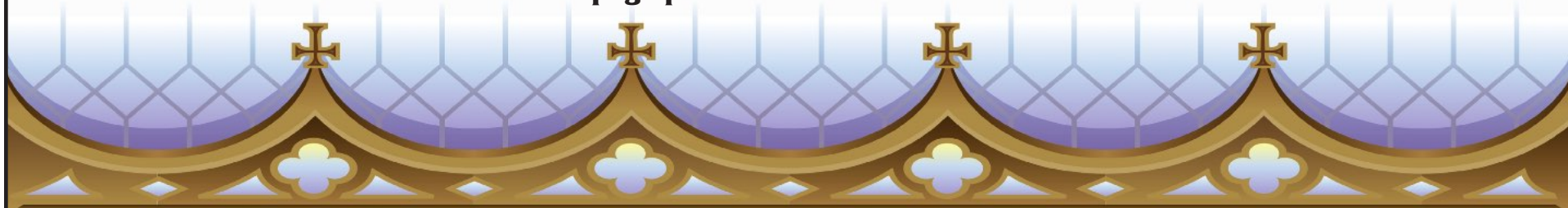
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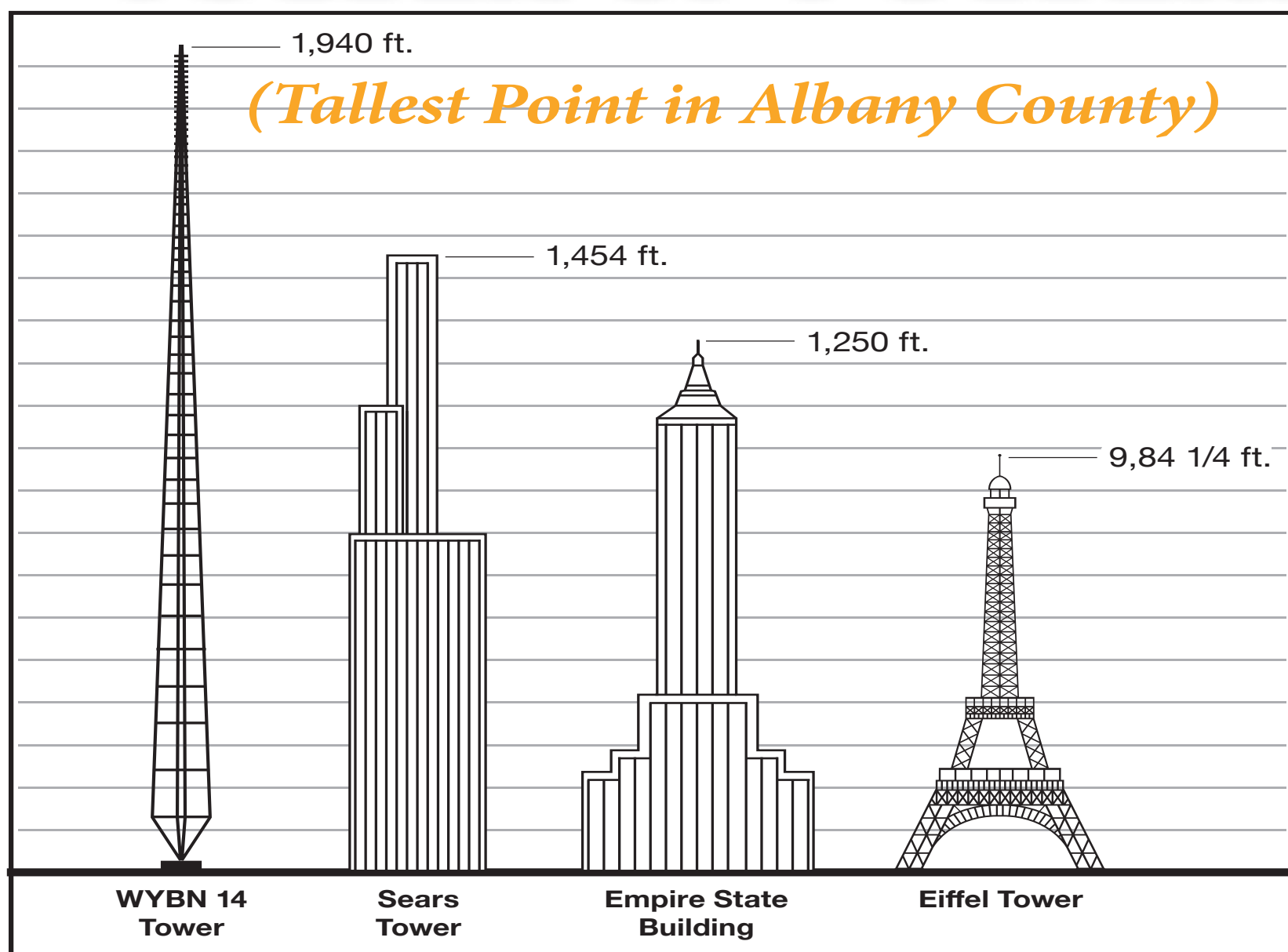
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## The importance of family traditions

Family traditions are meaningful to me. The older I get the more important it is to

preserve these annual happenings in the hope they will be passed down through generations.

One of these traditions for our family is barbecued pork spareribs on Memorial Day. This year, I'm teaching my nephew, son-in-law, two sons and oldest grandson the recipe and methods. I'm sure they may add their special tweaks to the recipe, but I'm confident the basics will remain.

I was 13 years old when my dad called me over to the grill and began teaching me. It may have been the first time my father entrusted me with this almost sacred responsibility.

I didn't understand it then, but from that day forward, ribs on Memorial Day were my responsibility, and has been since that moment.

I realized a few months ago that I've waited too long to pass the "tongs" off, so this holiday weekend was important. It represented a "changing of the guard" for our holiday tradition.

Cooking for me is an art form. There are specific techniques that create the repeated desired results. Over the years, there have been slight changes in methods and ingredients. I'm sure this next generation will do the same.

I've added a few ingredients to my cooking pallet and have slowed the cooking process down

to create a more tender result, but over the last decade, the recipe and process had reached the point that, in my mind, created the perfect slab of Moore Family barbecue spareribs.

And of course, the barbecue jokes or "dad jokes" begin.

"Why should you never barbecue on your roof? The steaks are too high."

For those of you who enjoy cooking, I barbecue ribs in three basic steps. First, I remove the membrane from the bone side of the ribs and apply a rub of salt, pepper, smoked paprika and brown sugar. I then slowly smoke them with apple wood for three hours.

Next, I wrap the ribs in aluminum foil and apply a little apple cider vinegar, butter and honey and place back on the grill for two hours.

Then the final step is to unwrap them, put on a thick coating of sauce and put them back on the grill. Check them every 15 minutes or so, making sure they do not overcook and dry out.

The weekend was everything I had hoped for. My students took the process as seriously as I hoped they would, and next year, it will be their responsibility. The ribs

were a bit rushed because the teaching process set us back a bit and as such, they were not as tender as usual. Next year will be better. I'll just sit back, watch, try to keep my mouth shut and enjoy a responsibility-free holiday for the first time since I was 13.

Ribs, of course, are not what's most important for this holiday. Another tradition is sharing the importance of why we celebrate Memorial Day. So many have given so much and it's important not to forget their ultimate sacrifice.

So, what are your family traditions? A Utah woman felt so strongly about her family fudge recipe that she had it engraved on her tombstone.

Is there something you hold so dear that it's important to you to continue after you're gone? It's never too late to begin.

And maybe it isn't passed down to you from generations before.

Maybe it begins with you?

Oh ... one last dad barbecue joke ... "My dad always said he would go to his grave with his famous barbecue rib recipe. On his death bed, he had me lean in to tell me the secret ingredient.

That's when I knew it was 'thyme.'"

# To have and have not

In a recent column I discussed what was sent to me as an “Urgent Call to Action” to get sportsmen and women to contact their assembly member to urge them to vote against a harmful bill under the guise of protecting the environment.

Specifically, to vote against A05728, a bill that would ban the use of ammunition containing lead on state-owned land and on land contributing surface water to the New York City water supply.

Given the expense and scarcity of this type of ammunition, it would effectively ban hunting on state land, NYC DEP land, and other many other properties.

It’s critical we all follow up and contact our assembly member and state senator to stop this anti-hunting bill from being passed.

The bill is up for its third reading after which it can go to the assembly floor for an up or down vote. If passed it goes to the state Senate for consideration.

So, as soon as you’re done contacting your assembly member, think about urging your state senator not to support the anti-hunting senate companion bill S05058. Just in case it makes its way to the Senate.

In the 2020 election, several NYS Assembly and Senate seats in the Hudson Valley were won by just a few hundred or less votes. Whether you are a Democrat, Independent or Republican, your state senator needs to hear from you. They work for you even though the system seems to be favoring the elite at the expense of the little guy.

Whether it’s a gun-grabbing bill that

requires gun owners to buy automobile-style liability insurance for firearms or restricting access to YOUR state lands, it seems those without substantial means are always getting the short end of it.

How so? If you own 500 acres, belong to an expensive, well-funded land-owning hunting club that may have purchased leases to various tracks of land for hunting, rules that restrict or ban activity on state land won’t affect you much.

On the other hand, if you are of more modest means and rent or own a home on a lot with a little acreage, or live in an apartment, the only opportunity open to you to freely hunt or target shoot is state or other public land.

Some types of state land like Wildlife Management Areas (WMAs) were created specifically by your tax dollars for that purpose — to give the public access to state lands managed specifically for hunting and trapping.

Now while DEC is by its nature pro-hunting, we need them to step up and

show it by spending some political capital to defeat bills like A05728 and S05058 that effectively ban hunting on state land.

Currently DEC has proposed to change regulations governing WMAs to: “Prohibit the discharge of firearms other than for hunting or trapping, except when using paper targets at areas clearly posted as open to target shooting and with suitable backstops. In addition, the proposed regulations prohibit breakable targets, such as clay pigeons, and paintballs and paintball guns.”

While it’s understandable DEC wishes to prevent litter and promote safety, especially in trouble spots on WMAs across the state, we must make sure they support target shooting on WMAs and other state land.

One way DEC can accomplish that is to include in the proposed changes to WMA rules, a plan to create and fund unmanned shooting ranges on WMAs. This is not a new idea but one that needs to be acted upon and sufficiently funded

if restrictions, no matter how beneficial, are placed within the current regulatory scheme.

Where else can a non-landowner not affiliated with a club sight in or practice shooting if not on a WMA target shooting area?

If there’s a litter problem on a WMA, send the ECOs to write tickets. That’s one of many things you pay them to do.

The elite, the wealthy and the powerful have all sorts of means to lobby government to provide them with what they want. Not so for the little guy. It’s time to keep your government officials accountable by telling them directly how you feel about bills to ban hunting, restrict access to YOUR hunting lands, or price out of existence your hobby of hunting, target shooting or just owning a firearm to simply defend hearth and home.

Happy hunting, fishing and trapping until next time.

Bridge but I can’t wrap my head around the 35 in. rule south of G.W. Granted if a 35 in. fish is taken north she may have eggs, but if she is taken south of the G.W. she will never lay another egg. So why doesn’t NY just take a lesson from Texas and issue 1 or 2 tags per person/per season for fish 30 in. and up? Or some slot limit for one trophy fish. I think most sportsmen would be willing to pay a reasonable fee for the tags as long as the money went back into striped bass research.”

Looks like a sound plan to me.

\*Urgent Calls Needed NOW for NY A5728 and S2708 Ammo Ban Bills

The lead-free ammo ban bill, A5728, is on the Assembly’s calendar 321 schedule for its third reading. After a bill is read for the third time, it will be voted on the assembly floor.

According to the NYS Conservation Council

(NYS CC), “These bills would prohibit the use of lead ammunition in the taking of wildlife on state-owned land and on land contributing surface water to the NYC water supply.”

That’s a huge swath of the state. NYSCC and like-minded rank and file sportsmen view this action as an attack on hunting in NYS.

# AKC Canine Good Citizen certifications

It’s about time I catch up to formally and publicly congratulate three very talented and committed staff members of our CGHS/SPCA family who are excellent dog trainers.

Last year, our grooming specialist, Julie Blenner, her dog Yeti, and our Animal Care Technician Taylor Jackson and her dog Maya, completed an extensive training course at my Taizé Shepherd Kennel in North Chatham, resulting in certification for their American Kennel Club Canine Good Citizen (AKC CGC) certificates!

Of special interest is that Yeti and Maya are litter mates, born at our

shelter in 2020. When they were old enough for placement, Julie and Taylor took the puppies home for what was to be quite a journey.

After completing a foundation course, they became AKC S.T.A.R. puppies, an outstanding program opened to puppies of all breeds under one year of age, with special requirements, of course.

The advanced training continued to prepare the dogs and handlers for the more stringent requirements of the AKC CGC program. In addition, I always piggyback that class with training for Therapy Dogs International (TDI), regardless of the ages of the dogs! Yeti

and Maya earned all sorts of medical equipment protocol, controlled interaction with other dogs in groups, hand-on challenges with strangers, and a good bit of counter-conditioning protocol necessary for a future therapy dog. Congratulations!

They passed with flying colors! I cannot leave out our assistant office manager, Katie Prack, who one year earlier certified with her Great Dane, Luna. We’re so proud of these young women and their dogs!

I have listed the requirements for AKC CGC certification, which has many benefits for travel, housing, insurance and more.

The CGC TEST con-

sists of 10 skills needed by all well-mannered dogs. All of the exercises are done on a leash.

- Test 1 - Accepting a friendly stranger: The dog will allow a friendly stranger to approach it and speak to the handler in a natural, everyday situation.

- Test 2 - Sitting politely for petting: The dog will allow a friendly stranger to pet it while it is out with its handler.

- Test 3 - Appearance and grooming: The dog will welcome being groomed and examined and will permit someone, such as a veterinarian, groomer or friend of the owner, to do so.

- Test 4 - Out for a walk (walking on a loose

lead): The handler/dog team will take a short “walk” to show that the

dog is in control while walking on a leash.

- Test 5 - Walking through a crowd: The dog and handler walk around and pass close to several people (at least three) to demonstrate that the dog can move about politely in pedestrian traffic and is under control in public places.

- Test 6 - Sit and down on command and staying in place: The dog will respond to the handler's commands to 1) sit, 2) down and will 3) remain in the place commanded by the handler (sit or down position, whichever the handler prefers).

- Test 7 - Coming when called: The dog will come when called by the handler. The handler will walk 10 feet from the dog, turn to face the dog, and call the dog.

- Test 8 - Reaction to another dog: To demonstrate that the dog can behave politely around other dogs, two handlers and their dogs approach each other from a distance of about 20 feet, stop, shake hands and exchange pleasantries, and continue on for about 10 feet.

- Test 9 - Reaction to distraction: To demonstrate the dog is confident when faced

with common distracting situations, the evaluator will select and present two distractions. Examples of distractions include dropping a chair, rolling a crate dolly past the dog, having a jogger run in front of the dog, or dropping a crutch or cane.

- Test 10 - Supervised separation: This test demonstrates that a dog can be left with a trusted person, if necessary, and will maintain training and good manners. Evaluators are encouraged to say something like, “Would you like me to watch your

dog?” and then take hold of the dog's leash. The owner will go out of sight for three minutes.

# Senate Dems push to create abortion access fund

ALBANY — As this year's legislative session races to a close, progressive Senate Democrats increased their push last week to pass a bill to create a public fund to help low-income New Yorkers with abortion expenses and related care.

The bill, sponsored by Sen. Alessandra Biaggi, D-34, and Assemblywoman Karines Reyes, D-87, would create the New York State Abortion Access fund to allow taxpayers to make a voluntary donation to the fund on their personal income taxes.

The fund would have no minimum requirement or be supported by other public dollars.

"Many low-income New Yorkers — young people, people of color and undocumented immigrants — face very difficult financial barriers to accessing abortion care," Biaggi said in West Capitol Park in Albany. "Obstacles like travel expenses, child care, the cost of the procedure itself, should never be things that stand in the way of exercising someone's constitutional and constitutionally protected right to choose."

Lawmakers are pushing to strengthen New York's abortion laws as the highest federal court is slated to take up a case in the next term that could affect abortion access in other states.

"As abortion rights are under attack across this entire country, New York has to — it must — continue to be a beacon of

light for those who seek care by creating an abortion access fund," Biaggi said. "...Even if New Yorkers donate just \$1, it is sufficient enough to make a difference."

New Yorkers have the option of donating to other similar funds when filing their income tax returns, such as efforts to preserve trees or aid retired racehorses.

Taxpayers could donate as much, or as little, as they choose if the measure to create the fund becomes law.

Officials argued passing the measure would create equity in sexual

and reproductive health care.

If passed, the fund would be available to any person seeking abortion access in New York, including out-of-state residents.

The state Health Department commissioner would issue a request for proposals to fund nonprofits that provide support to women seeking abortion services. Monies would be payable from the fund through the state Comptroller's Office on vouchers approved by the state health commissioner, according to the pro-

posed law.

The fund would also assist nonprofit organizations that help New Yorkers overcome logistics to access abortion care.

Robin Chappelle Golston, president and CEO of Planned Parenthood Empire State Acts, said the fund would provide support to individuals in need of abortion services regardless of income or location.

"It also destigmatizes abortion by being seen as it truly is: Health care," Golston said, adding the fund would help break down remaining barriers to abortion access state-

wide.

"We know the greater the distance, comes greater out-of-pocket costs and delayed care," she said. "A voluntary contribution to support abortion access funds would provide New Yorkers an impactful way to support reproductive health care for all."

Travel and costs pose some of the greatest barriers to abortion access, especially for women in rural communities and those seeking abortion services later in pregnancy, Brigid Alliance Executive Director Odile Schalit said.

"Ultimately, many

would take extreme measures to get there, while many others would abandon their desires or needs to have an abortion entirely," Schalit said.

The alliance, formed in 2018, assists people traveling into New York to access abortion services because their state or locality lacks a provider or New Yorkers who were delayed in accessing care.

"...For too many and for too long, barriers like the cost of procedures have prevented people from accessing timely, life-affirming and life-saving abortions, from having their basic health care needs met," Schalit said. "Financial issues like the cost of procedures cause significant delays in accessing care, increasing the risk of mental health outcomes and the risk of pregnant people finding alternative means of ending their pregnancies."

Abortion-access organizations help arrange transportation or ride-sharing services, help with gas, toll or car rental expenses, housing or meal stipends to assist women unable to access abortion services.

The bill was referred to the Senate Finance Committee on Jan. 6. The Assembly measure was referred to the Ways and Means Committee on Jan. 13.

From January to April, congressional legislators from 46 states have introduced 536 bills to reduce abortion access and 146 abortion bans.

New York is a reproductive health care sanctuary state.

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# Should my wife wait until 70 to claim?

## Dear Rusty:

I'm 74 and receiving my Social Security benefits. My wife is 68 and we are delaying her benefits until she's 70. But I read an article about a wife receiving half of her husband's benefit, which makes me wonder if my wife waiting is smart. Please let me know your thoughts.

## Dear Wondering:

Your wife waiting until she is 70 to claim her own SS retirement benefit may be a smart move, but only if her age 70 benefit will be more than the benefit she is already entitled to as your spouse.

Her benefit as your spouse is 50% of the benefit you were entitled to at your full retirement age (66). She would get

that 50% because she has already reached her own full retirement age (FRA), but your wife's spousal benefit doesn't grow beyond what she's entitled to at her FRA. Her own SS retirement benefit, however, grows by .667% per month until she is 70, at which point it

reaches maximum (32% more than her FRA benefit amount). So, the question is, which will be higher — her spouse benefit, or her age 70 benefit? If the answer is her spousal benefit, then she should claim that now. But if the answer is her age 70 benefit, waiting until she is 70 makes more sense.

There is, however, another option that would work even better if your wife's own benefit at age 70 will be her highest.

Since you are already collecting, and because your wife was born in 1953, she is eligible to file a "restricted application for spousal benefits only." Doing so would allow her to collect her 50% spouse benefit from you now, while still allowing her own SS retirement benefit to grow to maximum

at age 70. That would give your wife half of your FRA benefit amount each month, while she simultaneously maximizes her own SS retirement benefit. Then at age 70, when her personal benefit reaches maximum, she can switch to her own higher benefit.

I suggest that your wife get a Statement of Estimated Benefits from Social Security to determine if her age 70 benefit will be higher than her spouse benefit. If so, she can file the "restricted application for spouse benefits only" and then simply wait until she is 70 to switch from her spouse benefit to her own higher benefit (32% more than her FRA amount).

Note that this "restricted application for spouse benefits only" option is

no longer available to anyone born after Jan. 1, 1954, but is still available to your wife because she was born before that. Unless her spousal benefit will be her highest, I suggest that your wife file the "restricted application for spouse benefits only" which will give her 50% of your FRA benefit amount (including COLA awarded since then). She should also ask for six months retroactive spouse benefits since she was eligible to do this at her FRA.

The easiest way for your wife to get her Statement of Estimated Benefits is by using her personal "My Social Security" online account. If she doesn't yet have an online account with Social Security, it is easy to create one at [www.ssa.gov/myaccount](http://www.ssa.gov/myaccount). She will need that account anyway to apply for her benefits online, which is by far the most efficient way to apply.

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# Windham Mountain getting \$4M upgrade

WINDHAM — Windham Mountain is undergoing a \$4 million capital improvement project.

"Renovations have already started," Windham Mountain spokesman Dan Toth said.

The project will include upgrades to snowmaking equipment, the addition of an environmentally friendly groomer — which prepares the snow for recreational use — a revamped children's center and more.

"We want to provide an experience 'Above and Beyond' for visitors at Windham Mountain and make it a premier destination at the Catskills more so than any other destination," Toth said.

The \$4 million improvement project is expected to be completed in time for the winter 2021-22 ski season, according to a statement from Windham Mountain.

With the improvements, automated snowmaking on several trails will be extended including the Wraparound, Wonderama and Warpath Chute trails. The upgraded snowmaking equipment will produce snow faster and allow for faster recovery from freeze and thaw cycles, according to Windham Mountain.

The resort is also purchasing a PistenBully 600E+, a diesel-electric snow groomer that

is expected to use 20% less fuel and generate 20% less carbon dioxide, according to the resort.

"The green PistenBully 600E+ reduces environmental impact and builds toward a cleaner future without sacrificing power," according to the statement. "Further sustainability efforts include 10 additional electric-vehicle charging stations, enhanced recycling and energy-saving measures across the resort."

Improvements also include redevelopment of the Children's Learn-

ing Center focused on teaching kids to ski and snowboard.

"The renovations to the Kid's Center will create a modern and innovative facility designed to enhance the lesson experience for young skiers and snowboarders," Dan Hogan, director of Snow Sports School, said.

The capital project will also bring new shuttle buses, a new ski and snowboard tuner, and a new conveyor lift for the Whisper Run beginner trail.

Upgrades planned for

the summer will be made at the Winwood Inn and the Bike Park for mountain bikers, which will open June 19.

Area ski resorts — Windham and Hunter mountains — had a good winter this year despite the COVID-19 outbreak, Karl Heck, director of Greene County Economic Development and Planning, said.

"Both ski areas seem to have had a good season and the weather was good," Heck said. "Whenever the resorts get through Easter and

are still open, that's a good thing."

The renovations could drive more tourists — and tourism dollars — into the county, Heck said.

"The new renovations are a help and Windham Mountain has spent a lot of money on recent improvements," Heck said. "A lot of the improvements, like automated snowmaking and an improved children's center, could increase capacity."

When tourists visit county resorts, it's a

boon for the local economy, Greene County Legislature Chairman Patrick Linger, R-New Baltimore, said. "People generally don't come up for a day trip — they stay in inns and hotels, they eat in restaurants — so there is a pretty significant economic impact outside the ski resort."

"If there is a bad day for skiing they may go shopping or hit a brewery," he added. "They find there is so much here to do and they go out and spend money elsewhere in the county."

# Clock starts ticking on pandemic recovery grants

ALBANY — Small businesses can begin June 10 applying for pandemic recovery grants from the state.

Grant amounts will range from \$5,000 to \$50,000.

"The state has put up \$800 million," Greene County Economic Development and Planning Director Karl Heck said. "The grants can be used for reimbursable pandemic expenses like payroll, supplies and materials related to COVID, rent and mortgage."

State funds could prove a lifeline for many businesses as the economy begins to reopen after

months of shutdowns due to the virus outbreak.

"A lot of businesses were closed during the pandemic and they weren't making any revenue," Heck said.

Gov. Andrew Cuomo announced May 25 the funds would be available through the Small Business Recovery Grant Program to help businesses recover from the economic impact of the pandemic.

"New Yorkers and small businesses in every corner of the state were devastated by the pandemic, and as we continue to recover and rebuild we need to make sure they have the resources they need to get back on their feet and succeed in

a new, reimagined economy," Cuomo said when he announced the funding.

There are economic requirements businesses need to meet to be eligible for the funding.

"They have to have had gross receipts between \$25,000 and \$500,000 for the years 2019 or 2020, at least one of those two years, and demonstrate at least 25% loss in gross receipts year over year," Heck said.

COVID-related expenses that are eligible for reimbursement must have been incurred between March 1, 2020, and April 1, 2021, and can include payroll costs; commercial rent or mortgage payments; local property or

school taxes; insurance and utility costs; expenses related to the purchase of personal protection equipment, or PPE; heating, ventilation and air-conditioning costs; supplies and materials needed to be in compliance with COVID protocols; and other machinery or equipment costs, according to the state website.

The grants could prove to be a boon to local small business owners, Heck said.

"Hundreds of Greene County businesses could benefit," he said. "We have a lot of small businesses so there are a lot in that demographic. A significant number of people would be eligible so we want to get the word out

that this is an opportunity for recovery."

Small business owners are encouraged to apply as close to the June 10 start date as possible. Previous pandemic recovery programs ran out of money long before many businesses put in their applications, Heck said.

"It is better to apply early. As the federal Restaurant Revitalization Fund showed, that was important — it was oversubscribed," he said. "Businesses applied for double the amount of money that was available."

That recovery program had \$28 billion in available funds, Heck said.

"They got almost \$60 billion worth of applica-

tions in three weeks and had to shut it down," he added.

The state's Small Business Recovery Grant Program will award grants, not loans, so the funds do not have to be paid back.

"There are still businesses that are looking for restart capital and others that are limping along," Heck said. "The smaller businesses had less capital at the beginning of the pandemic and would probably be harder pressed to get fully going."

# Delgado holds 1st in-person town hall since pandemic began

U.S. Rep. Antonio Delgado, D-19, held his first in-person town hall meeting since the start of the COVID-19 pandemic last Tuesday in Hyde Park.

Delgado discussed the challenges of getting relief funding to small and rural communities during the pandemic.

"We've got two things ahead of us in the near future," Delgado said. "The American Jobs Plan and the American Families Plan. We have not really invested in our infrastructure in decades. We are still operating on 20th century technology."

Our local communities have health care facilities that need investment, areas that need greater access to broadband, and a need for housing investment.

"We have a real opportunity here to double down on our future," Delgado said. "This is not about spending money without a return on that investment. We're going to get the return. There's great investment in housing, great investment in our roads and our bridges, great investment in our water infrastructure, in our broadband systems, our workforce development."

There are a lot of investment opportunities with the American Jobs Plan and the American Families Plan, Delgado said.

The COVID-19 pandemic has caused people to rethink their priorities and reassess what matters to them, Delgado said.

"When the CARES Act was passed back in March of last year there was a cut-off for state and local funding," Delgado said. "Only those localities with populations greater than 500,000 people were given direct federal relief to offset the loss of sales tax revenue, property tax, to offset the loss of small businesses generating economic profits for the community. None of that went to our localities here in our rural communities."

A funding formula Delgado worked to create was later used to conceive the American Rescue Plan, which includes \$130 billion for localities across the country. He said this gives localities all across the 19th District access to funding.

"Local governments in NY-19, all 11 counties, all the towns there are going to have over \$400 million," Delgado said. "This is a big deal because it means we're actually enabling communities. We're giving folks the resources on the ground, the individuals with situational awareness who know how to utilize these funds. The government, big government, is putting its hands

down to help and then getting out of the way."

The funding allows for those communities to decide what they will use it for, without the federal government dictating how they will use it, Delgado said.

"I think this is how we can legislatively can restore people's faith in the system too," Delgado said. "When they see the government not putting handcuffs on them in terms of what they can do and not do with the funding we give you but enables you to invest that into your community and empower you, to propel you into the future."

A number of people asked questions of the Congressman. One man told Delgado about the need in Hyde Park for an improved sewer system, which would be able to help local businesses and allow for improvements to local tourism restaurants and hotels. Delgado said this issue of infra-

structure, both above and below ground is one that is found throughout the 19th district, as both a safety concern and an economic concern, and there are federal funds available for projects like this. Another question came from a woman who asked about net neutrality and how it plays into expanding broadband. Delgado said people learned through COVID how critical accessing information is to everyone. He said broadband has become a necessity for educational purposes, telemedicine and health purposes, and for small businesses to be able to run.

"When I talk about broadband, first I'm talking about making sure everybody has it," Delgado said. "The fact that we have folks going without it is really an issue."

Last Tuesday's town hall was Delgado's 56th since taking office, he said.

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# Creative Summer Moments

**W**arm, sunny days are the perfect setting for making family memories, but they're also ideal opportunities to encourage kids to get creative and let their imaginations soar.

These ideas for summertime activities encourage family interaction, and the more kids get to help plan and organize the details, the more engaged you can expect them to be.

### Visit Your Local Park

Pack all the kids' favorite snacks and beverages to keep cool and hydrated. Choose your spot under a big shady tree and spread out for an impromptu picnic. ## Mess-Free Watercolor Art

Learn how to make a faux watercolor masterpiece using Zebra Pen Mildliner Brush Pens.

1. Sketch your design using a pencil.
2. Trace over your pencil design with a bleed-proof technical drawing pen. Be sure to erase any pencil lines still showing.
3. Use brush pens to add blocks of color to each area, but don't worry about thoroughly covering each line. Use more colors to add more visual interest and depth.
4. Focus on one section of the design at a time.
5. Dip a clean paint brush into a cup of water. The brush should be well saturated but not so wet that it's dripping.
6. Move the wet paint brush over the color blocks, spreading color to cover white spaces and blend.
7. Once the design is dry, use brush pens to add details and accent colors then trace over original design lines to add bolder borders.
