

Comet Nishimura and the Month of the Bride

OF THE MANY coincidences associated with Comet Nishimura, one of the most compelling has to do with its orbit.

According to astronomers, the last time the comet returned from its long journey around the Sun, to pass by Earth, was 435 years ago.

In the Strong's index of every Greek and Hebrew word in Scripture, #435 Greek is the word "*anér*," meaning "betrothed or future husband."

Additionally, the first name of the comet's discoverer, Hideo, means "husband."

That the long-orbit Comet Nishimura has a dual connection to the word husband is significant, because Jesus is depicted as a husband who is returning from a long journey:

"My husband is not at home, He has gone on a journey far away ... and will come home at the day appointed" (Prov. 7:19, 20).

There is more.

Strong's #435 Hebrew is the word "Elul," referring to the sixth biblical month, which Jews call the "month of the bride." With this in mind, it is striking that Elul 1 (August 18) is when the newly discovered Comet Nishimura began to make news:

Throughout the month of Elul, astronomy and prophecy circles have been abuzz about Comet Nishimura. But the most remarkable part of the comet's concurrence with Elul is that it will reach perihelion, or shine it's brightest, as the "month of the bride" is ending on September 16–17. Moreover, that same day, the Feast of Trumpets, Comet Nishimura will enter the Constellation Virgo, the sign depicting a virgin as a symbol of God's people:

"At that time the kingdom of heaven will be like ten virgins who took their lamps and went out to meet the bridegroom. Five of them were foolish and five were wise" (Matt. 25).

After the Feast of Trumpets, the comet will sweep toward the left hand of Virgo, which holds a sheaf of wheat, before exiting the sign of the virgin on September 23, the last day of summer.

In summary:

- The 435-year orbit of Comet Nishimura points to the Strong's #435 words, "betrothed," "husband," and "Elul."
- The comet was discovered by Hideo Nishimura, whose first name means "husband," a week before Elul began in 2023.
- All during Elul, skywatchers have been abuzz about the newly discovered comet.
- As Elul ends, Comet Nishimura will shine its brightest as it enters Virgo at the Feast of Trumpets.
- Finally, the comet will sweep toward Virgo's sheaf of wheat, and then exit the sign around the last day of summer.

Scripture says the heavens speak to us:

"The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands. Day after day they pour forth speech; night after night they reveal knowledge" (Ps. 19:1, 2).

The message of Comet Nishimura is that the Bridegroom is coming. Exactly when He will arrive, no one knows. But judging by the signs, it is soon.

3. Name meanings:

Hideo means "husband."

Nishimura means “to go west.”

This is significant because Jesus’ return is said to be as lightning flashes from “east to west” (Matt. 24:27).

4. Coincidentally, the Gematria value of the name Hideo Nishimura is 153, corresponding to the 153 fish, symbolic of Christians, who are “caught up” and brought before the Lord (John 21).

5. It appears that Hideo Nishimura was chosen by God to discover the comet. Subtracting 435 years from 2023, we arrive at the year of the comet’s last visit 1588. Strong’s #1588 is the Greek word “*eklektos*,” referring to one who is “chosen out by God for the rendering of special service to Him.”

6. Comet Nishimura’s last fly-by in 1588 was a Sabbatical year, so there are “62 weeks” between the comet’s two visits in 1588 and 2023 (Dan. 9:25).
