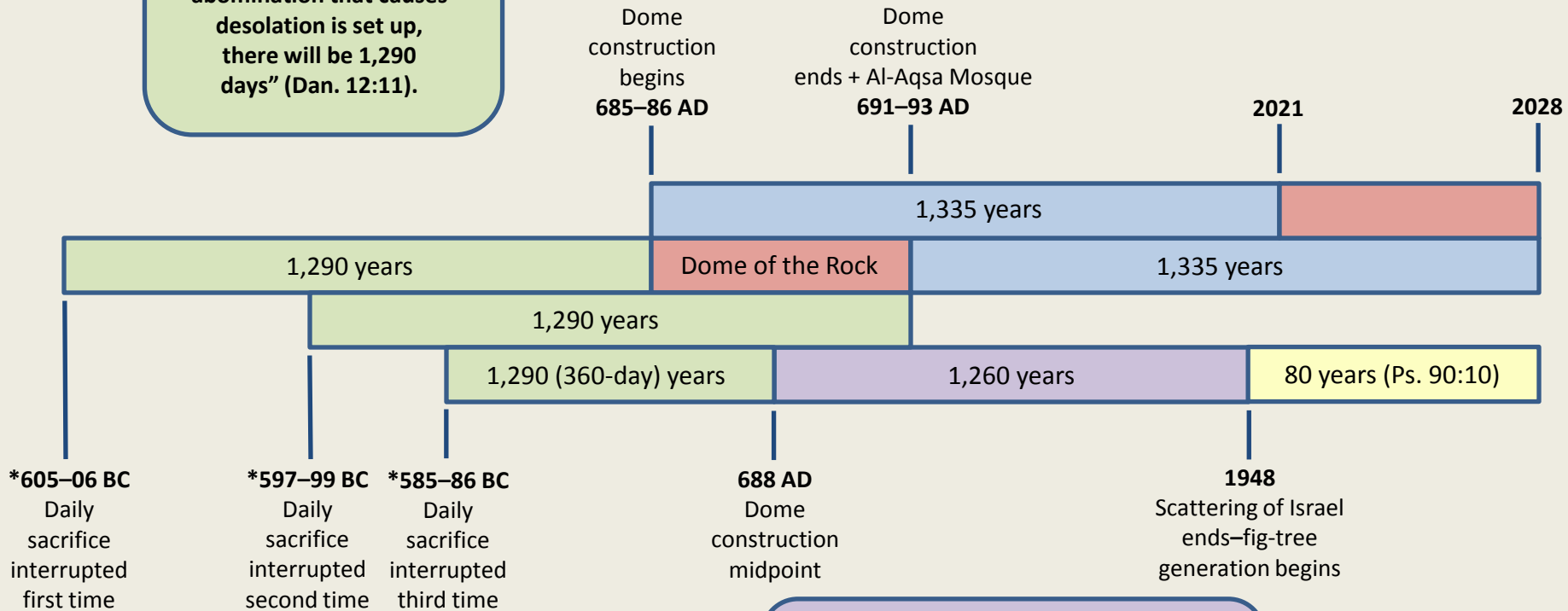


Timeline Convergence: Daniel 12 and the Fig-Tree Generation

“From the time that the daily sacrifice is taken away and the abomination that causes desolation is set up, there will be 1,290 days” (Dan. 12:11).

“Blessed is the one who waits for and reaches the end of the 1,335 days” (Dan. 12:12).



*Nebuchadnezzar invaded Jerusalem three times, interrupting the daily sacrifice. Counting 1,290 years from these dates, we arrive at key dates related to the Dome of the Rock. Counting 1,260 years from the Dome of the Rock, we arrive at the start of the fig-tree generation. Counting 1,335 years from the Dome of the Rock, we arrive at the calculated end of the fig-tree generation.

“It shall be for a time, times, and an half [1,260 days]; and when he shall have accomplished to scatter the power of the holy people, all these things shall be finished” (Dan. 12:7).
