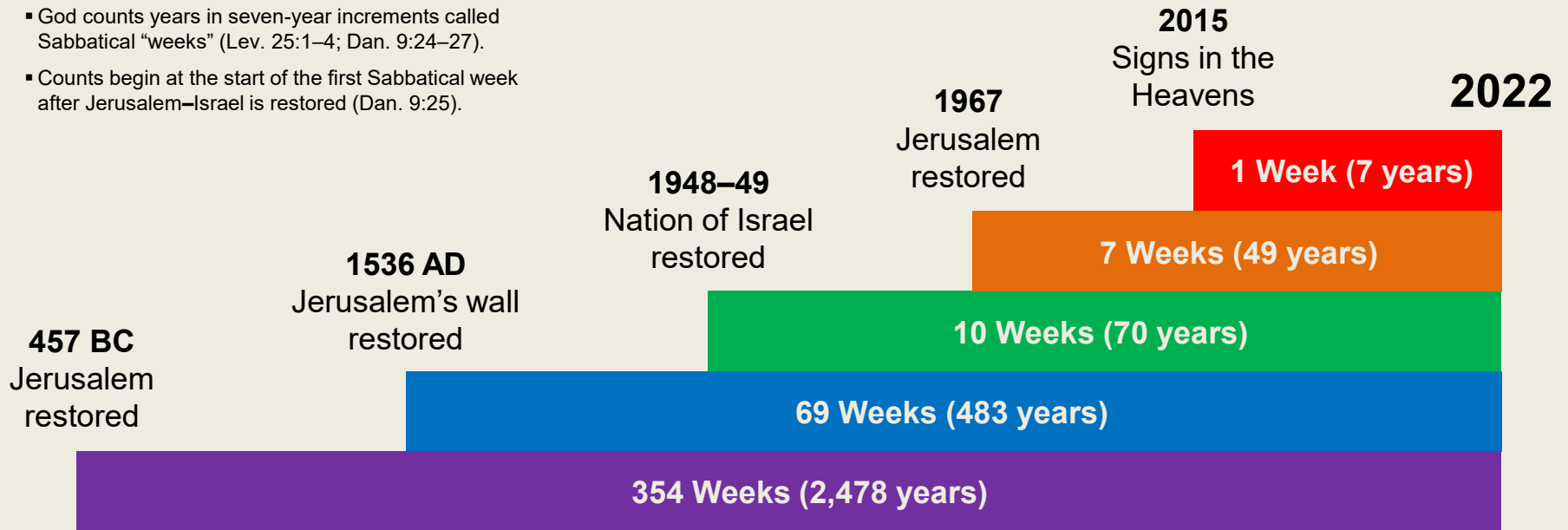


Biblical Timeline Convergence 2022

NOTES:

- God counts years in seven-year increments called Sabbatical “weeks” (Lev. 25:1–4; Dan. 9:24–27).
- Counts begin at the start of the first Sabbatical week after Jerusalem–Israel is restored (Dan. 9:25).



- 1 week denotes a period of warning or preparation (Gen. 7:1–4; 41:25–30).
- 7 weeks precede Messiah the Prince or a Jubilee (Dan. 9:25; Lev. 25:8–10).
- 10 weeks denote a typical lifespan, or generation, and a time of release (Matt. 24:32–34; Ps. 90:10; Jer. 29:10).
- 69 weeks precede Messiah the Prince (Dan. 9:25).
- 354 denotes the fullness of time, as a 12-month biblical year is comprised of 354 days.
