Laugh with us, cringe with us, and above all, remember that everyone has a place in the story. *Puffs* is not just a parody; it's a celebration of finding strength in ourselves and those we care about, no matter how "ordinary" we may feel. Thank you for joining us, and we hope you leave with a smile, a sense of belonging, and maybe a bit more Puff pride.

Sam Benson


