



## **5<sup>th</sup> Annual Women's City Public Links Tournament Entry**

**36 Hole Stroke Play:** Saturday, August 28<sup>th</sup> at Yahara Hills Golf Course – East Course  
Sunday, August 29<sup>th</sup> at Odana Hills Golf Course  
(MUST HAVE A VALID WSGA HANDICAP AS OF 8/25/21 TO ENTER.)

Tee times beginning at 8:00am both days. Tee times for the Sunday round will be determined at the conclusion of the Saturday round based on player performance. Please call Odana (608)266-4724 or Yahara (608)229-8250 after 5:00pm Saturday to receive your Sunday tee time or check the tournament website (found at bottom of this page).

**\*Golf Cart Fees not included. Must pay for cart rental the day of the tournament. Cart rental is optional. Price is \$18+tax per player for cart rental per day.**

Entries must be paid online by Wednesday August 25<sup>th</sup> at 5:00pm. No late entries will be accepted. **Entry fee covers greens fees, range balls, purse, and awards.**

### **36 Hole Flighted Championship:**

- Flights determined by number of entries. All flights will play gross and net. If a player wins a gross purse prize, they are not eligible to win a net purse prize.
- Winner will have their name engraved on a perennial trophy. Other prizes will be awarded to flight champions.
- All award money will be given in the form of City of Madison Club Credit added to player's account.
- Participant withdrawals may be made up to 48 hours in advance.
- Within 48 hours of the tournament, no tournament entry refunds will be granted.
- Championship flight will play the White Tees. All other flights will play Gold Tees.

**Optional Skins Game:** \$20.00 covers both days of the event paid on day one. Championship flight will have its own Gross Skins Game. All other flights will have their own Net Skins Game.

### **36 Hole Championship Eligibility Requirements:**

- Open to all female public course amateur golfers.
- Must have a valid WSGA Handicap from a public golf course as of 8/25/21.
- High school competitors may only accept the championship trophy due to WIAA regulations regarding Amateur Status.
- Tournament Director may grant up to five (5) private course exemptions.

**Dress Code:** Proper golf attire, including a shirt, slacks, skirt or shorts and shoes.

**Entry Deadline:** Wednesday, August 25<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 pm. Late entries not accepted once pairings have been made.



## **City of Madison Public Links Tournament Informational Sheet**

**Rainout Procedure:** If in the unlikely event of inclement weather, all players have completed 9 holes, but not all players have completed 18-holes, the daily event scores will be based on 9-holes. If any players fail to complete 9-holes due to weather, the day will be cancelled.

If inclement weather cancels play on both days, entry fees will be returned to players in the form of City of Madison Gift Cards.

**Tiebreaking Procedure:** Any players competing for the overall Public Links Championship will play a sudden death playoff beginning on Hole #1 and following holes in succession until a Champion is determined.

Any ties within A, B, C and D flights will be broken by a sudden death scorecard playoff starting at the #1 handicap hole and following in succession by handicap holes until a Flight Champion is determined.

**Payouts:** Each flight will pay out the top 20% of its field. All prize money will be awarded in the form of City of Madison Club Credit that will be added to a player's account.

Skins money will be awarded in the form of City of Madison Club Credit that will be added to a player's account.

**Drawing for Season Pass, Hole in One and Door Prizes:** Participants that withdraw from the tournament are not eligible. Must be present to win door prizes, do not need to be present to win 2022 Season Pass Membership. Tournament must have a minimum 20 participants for the drawing to take place.
