



1st Annual Tee off to Fall - Two Player Net Best-Ball Tournament Entry

Two Player One Net Best-Ball: Sunday, September 12, 2021

Tee times beginning at 9:00am

Entry Fees: (Covers both Players Entry & Greens Fees)

- **Two Non-Loyalty Players:** **\$160.00**
- **One Loyalty Player/One Non-Loyalty Player:** **\$155.00**
- **Two Loyalty Players:** **\$150.00**
- **One Season Pass Player/One Non-Loyalty Player:** **\$120.00**
- **One Season Pass Player/One Loyalty Player:** **\$115.00**
- **Two Season Pass Players:** **\$80.00**

Golf Cart Fees not included. Cart rental is optional. Must pay for cart rental the day of the tournament. Cart rate is \$18+tax per player.

Entries must be paid online by Wednesday September 8th at 5:00pm. No late entries will be accepted. **Entry fee covers greens fees, range balls, purse, and awards.**

Handicap allowances are designed to provide equity for players of all levels of ability in each format of play, over both 9 holes and 18 holes. The handicap allowance for this event will be at 85% of total handicap.

- For example, player A, with a handicap index of 12.8 would have a playing handicap index of 11.1. Player B with a handicap index of 17.4, would have a playing handicap index of 15.1.

Tees: Men will play BLUE tees. Women will play GOLD Tees.

- Trophies awarded to the Championship team only. Names will be engraved on perennial trophy.
- Participant withdrawals can be made up to 48 hours in advance. Within 48 hours of the tournament, no tournament entry refunds will be granted.

Optional: \$20.00 INDIVIDUAL SKINS GAME paid on the day of the event. Will be paid out in CASH! A gross and net skins game will take place simultaneously.

Entry Deadline: Wednesday, September 8 at 5:00 pm. Late entries not accepted once pairings have been made.

Rainout Procedure: If in the event of inclement weather, all players have completed 9 holes, but not all players have completed 18-holes, the daily event scores will be based on 9-holes. If any players fail to complete 9-holes due to weather, the day will be cancelled, and entry fees returned to players in the form of Golf Madison Parks Club Credit.

Tiebreaking Procedure: Scorecard Playoff beginning on the #1 handicap hole and following in succession until a winner is determined.

Payouts:

- The tournament will pay out the top 20% of the field. All prize money will be awarded in the form of a City of Madison Club Credit that will be added to a player's account.
- Skin money will be awarded in the form of Cash that will be available for pick up the next day following the event.
- Trophies will be awarded to the Championship team only. Names will be engraved on perennial trophy.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Open to all public course amateur golfers. Co-ed Tournament.
- Must have a valid WSGA Handicap as of 9/8/21.
- High school competitors may only accept the championship trophy due to WIAA regulations regarding Amateur Status.

Participant withdrawals can be made up to 48 hours in advance. Within 48 hours of the tournament, no tournament entry refunds will be granted.
