Austria's putting on a wood show

Ever seen such a wooden performance? Inspired by a famous 1970 drawing by artist Max Peintner, curator

Klaus Littmann has installed 299 real trees in the Wörthersee football stadium in the southern Austrian city of Klagenfurt. *For Forest* is a statement about climate change – imagine if trees were so endangered they became exhibits? – and it's free to view, for both the ruminating public and the wildlife that will certainly fly in to check it out. Catch Austria's largest public artwork before it's uprooted and safely returned to its native habitat. *For Forest: The Unending Attraction of Nature*, by Klaus Littmann, is at Wörthersee Stadium in Klagenfurt until 27 October. forforest.net
