**The Persecuted Church: Laos**

**Arsonists Target Church Leader's Home**

It has been a difficult year for a group of Khmu believers in northern Laos. Last April, village authorities demanded that they renounce their Christian faith or leave the village. After extended negotiations, the authorities had a dramatic change of heart in December and issued a proclamation protecting the Christians' right to practice their faith. The believers celebrated at a Christmas worship service in another city, and eight other families decided to become followers of Christ. However, in the middle of the night on Jan. 23, someone poured gasoline around the home of one of the Christian leaders and tried to burn it down. Fortunately, the fire was noticed in time and successfully extinguished. The arsonists left a note warning Christians to leave the village or "your life will not be safe." Pray for this particular church leader, who is scared and thinking about leaving the village. "If he leaves, many of the Christians will be discouraged," a VOM contact said. Pray that the other Christians will remain firm in their faith.
