**THE PERSECUTED CHURCH: Nigeria
Fulani Islamic Militants Attack Christians in Plateau State**

On January 8, 2020, Fulani Islamic militants attacked the predominantly Christian village of Kulben, in northern Nigeria’s Plateau state, killing at least 12. The men of the village took their wives and children to safety in the bush before returning to defend their homes and land from the three-hour onslaught. Since the attack, 36 villagers have been staying in a nearby village, as most are now too afraid to return home. Pray for those who lost family members, homes and farmland in these attacks.

Continue to pray for area churches: Ebenezer Presbyterian, St. John’s Lutheran, First Lutheran, United Methodist, Holy Redeemer, Our Saviors Lutheran, Temple of Jesus Christ, Hispanic Church and Emden. Ask God to continue to move through His church to the glory of His kingdom. Remember—we are part of God’s kingdom and need to always be following Him.
