The Persecuted Church - West Africa **Fulani Believers Receive Bibles**

This year, many Fulani believers have received audio Bibles as part of an ongoing effort to deliver God's Word among the Fulani tribes in central and northern Sahel. Distributions of Bibles among the Fulani have resulted in many salvations and the spread of the gospel across the Sahel over the past few years as many are eager to hear God's Word. Pray that these Fulani Christians will grow in their faith as they learn the Scriptures. Pray that many more Muslims in the Sahel will be eager to hear Scripture and will come to know Christ.
