**CHRISTIAN REFORMED CHURCH - Vietnam
Displaced Families Temporarily Hosted by Local Christians**

Thirteen Christian families are temporarily living with Christian host families in another province after being displaced by the government. All 13 families lost land, homes and possessions when they were confiscated by local governments, and they were also subjected to forced labor. A local pastor is currently caring for the families. *“Please share their stories and give them prayers in this difficult time,”* wrote a VOM coordinator.

Continue to pray for area churches: Ebenezer Presbyterian, St. John’s Lutheran, First Lutheran, United Methodist, Holy Redeemer, Our Saviors Lutheran, Temple of Jesus Christ, Hispanic Church and Emden. Ask God to continue to move through His church to the glory of His kingdom. Remember—we are part of God’s kingdom and need to always be following Him.
