**THE PERSECUTED CHURCH: Pakistan
Supreme Court Overturns Asia Bibi's Conviction
and Death Sentence**

Christians around the world are rejoicing at the news that Asia Bibi's blasphemy conviction and death sentence have been overturned after nine and a half years in prison. Pakistan's Supreme Court announced its ruling on October 31, after reviewing her appeal several weeks earlier. The Court's ruling is highly controversial in this conservative Muslim nation; in addition to widespread protests, two churches have already been attacked. Pray for Christians throughout Pakistan in the aftermath of this ruling. Praise God for this result, and continue to pray for Asia and her family.

Continue to pray for area churches: Ebenezer Presbyterian, St. John's Lutheran, First Lutheran, United Methodist, Holy Redeemer, Our Saviors Lutheran, Temple of Jesus Christ, Hispanic Church and Emden.
