From Anthony & Sara: I wanted to share with you another testimony about preaching. Back in January I preached about integrity at a large Pentecostal church here in town during a special event. I know that this message challenged people a lot, and many people thanked me. But sometimes I, like other preachers, wonder how much impact my sermons are really making. I preached at the same church again more recently. After the service someone came up to talk to me about the integrity message. He said that after that message he repented, recommitted himself to serving Christ faithfully, and he is a different person today. No more does he give in to lying or corruption. He feels like a new man, and he is no longer ashamed of himself.

He gave me a specific example. He is a teacher. A former student came to him who was trying to get into a special internship program, one that would probably secure her a good job in the future. Her grades weren't quite good enough, but this teacher had the power to change them and of course her family was going to pay him to do so. Although he could have really used that money, he shocked the student and her family by saying, "No, I cannot do those kinds of things anymore." Such testimonies remind me that God is at work through his Word even when I don't always see it or hear about it.

Young Woman Chooses Faith in Jesus over Family

Kaili came to know Christ in 2017, after a teacher shared the gospel with her. But when Kaili's mother found out, she told her daughter to abandon her new faith. Kaili explained that she could not turn her back on Jesus. *"I have witnessed His love for me and know that Jesus is true,"* she told her mother. So her mother then removed Kaili's name from the official family registry and told her they were no longer mother and daughter. Kaili moved in with her pastor's family, and when she visited her family several months later many villagers noticed that she had changed. When they asked her about it, she told them, *"Jesus taught me. I want to follow the right way and honor Him."* Kaili's mother warned her to leave because village authorities were planning to arrest her. *"Please don't come back,"* her mother told her. Pray for Kaili and for the pastor who is currently caring for her.

Continue to pray for area churches: Ebenezer Presbyterian, St. John's Lutheran, First Lutheran, United Methodist, Holy Redeemer, Our Saviors Lutheran, Temple of Jesus Christ, Hispanic Church and Emden. Ask God to continue to move through His church to the glory of His kingdom. Remember—we are part of God's kingdom and need to always be following Him.
